Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population **increased by 2.2%** since 2015, growing by 589. Population is expected to **increase by 1.2%** between 2020 and 2025, adding 311.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **declined by 3.6%** in Juneau County, WI from 10,472 to **10,097**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 0.0% by 3.6%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 66.5% to 64.0% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **9.9% of Juneau County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.2% below the national average), and **10.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

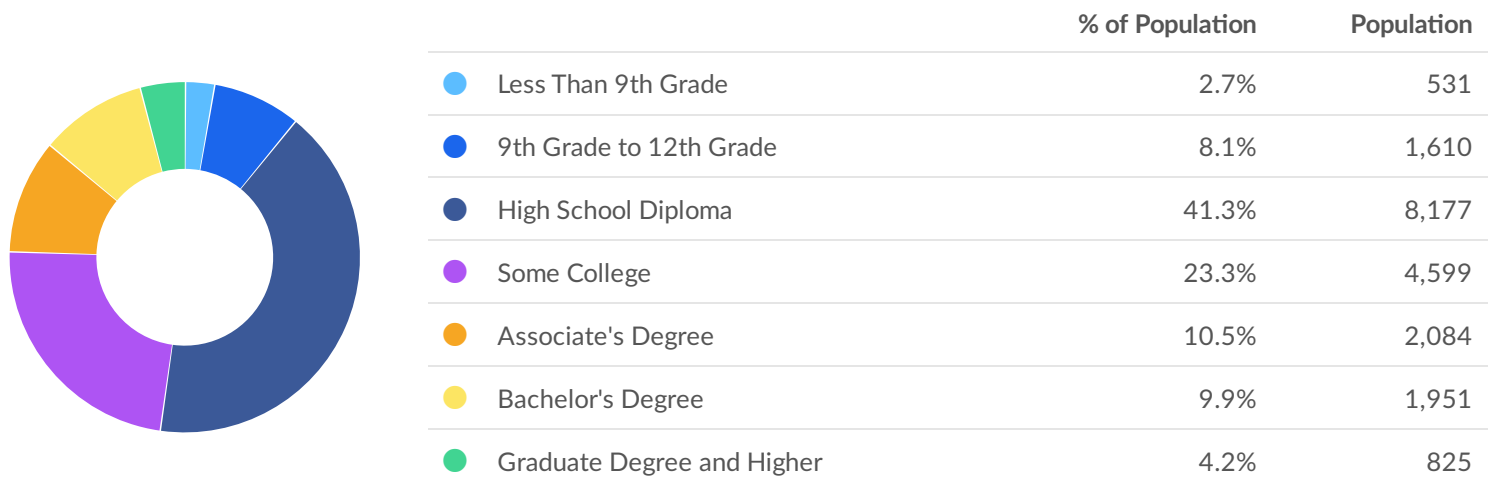

Dec 2020 Labor Force Breakdown



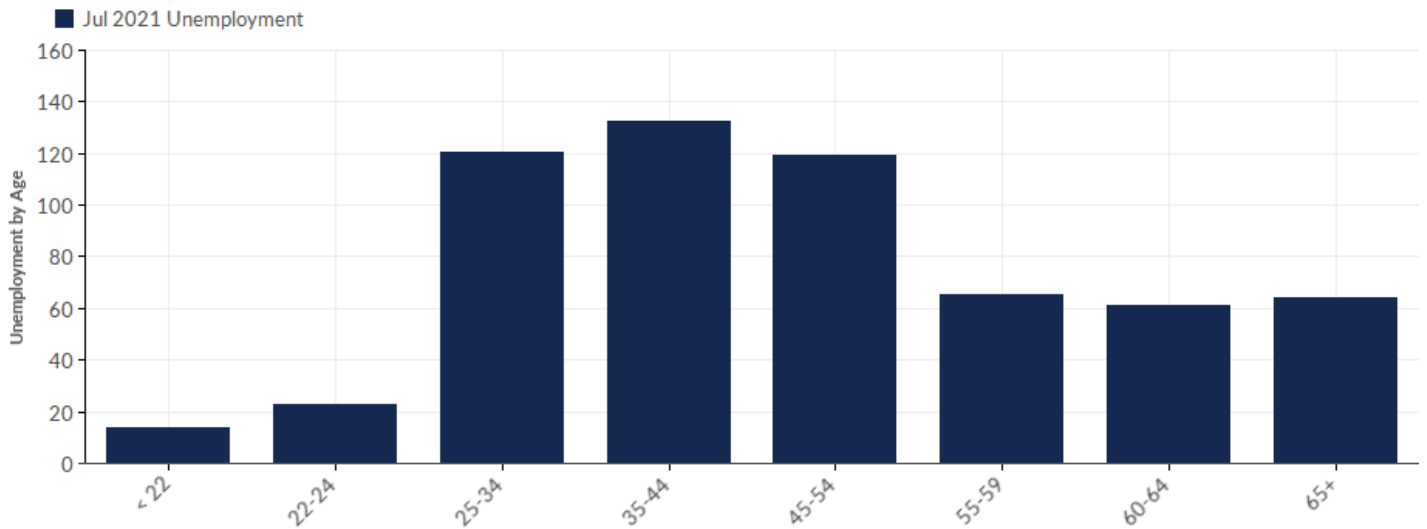
Educational Attainment

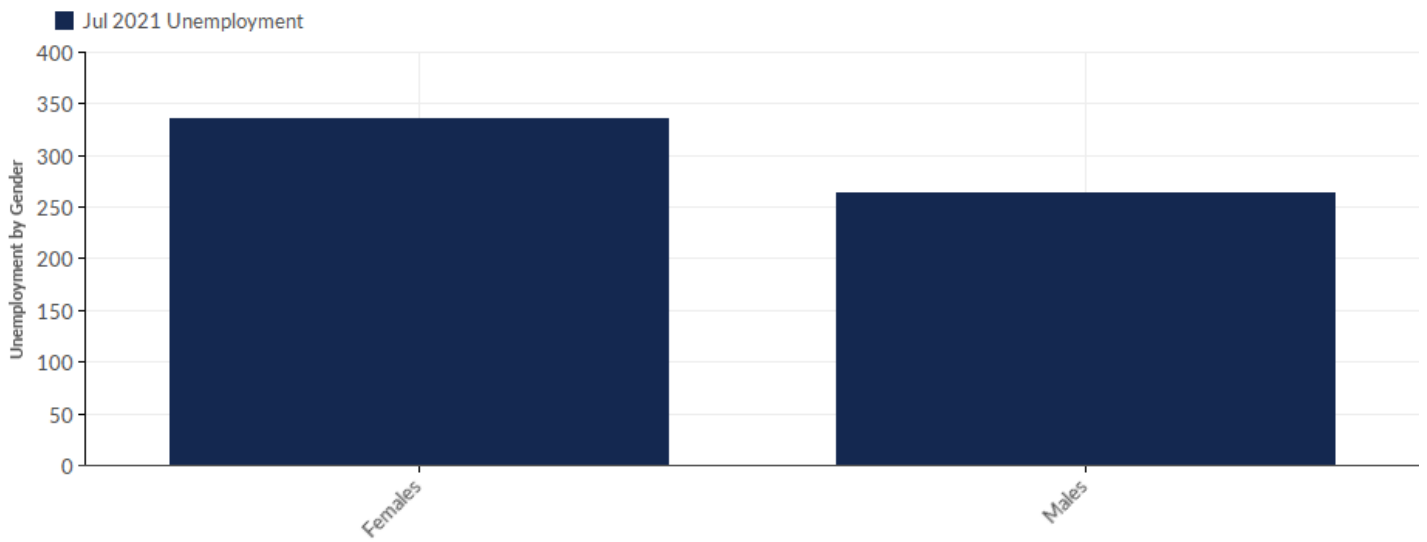

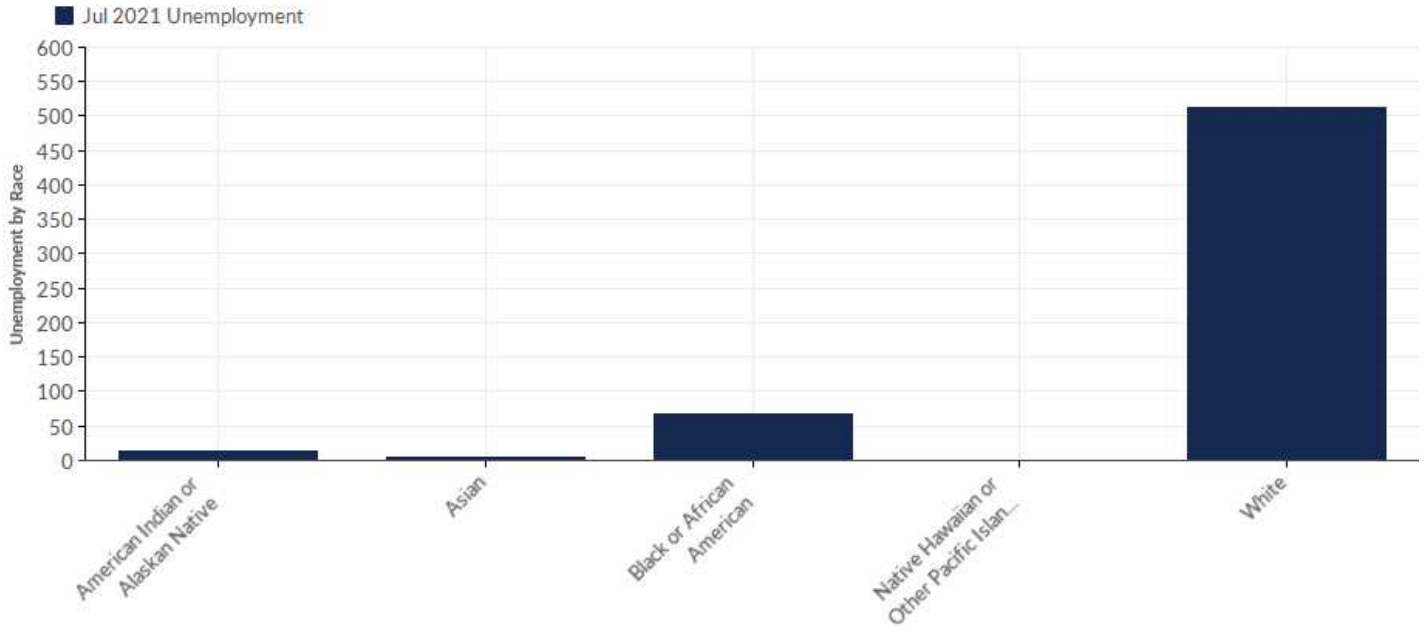

Unemployment by Gender



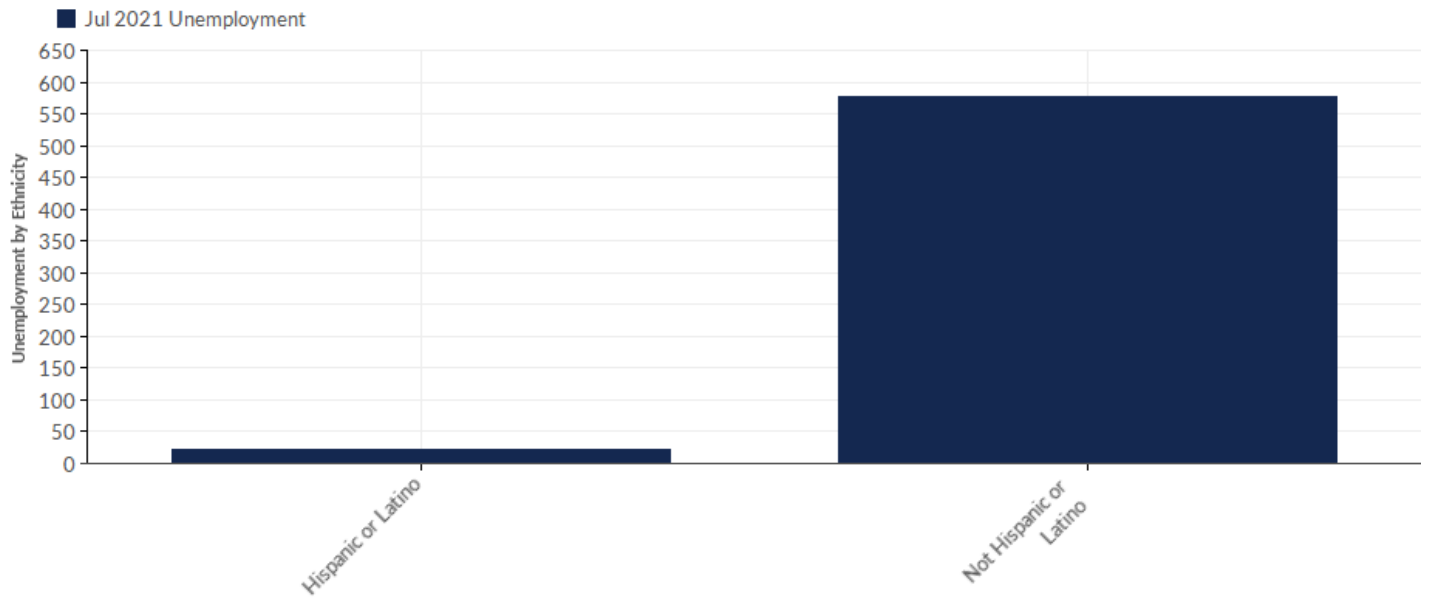

Unemployment by Ethnicity

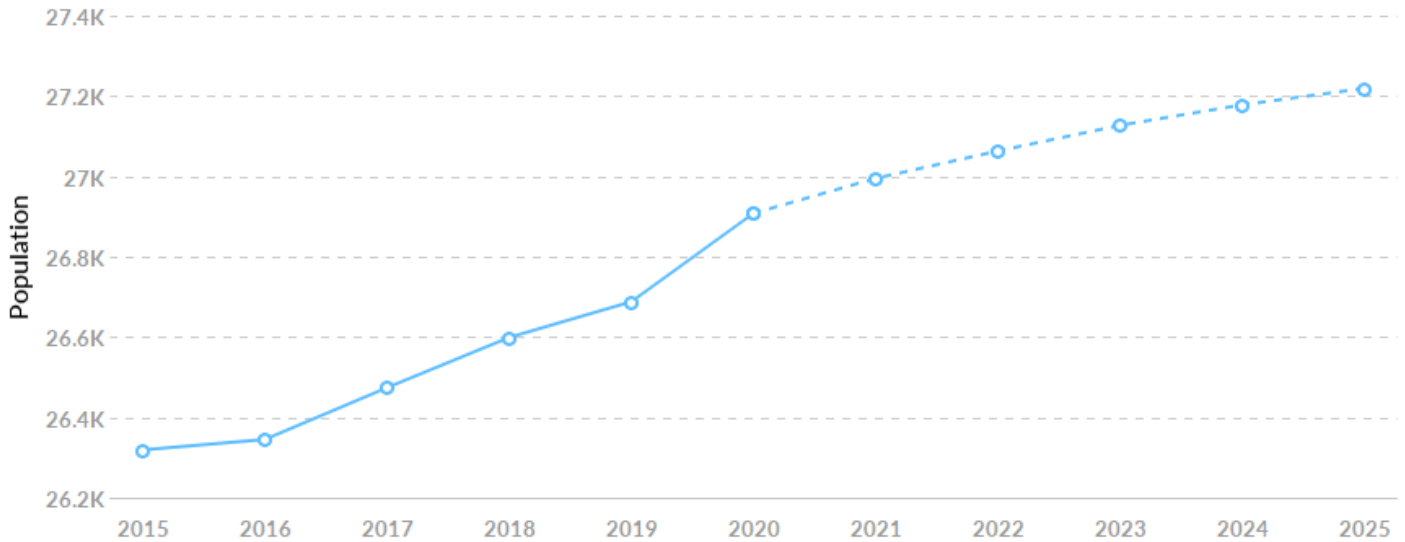

Population Trends

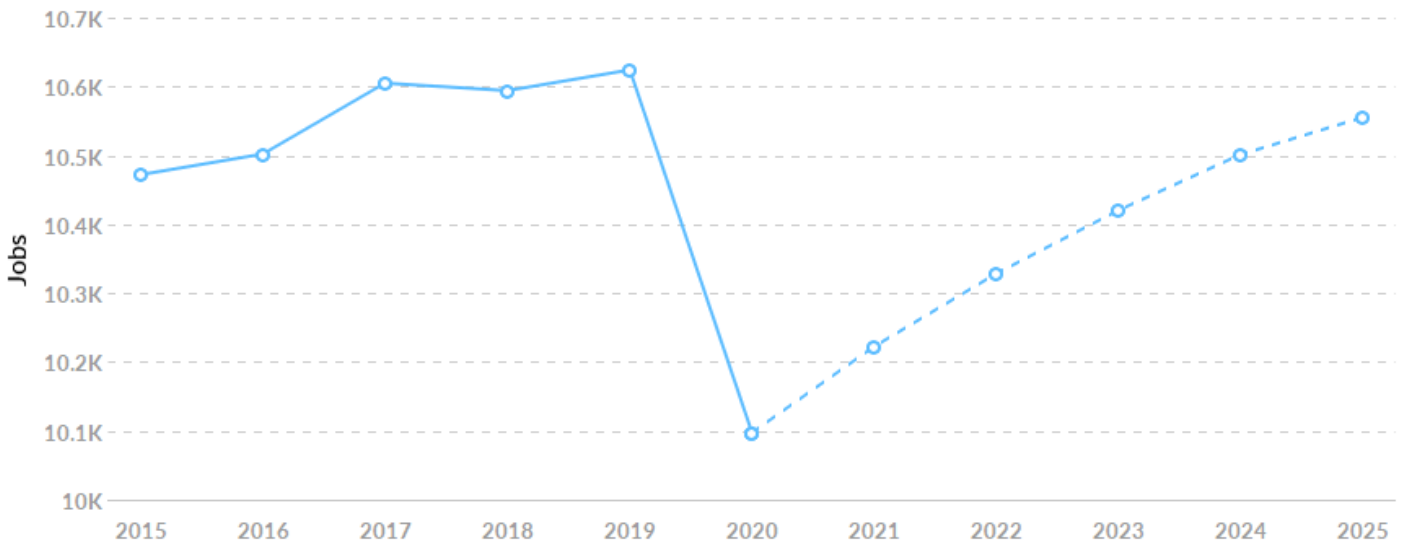

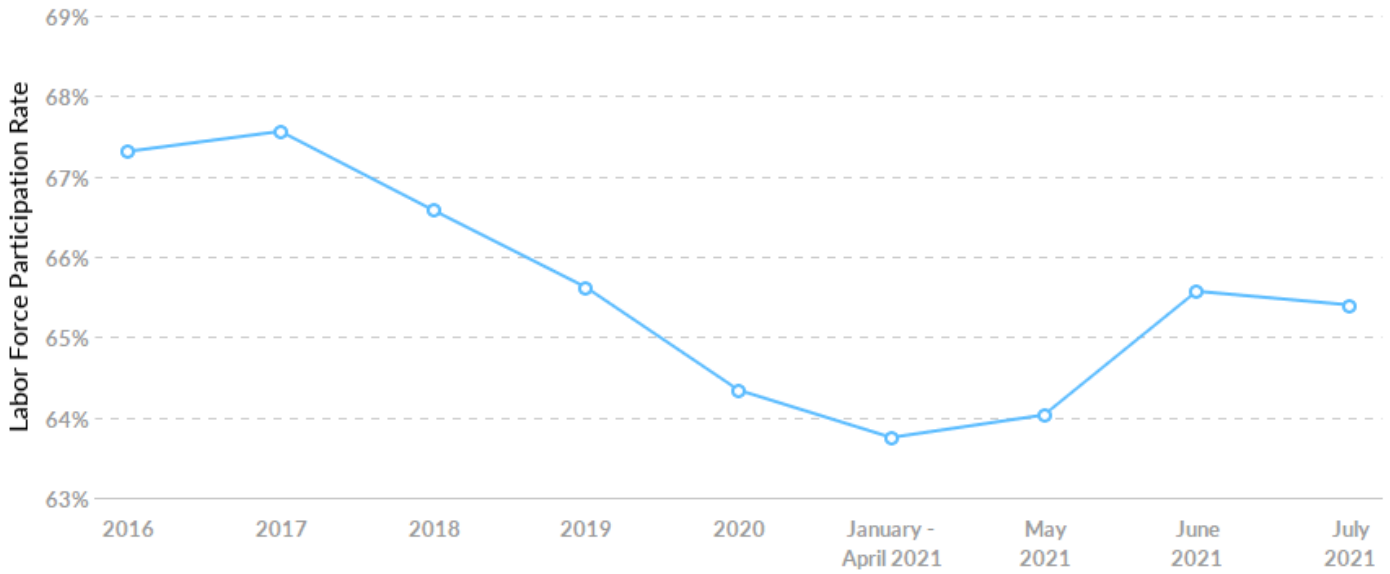
Job Trends

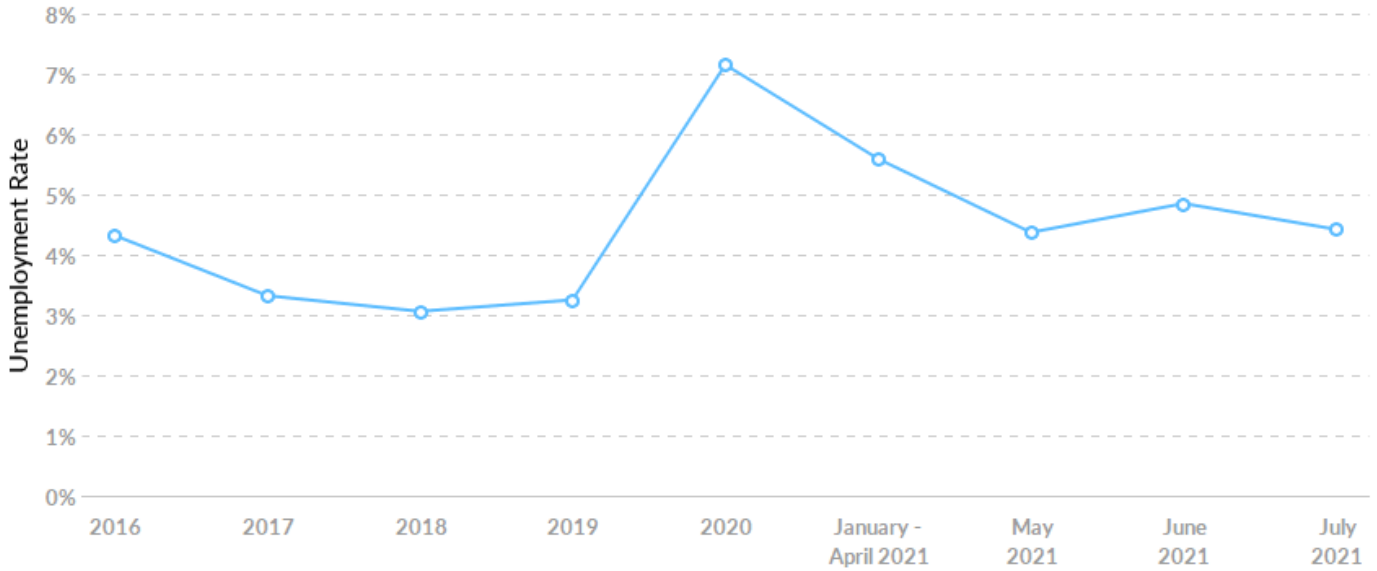

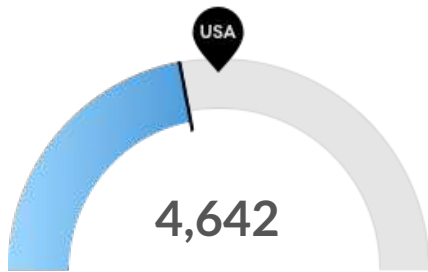
Unemployment Rate Trends

Juneau County, WI had a July 2021 unemployment rate of 4.42%, **increasing from 4.32%** 5 years before.



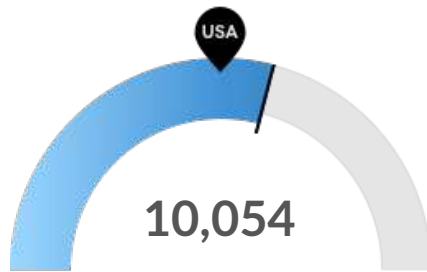

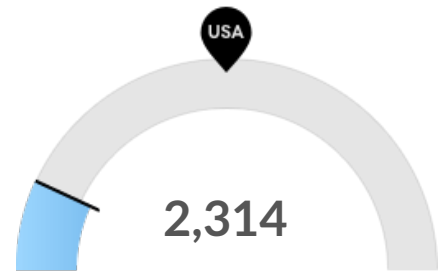
Millennials

Juneau County, WI has 4,642 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,545.



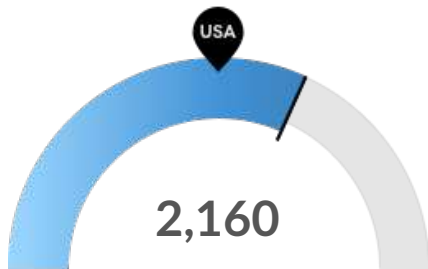
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Juneau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,009 people 55 or older, while there are 10,054 here.



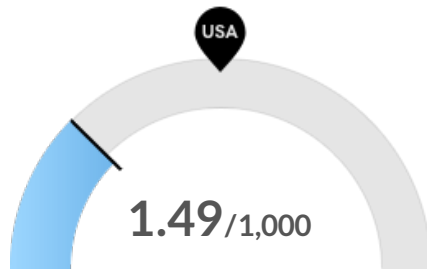
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Juneau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 10,838 racially diverse people, while there are 2,314 here.



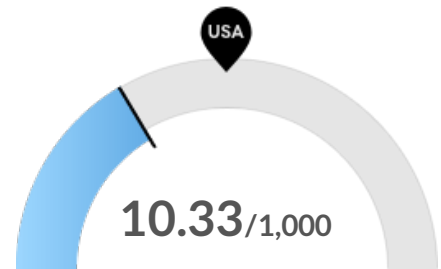
Veterans

Juneau County, WI has 1.49 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.62 per 1,000 people.

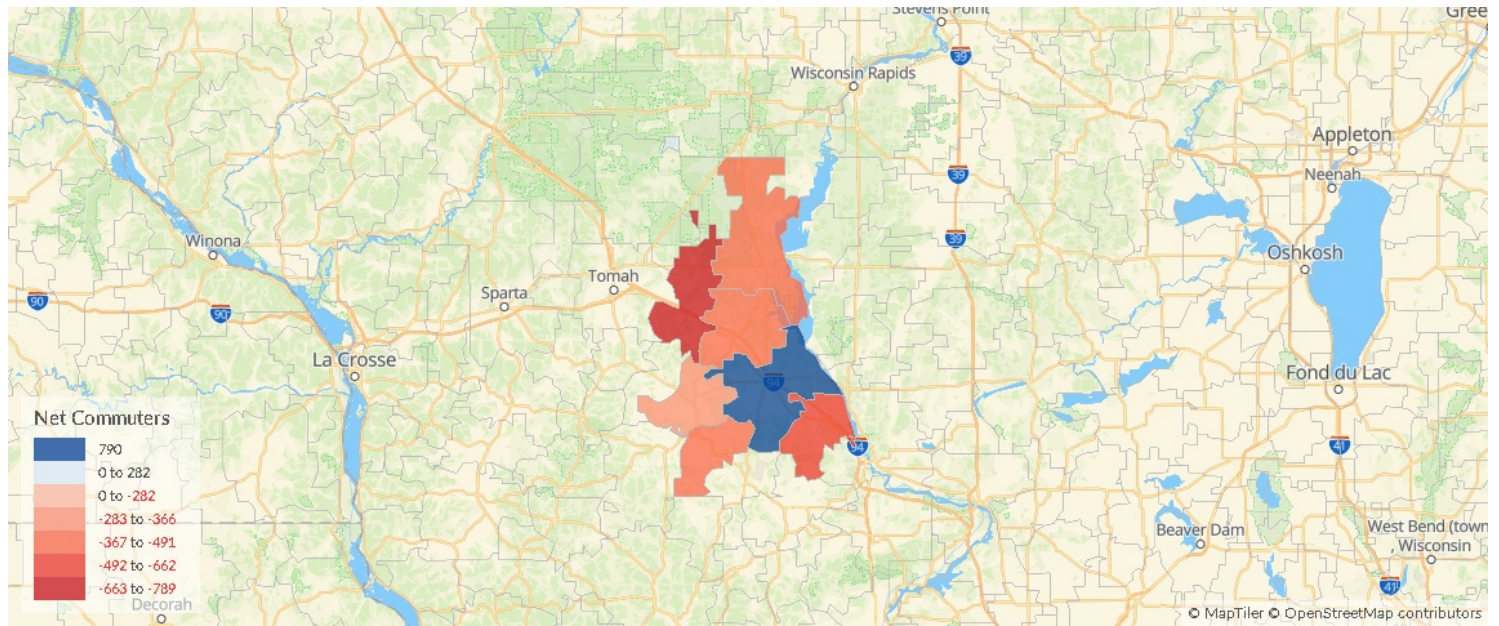


Property Crime

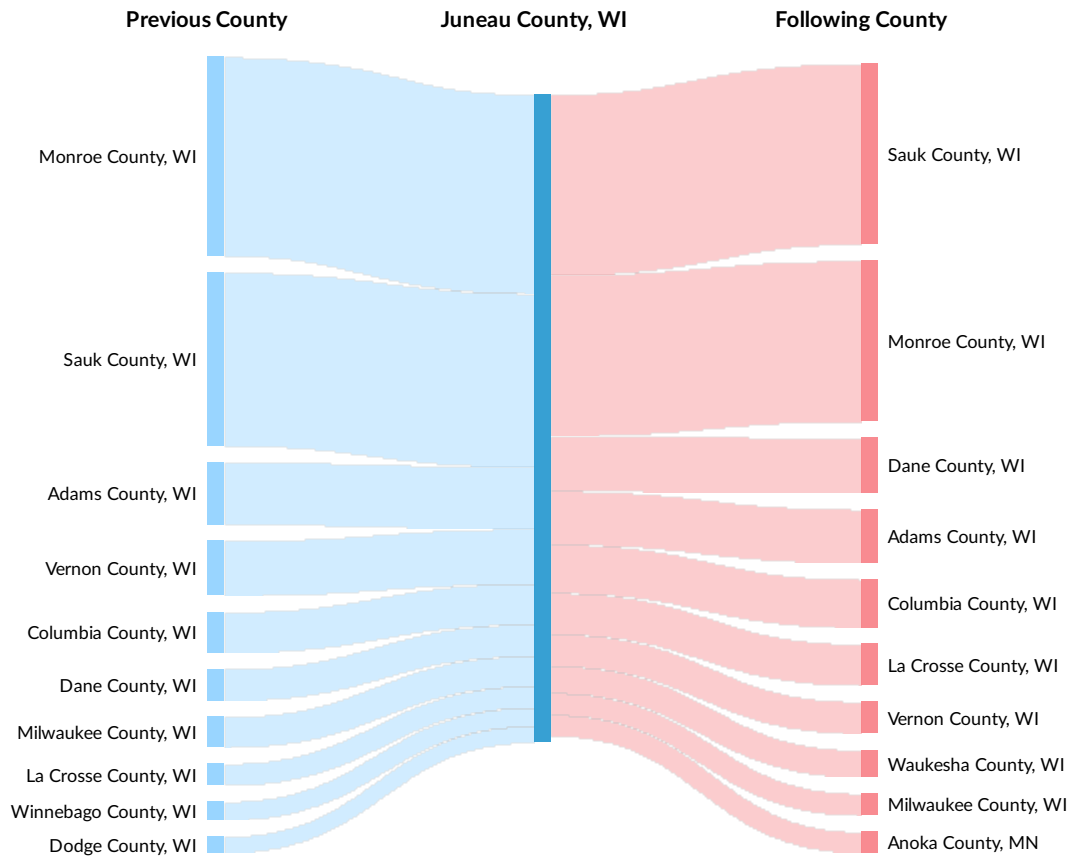

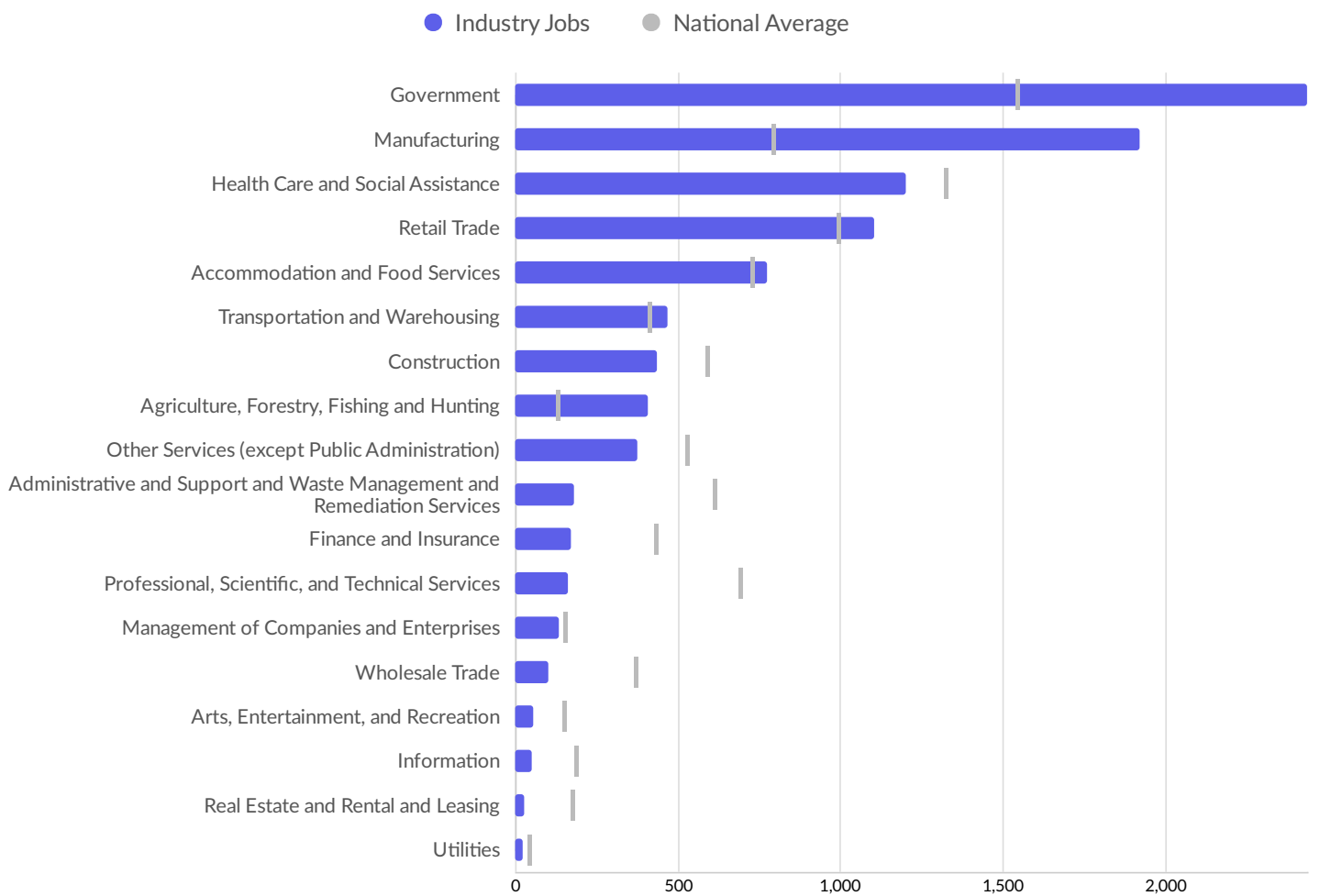

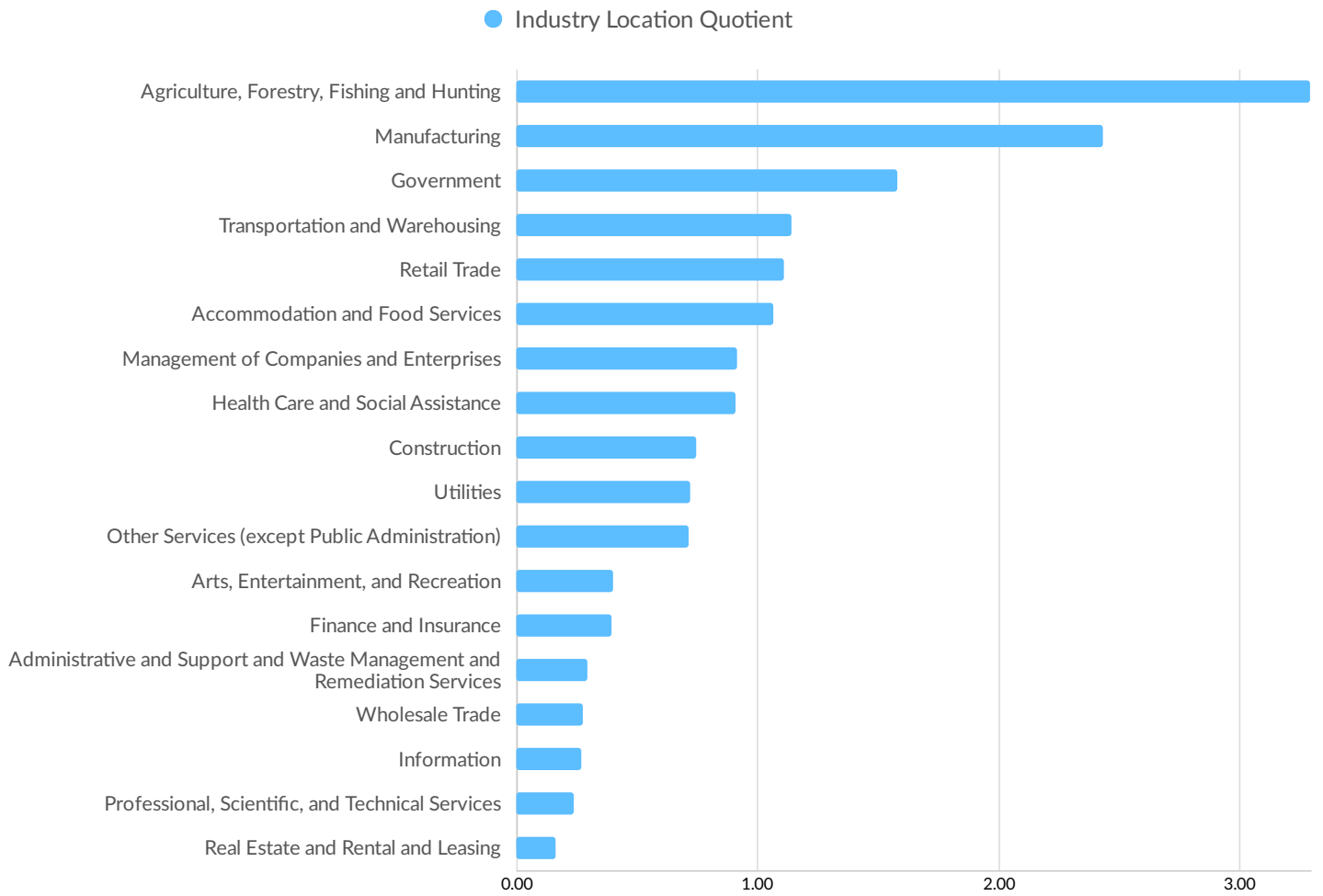

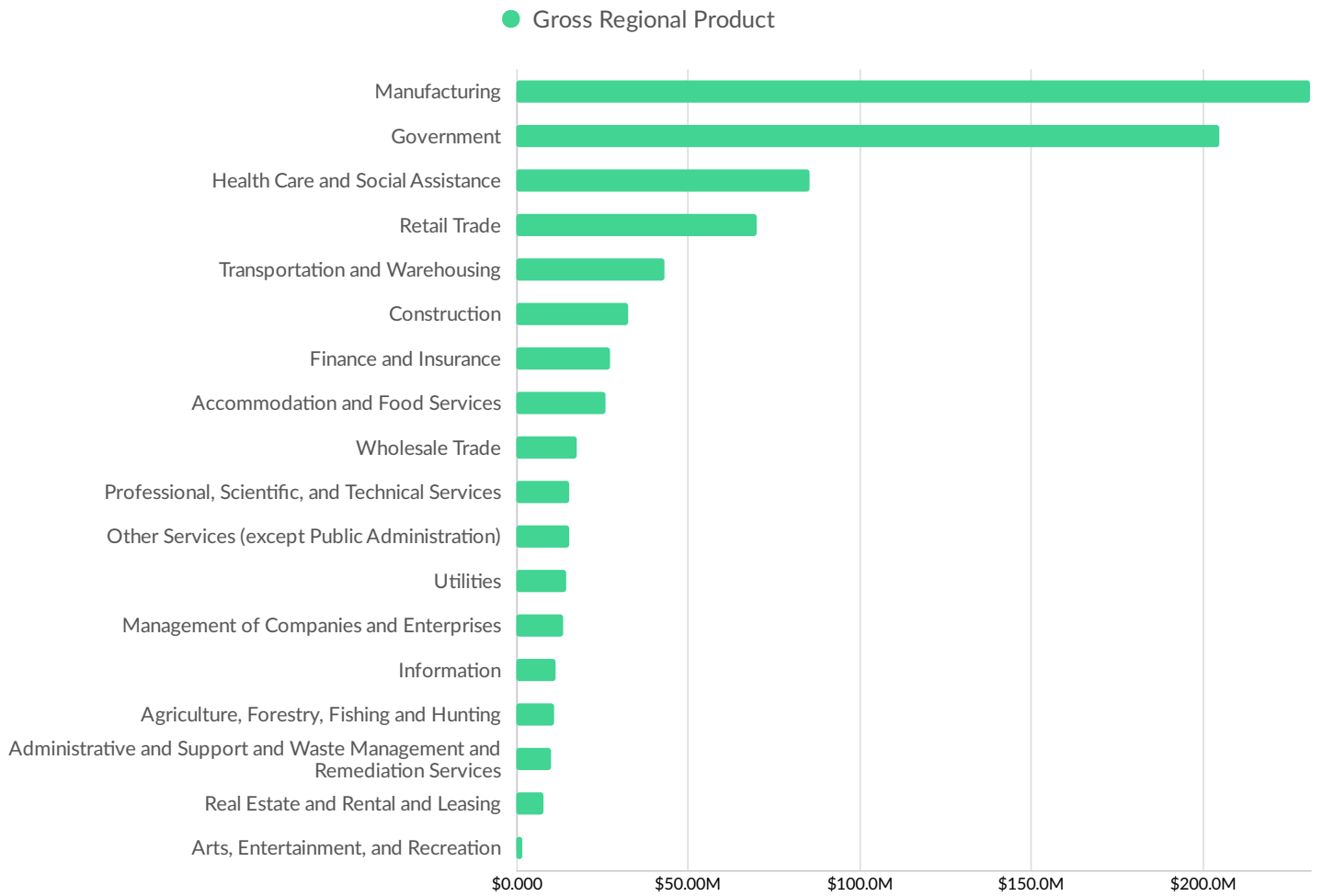
Top Growing Industries



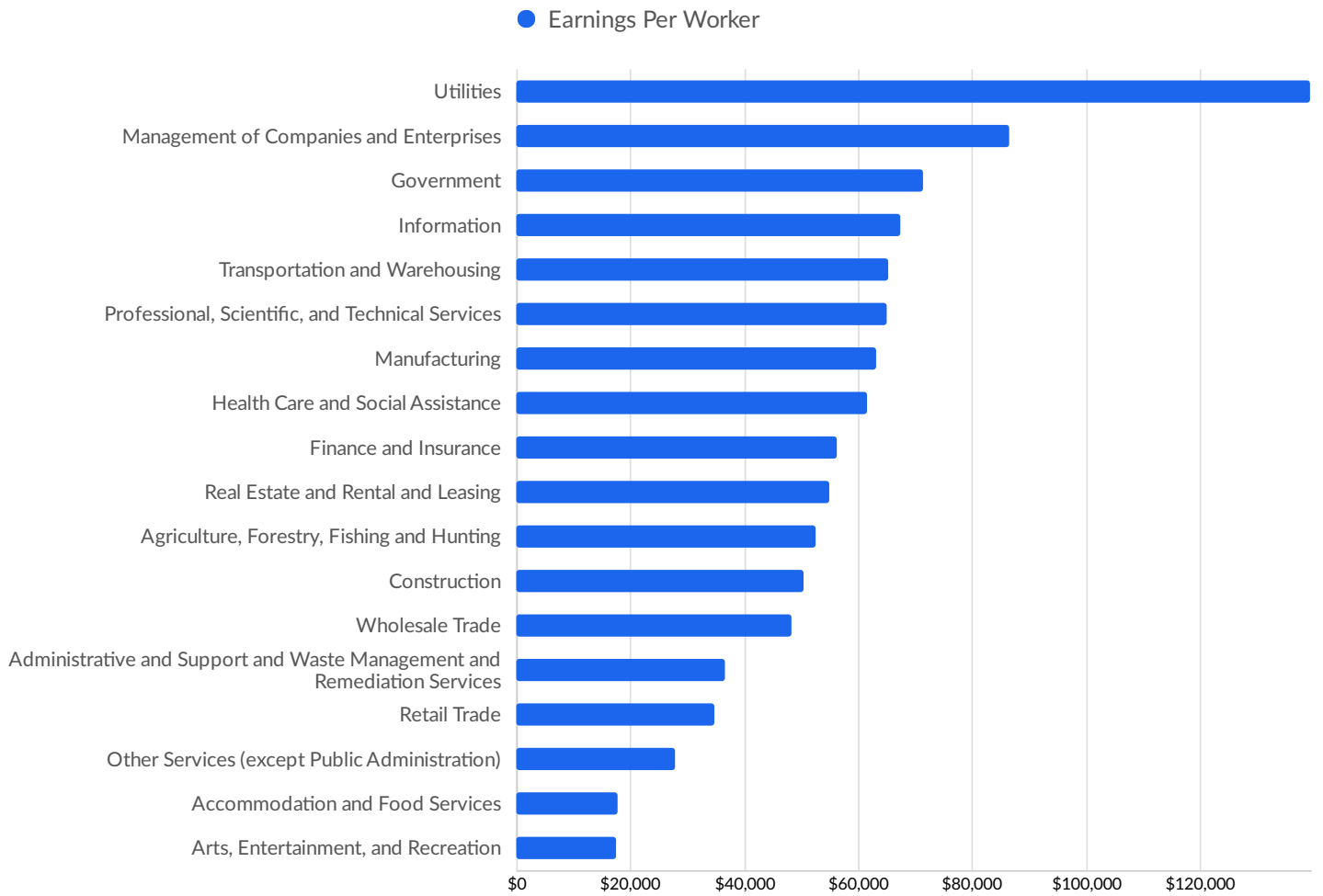
Top Industry Location Quotient

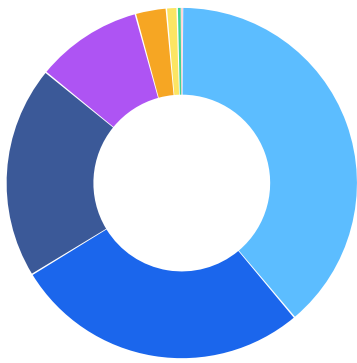

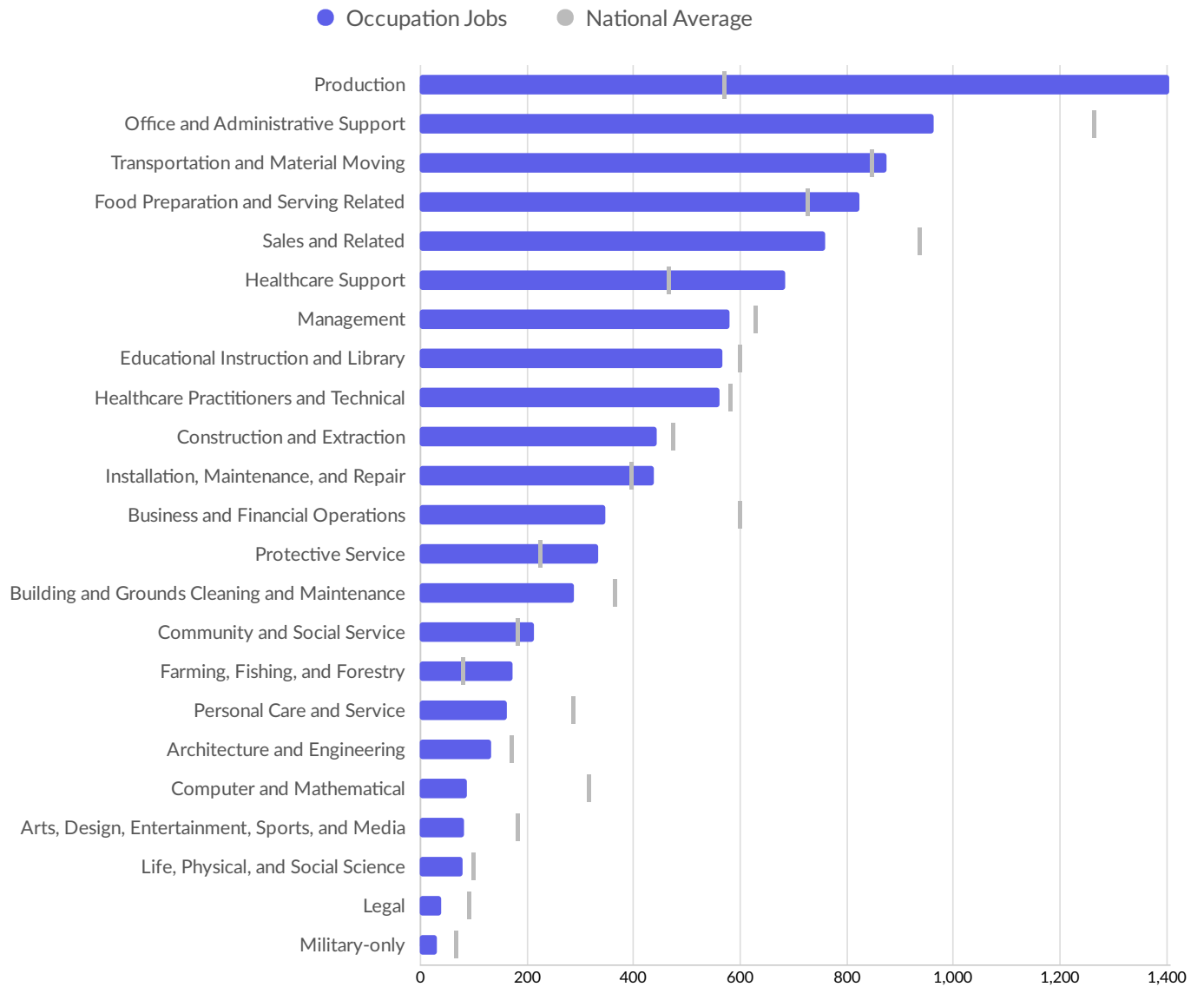

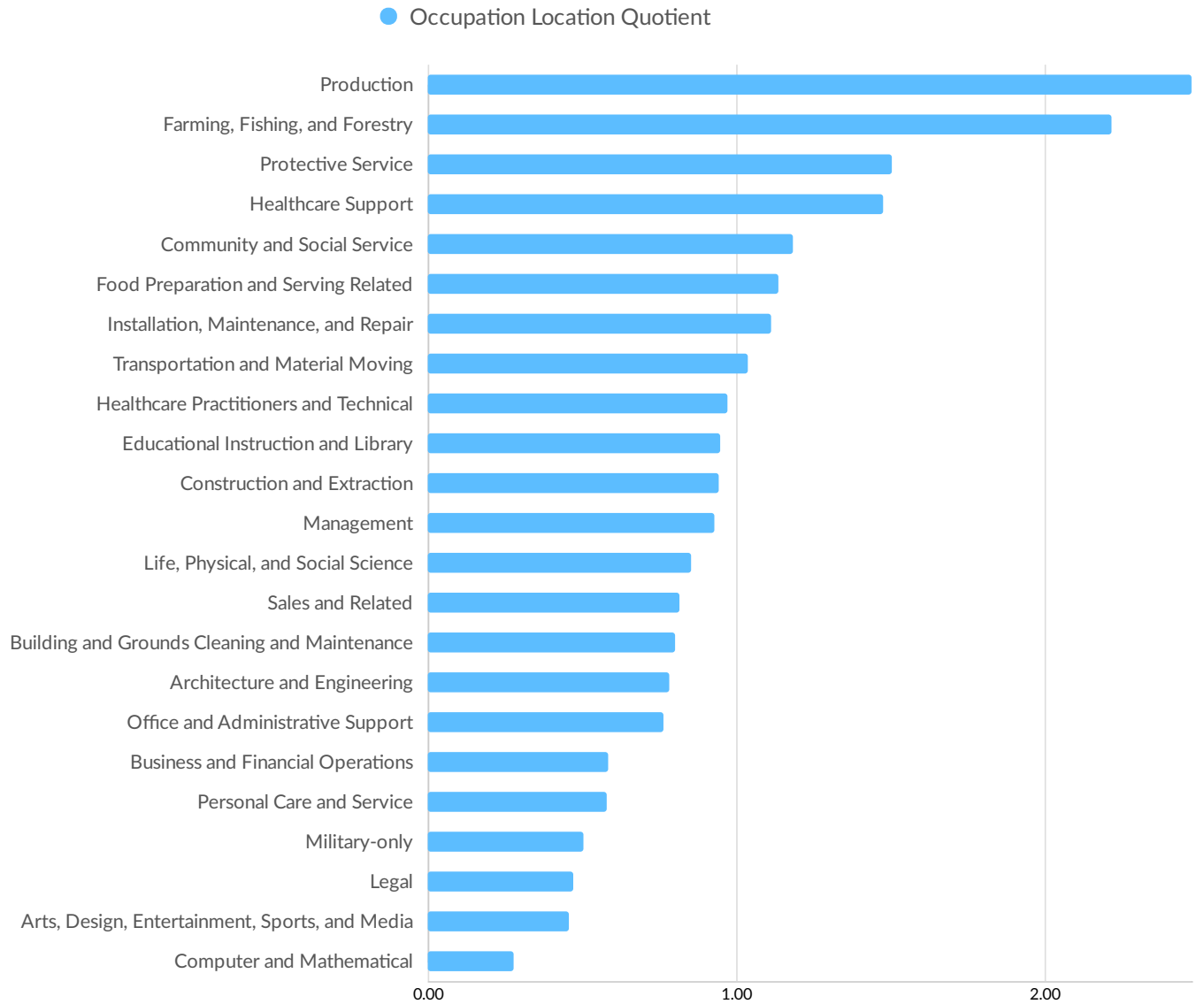
Largest Occupations



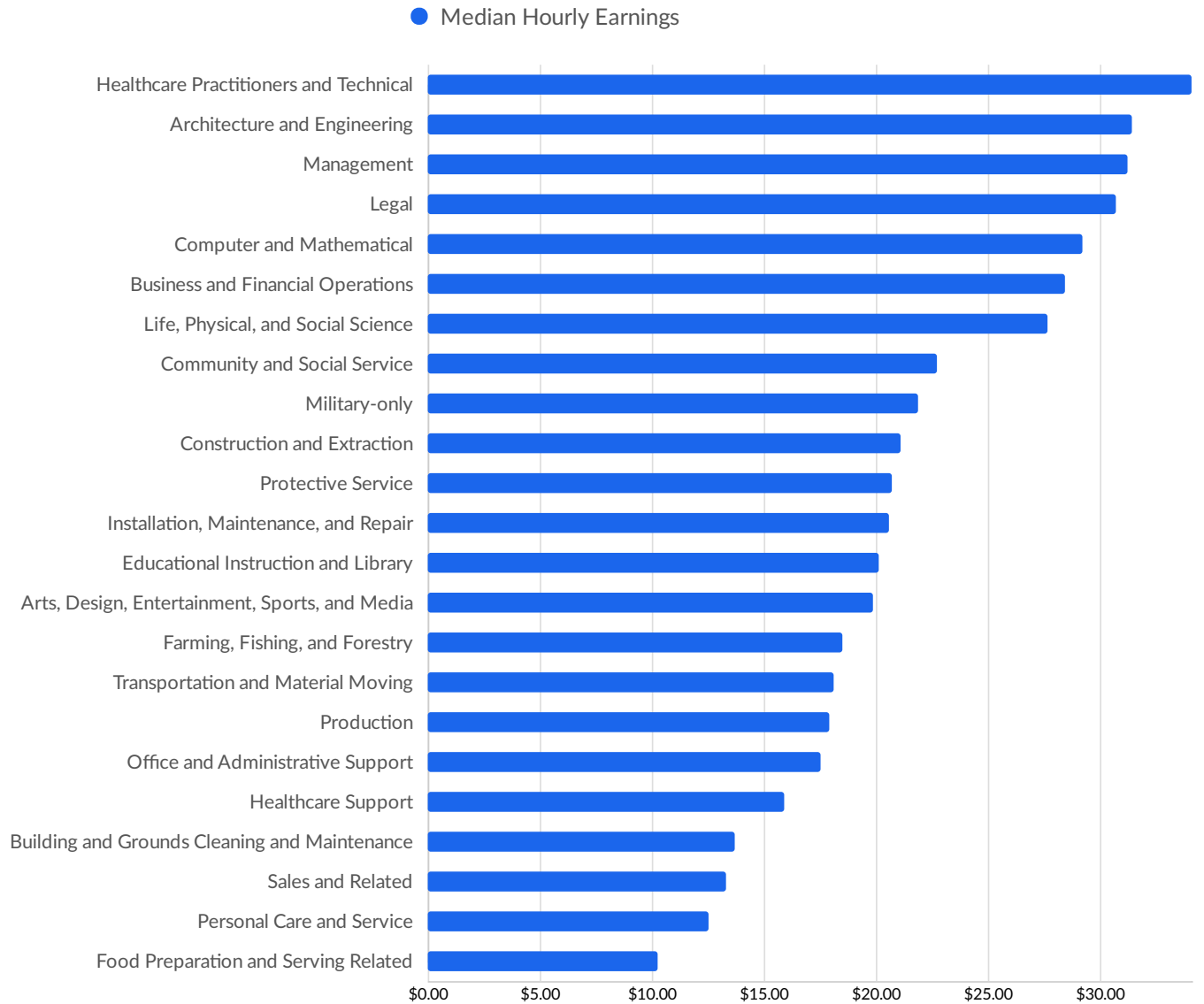
Top Growing Occupations



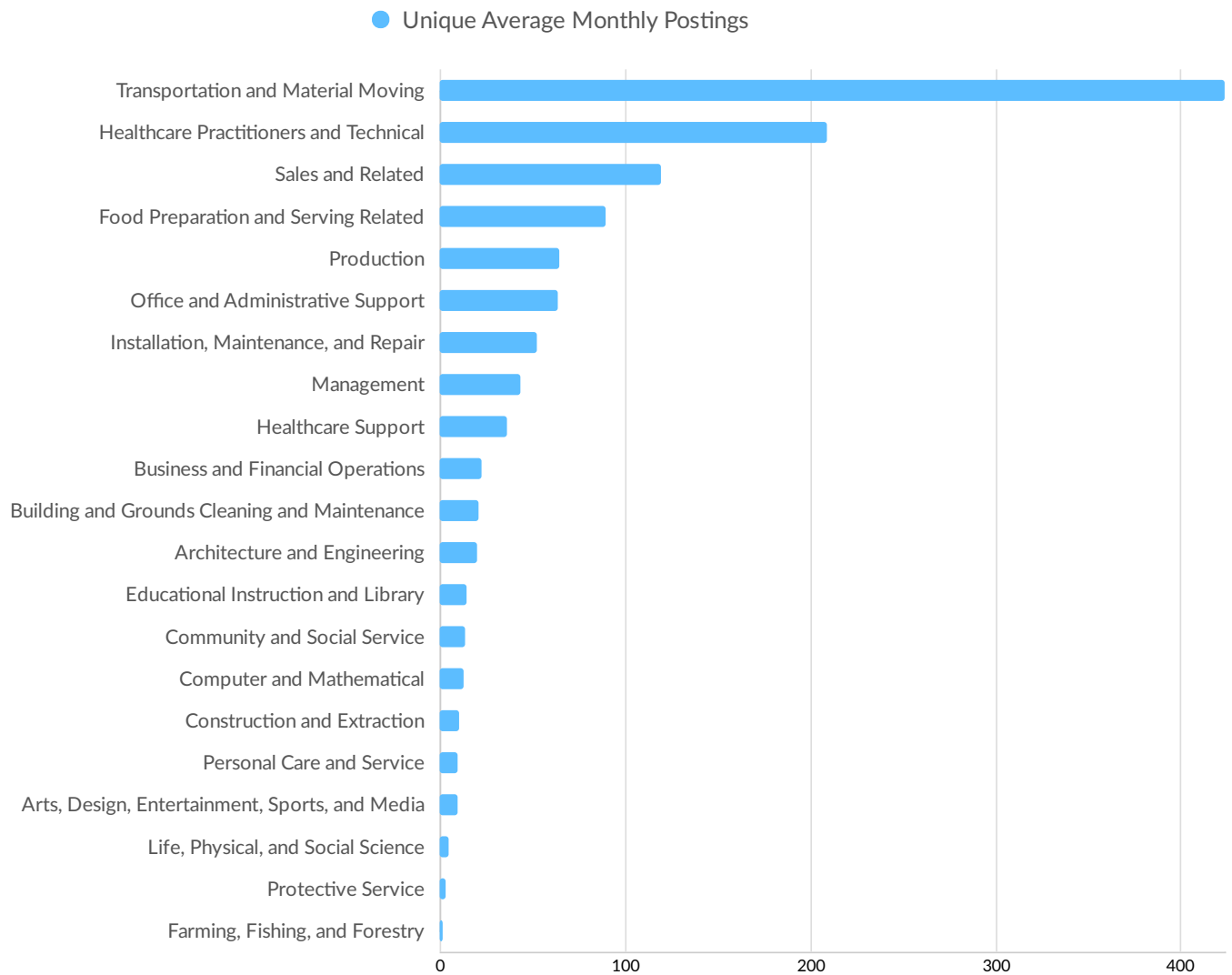
Top Occupation Location Quotient



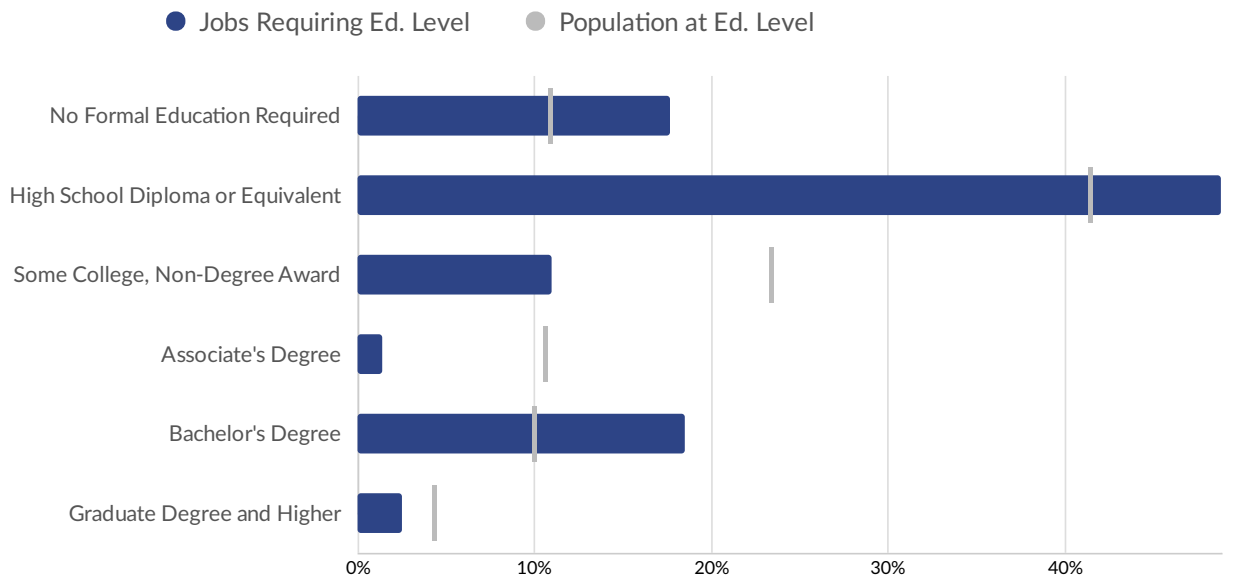
