#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2020 the region's population **increased by 0.4%** since 2015, growing by 68. Population is expected to **increase by 0.7%** between 2020 and 2025, adding 127.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 2.8% in Langlade County, WI from 8,768 to 8,521. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 0.0% by 2.8%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 61.1% to 59.0% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.7% of Langlade County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.4% below the national average), and **11.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.5% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Crop Production, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.














### **Unemployment Rate Trends**

Langlade County, WI had a July 2021 unemployment rate of 4.90%, decreasing from 5.06% 5 years before.






#### Millennials

Langlade County, WI has 1,561 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,067.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Racial diversity is low in Langlade County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 7,701 racially diverse people, while there are 1,314 here.












### **Top Industry Location Quotient**








#### **Top Occupation Location Quotient**




