Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population **increased by 0.2**% since 2015, growing by 232. Population is expected to **increase by 0.5**% between 2020 and 2025, adding 668.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 2.7% in Marathon County, WI from 77,164 to 75,108. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 0.0% by 2.7%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 68.9% to 67.2% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.7% of Marathon County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.4% below the national average), and **13.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.2% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Dairy Product Manufacturing.








Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity










Unemployment Rate Trends

Marathon County, WI had a July 2021 unemployment rate of 3.27%, decreasing from 3.48% 5 years before.





Millennials




Veterans

Marathon County, WI has 8,589 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 7.534.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 40,356 people 55 or older, while there are 44,803 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 54,615 racially diverse people, while there are 16,340 here.




Property Crime






Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Location Quotient






Top Industry GRP







Top Occupation Location Quotient











Top Posted Occupations
