- As of 2020 the region's population **increased by 0.7**% since 2015, growing by 488. Population is expected to **increase by 0.9**% between 2020 and 2025, adding 665.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 5.1% in Portage County, WI from 38,899 to 36,919. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 0.0% by 5.1%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 68.3% to 63.9% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **23.7% of Portage County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.7% above the national average), and **11.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Insurance Carriers, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Fruit and Vegetable Preserving and Specialty Food Manufacturing.








Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity










Unemployment Rate Trends


Millennials

Portage County, WI has 12,596 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 14,638.




Veterans

Portage County, WI has 3,933 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 3,939.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Portage County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 21,141 people 55 or older, while there are 22,223 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Portage County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 28,611 racially diverse people, while there are 6,670 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Location Quotient






Top Industry GRP







Top Occupation Location Quotient




Median Hourly Earnings




