

Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population **increased by 2.4**% since 2015, growing by 471. Population is expected to **increase by 1.0**% between 2020 and 2025, adding 211.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 9.5% in Adams County, WI from 5,977 to 5,411. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 0.0% by 9.5%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 50.6% to 46.5% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, 9.6% of Adams County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (10.4% below the national average), and 8.2% hold an Associate's Degree (0.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Crop Production, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).








Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity





As of 2020 the region's population increased by 2.4% since 2015, growing by 471. Population is expected to increase by 1.0% between 2020 and 2025, adding 211.








Unemployment Rate Trends

Adams County, WI had a September 2021 unemployment rate of 5.01%, decreasing from 5.88% 5 years before.






Population Characteristics

Adams County, WI has 2,989 millennials (ages 25-39). The size is 4.224.






Adams County, WI has 1,940 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1.125.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,101 people 55 or older, while there are 10,277 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,256 racially diverse people, while there are 2,077 here.




Property Crime






Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Location Quotient






Top Industry GRP






Top Growing Occupations





Top Occupation Location Quotient



Top Occupation Earnings


Median Hourly Earnings




