

- As of 2020 the region's population **declined by 0.6%** since 2015, falling by 55. Population is expected to **increase by 1.1%** between 2020 and 2025, adding 103.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 11.3% in Forest County, WI from 3,628 to 3,218. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 0.0% by 11.3%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 54.5% to 51.7% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.0% of Forest County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.1% below the national average), and **12.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.








Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity










Unemployment Rate Trends

Forest County, WI had a September 2021 unemployment rate of 5.75%, decreasing from 6.07% 5 years before.





Forest County, WI has 1,341 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 1,846.






Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Forest County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 2,667 people 55 or older, while there are 3,659 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Forest County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 3,609 racially diverse people, while there are 1,902 here.




Property Crime






Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Location Quotient






Top Industry GRP







Top Occupation Location Quotient









