- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **declined by 2.8%** in Langlade County, WI from 8,768 to **8,520**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 0.0% by 2.8%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 61.1% to 59.0% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.7% of Langlade County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.4% below the national average), and **11.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.5% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Crop Production, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

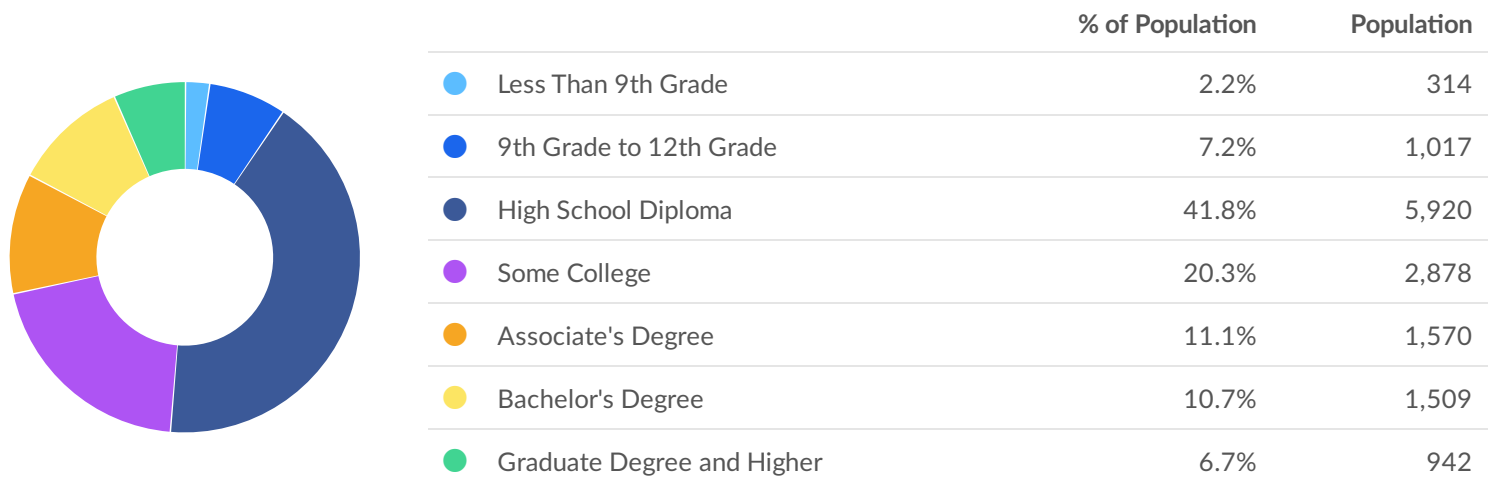

Dec 2020 Labor Force Breakdown



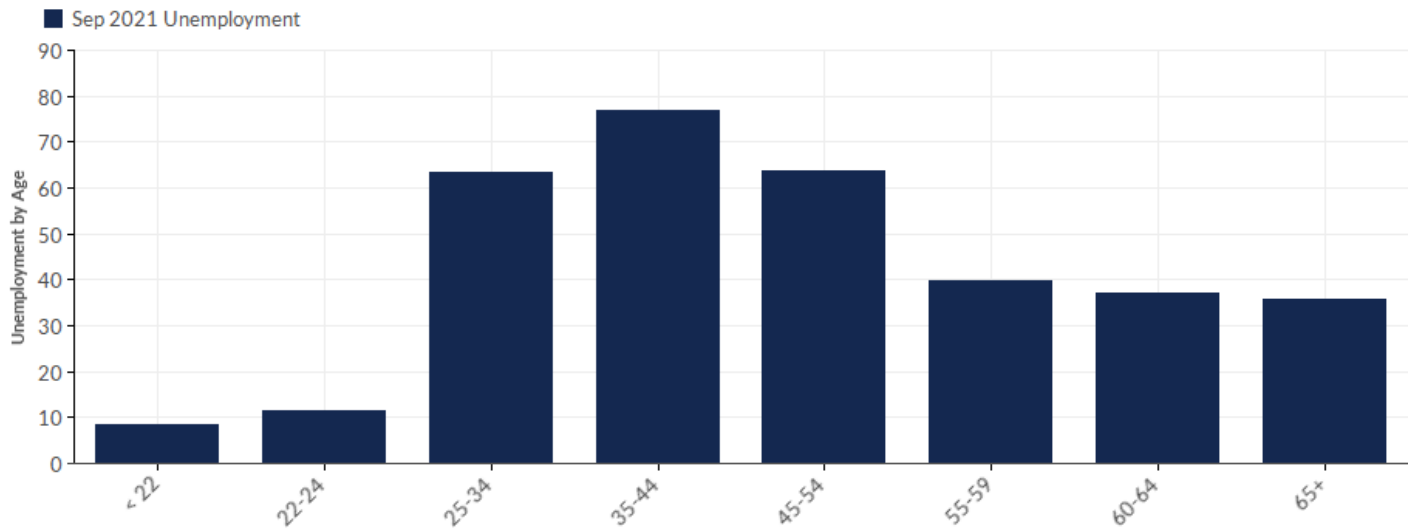
Educational Attainment

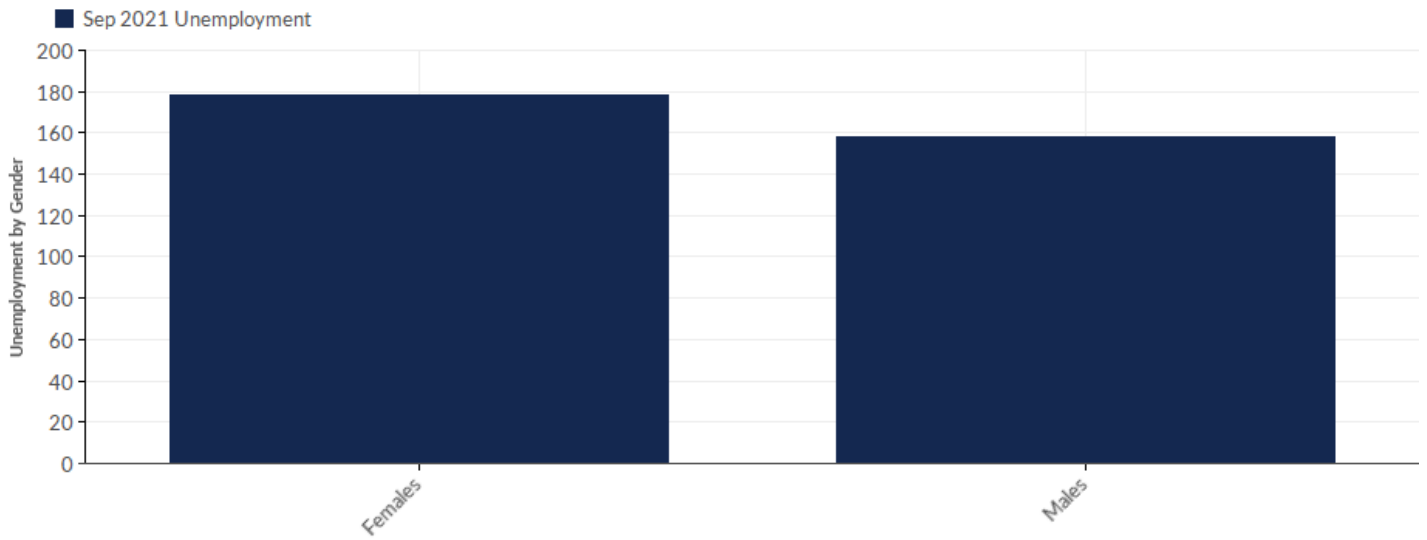

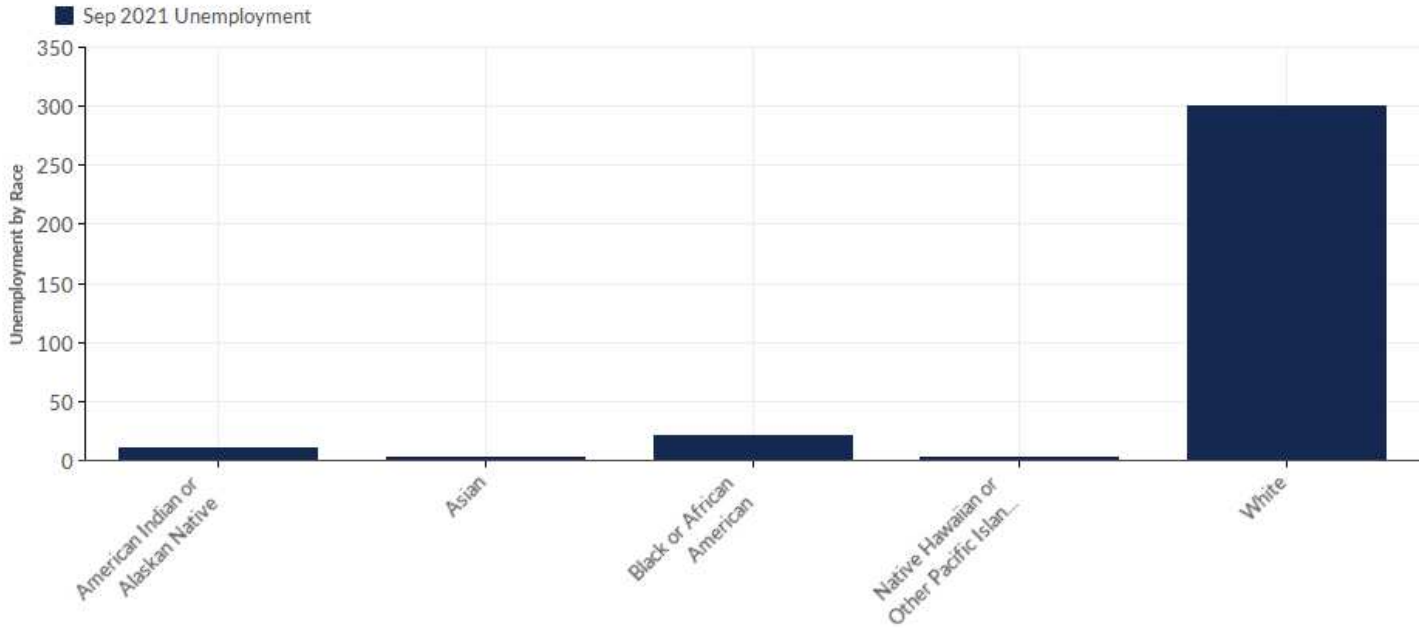

Unemployment by Gender



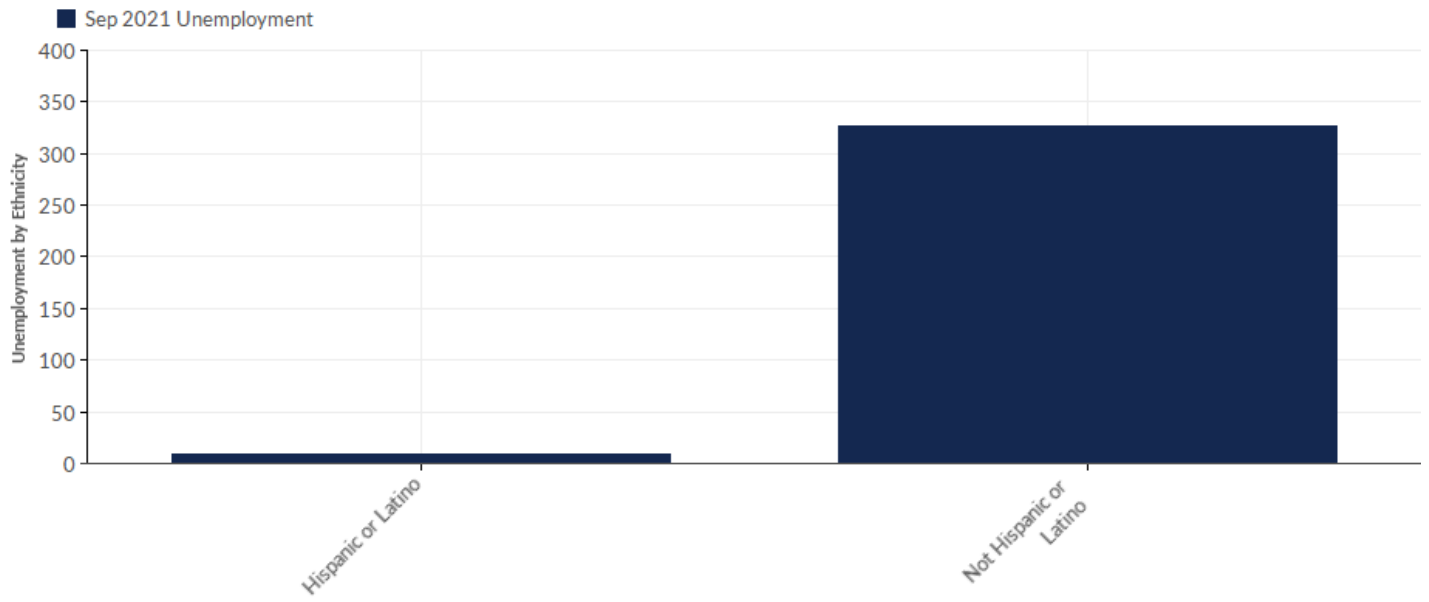

Unemployment by Ethnicity

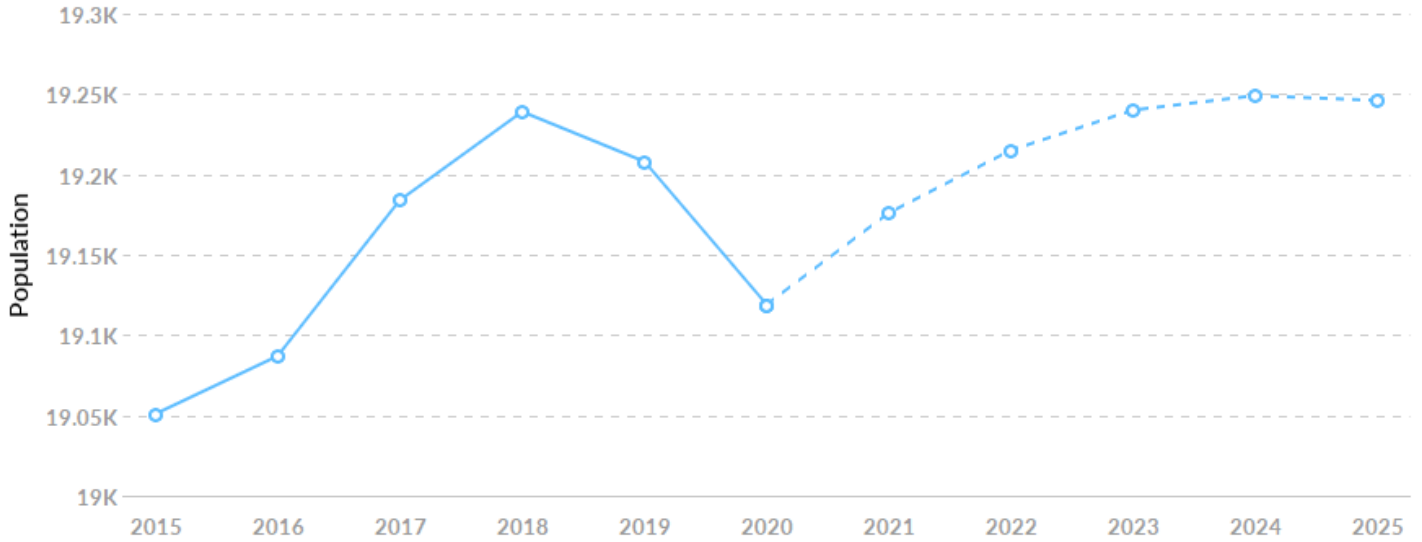

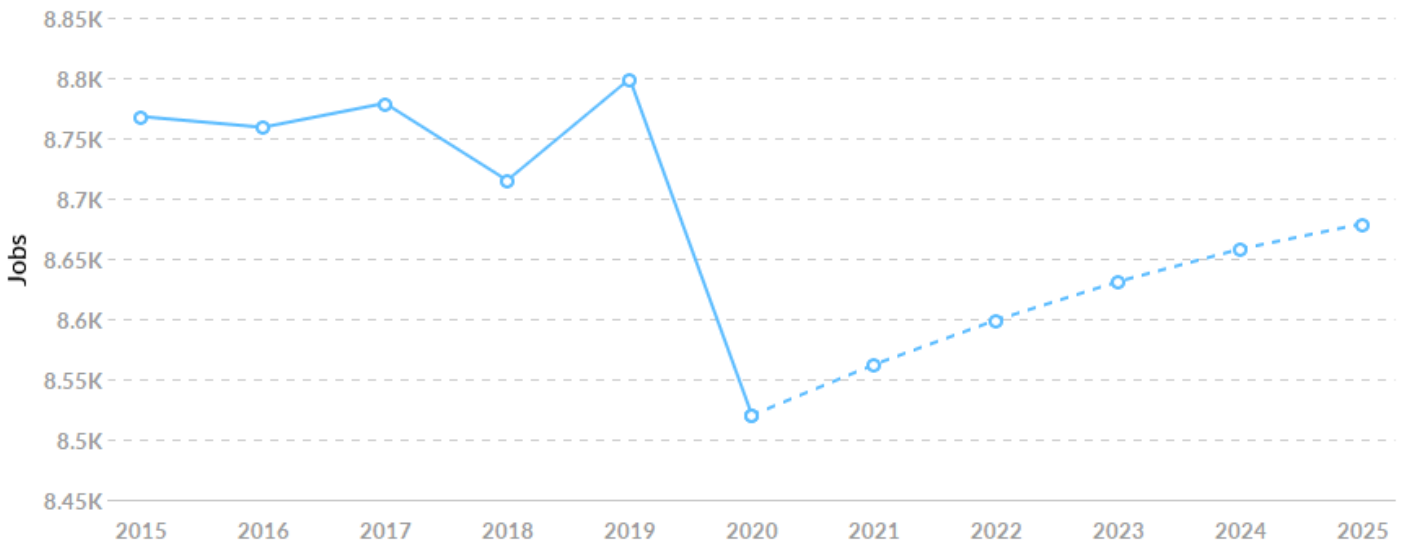

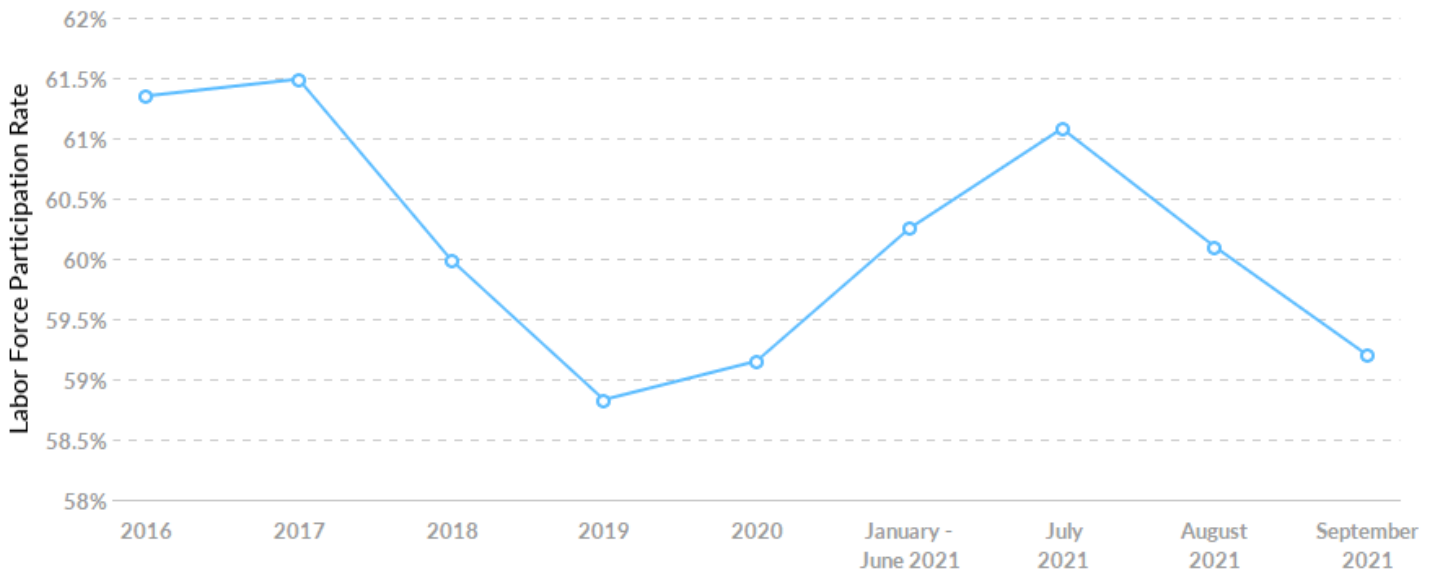
Job Trends

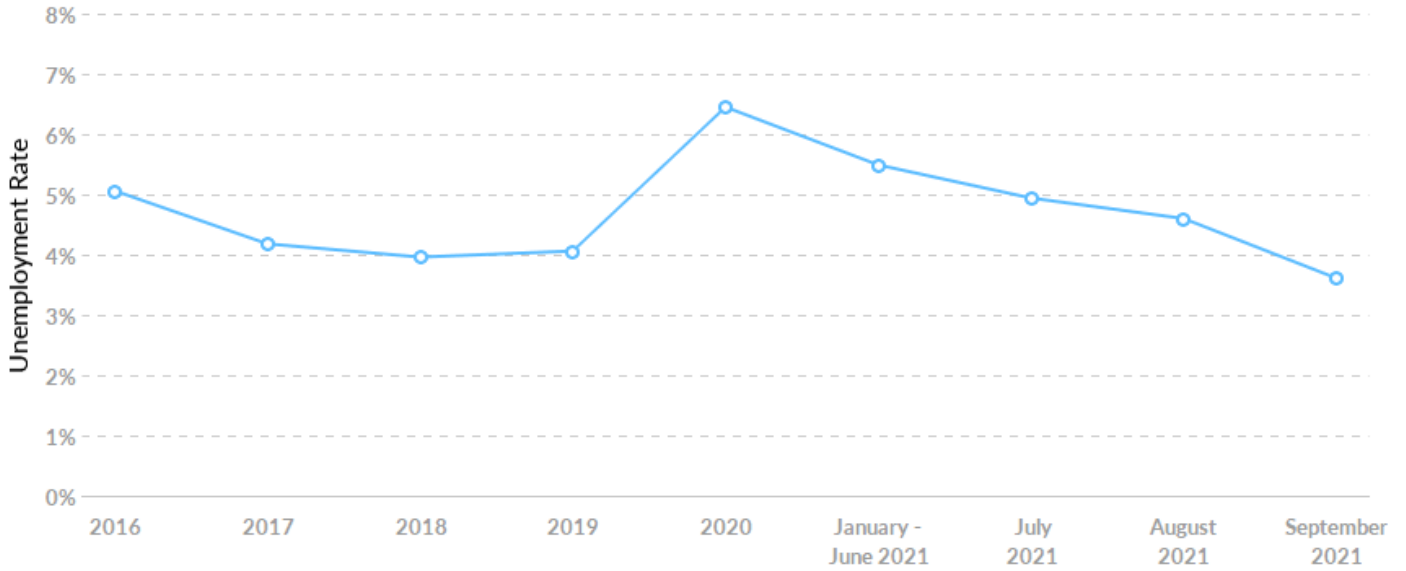

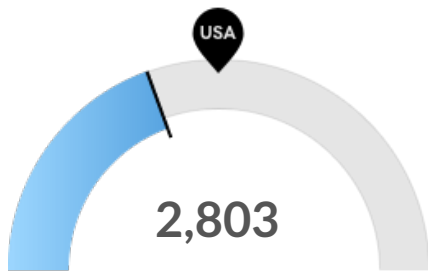
Unemployment Rate Trends

Langlade County, WI had a September 2021 unemployment rate of 3.61%, decreasing from 5.06% 5 years before.



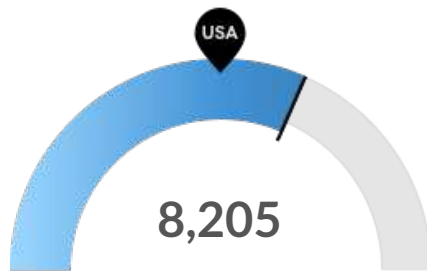

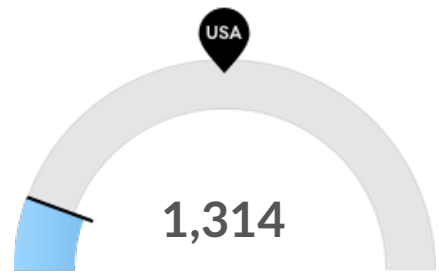
Millennials

Langlade County, WI has 2,803 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 3,940.



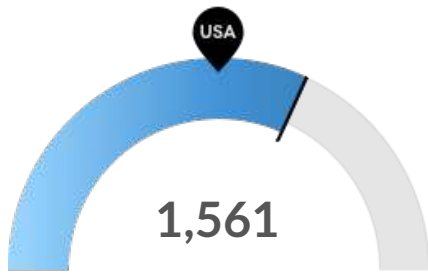
Retiring Soon

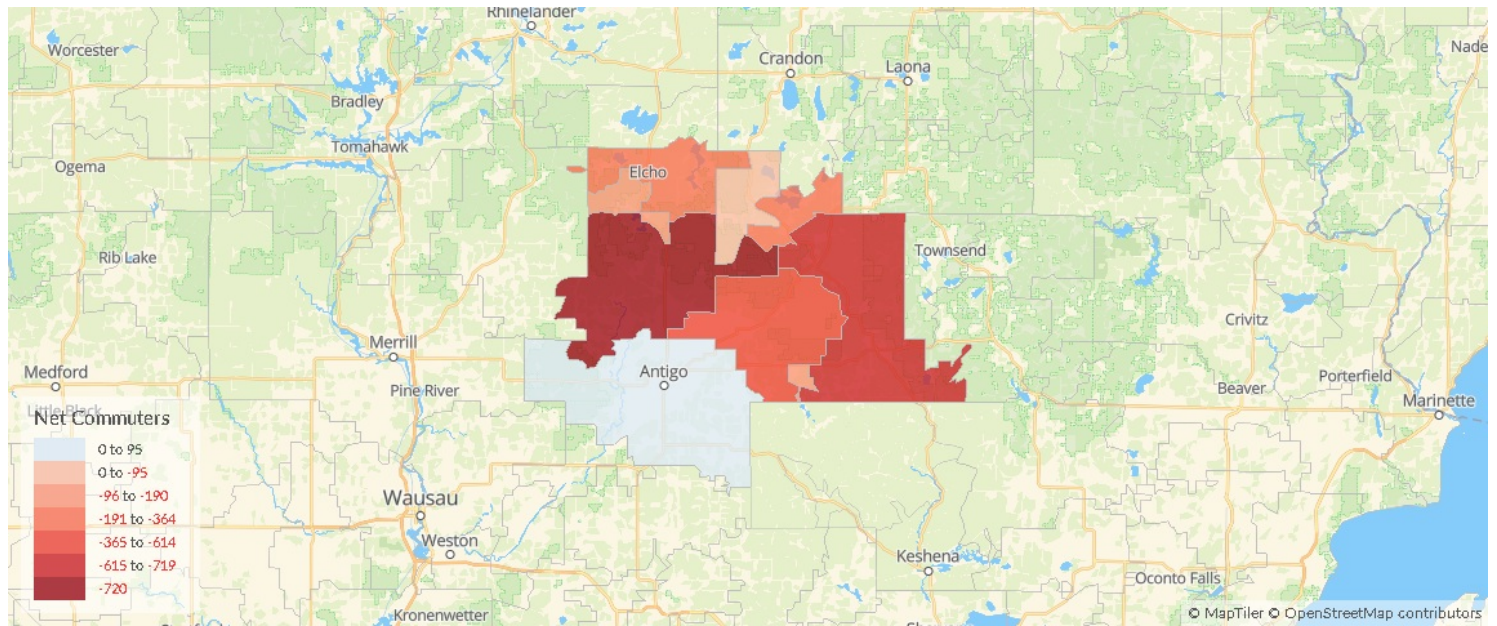

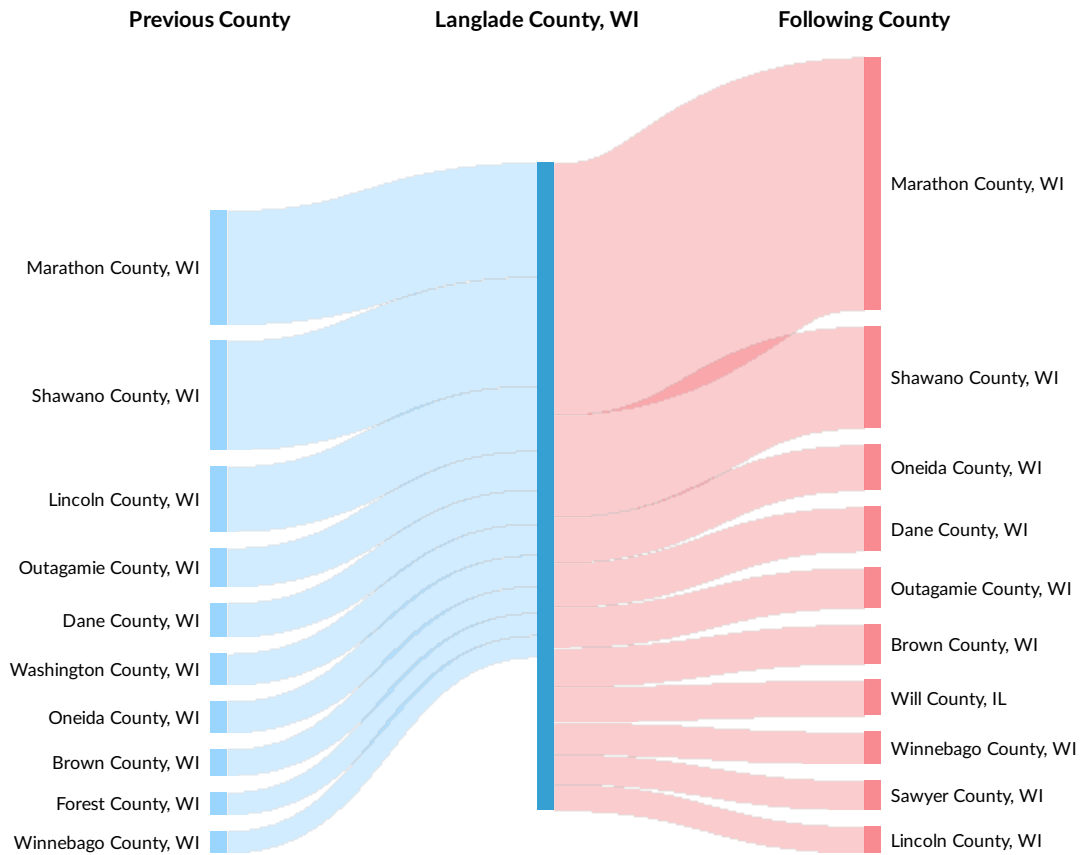

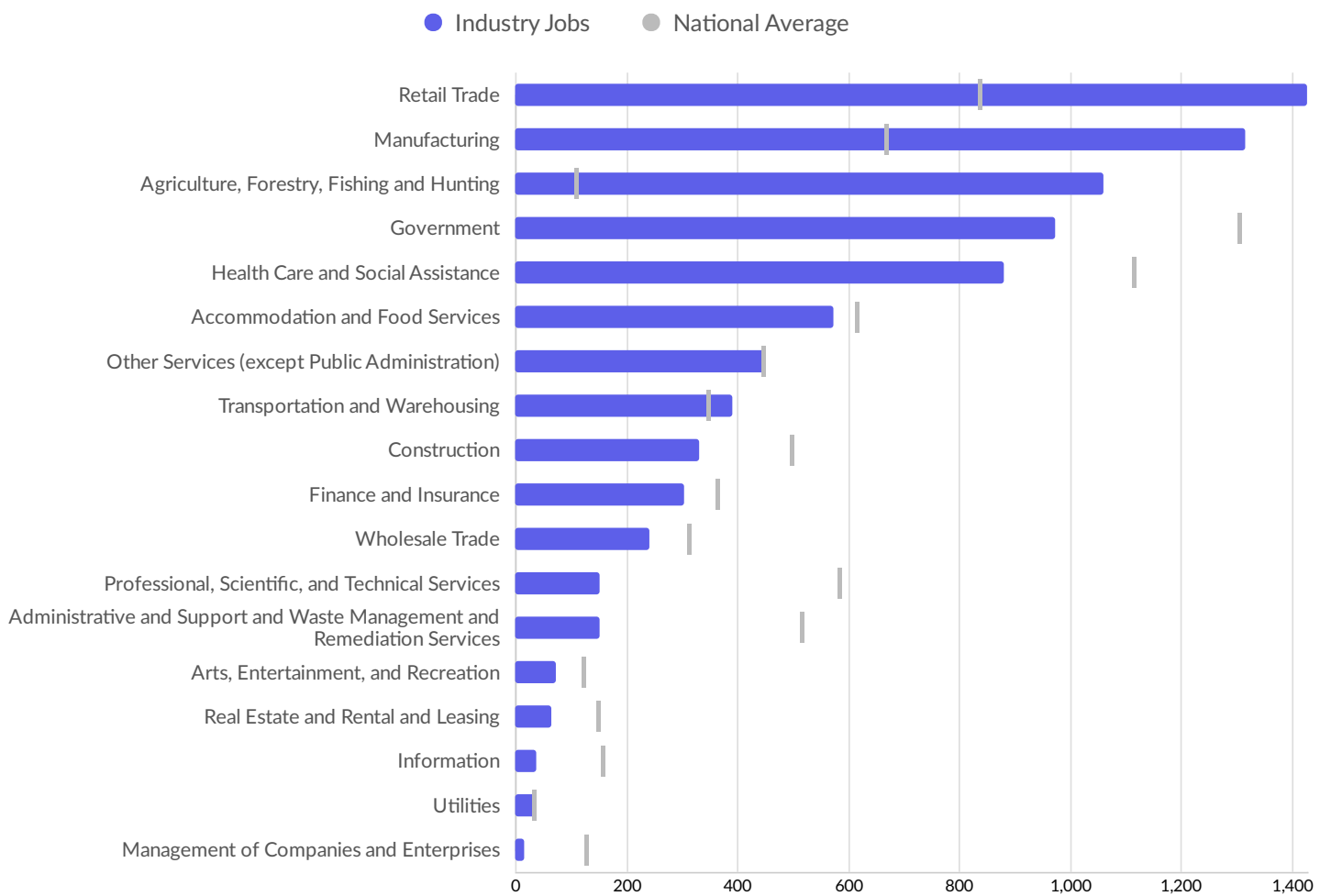

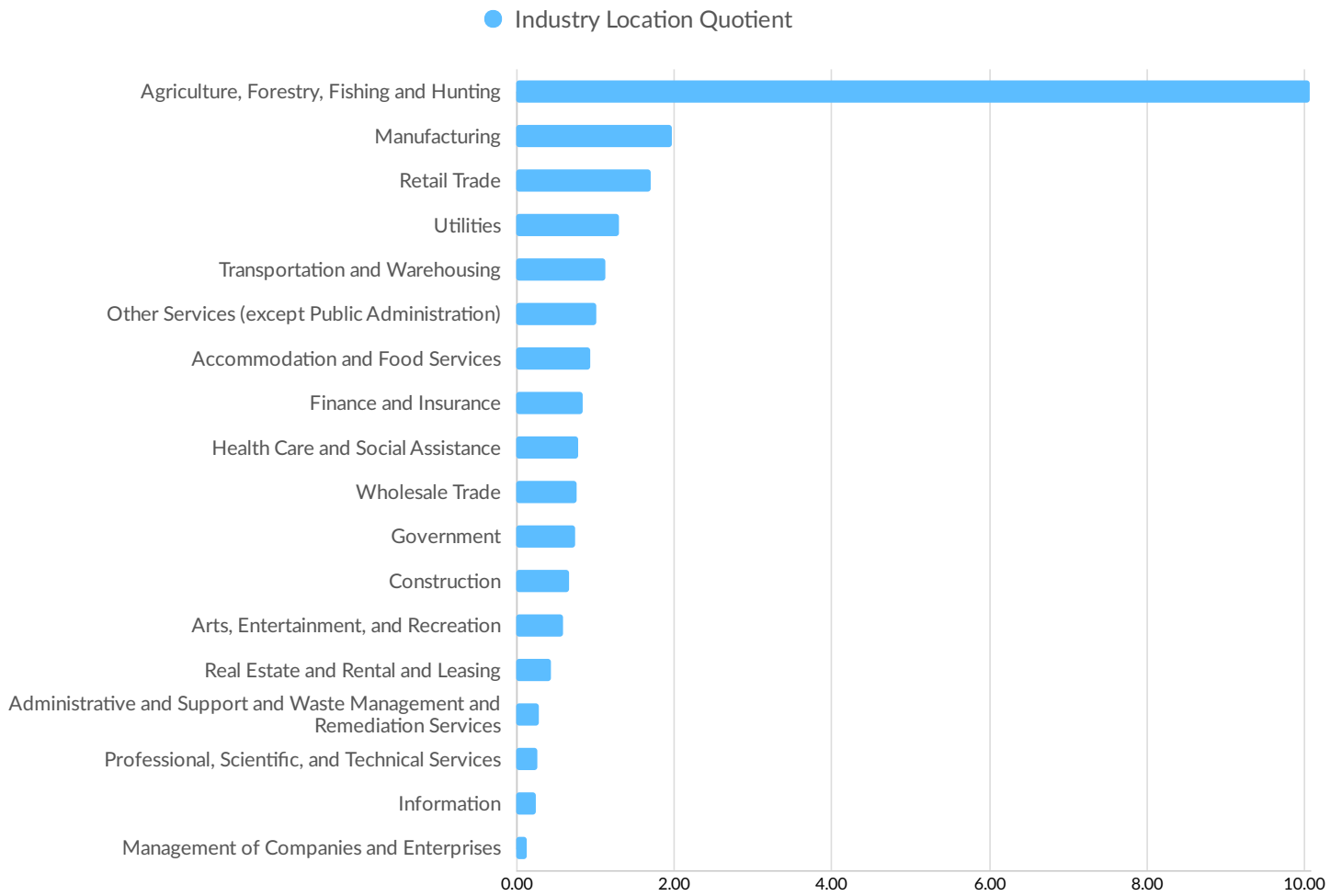

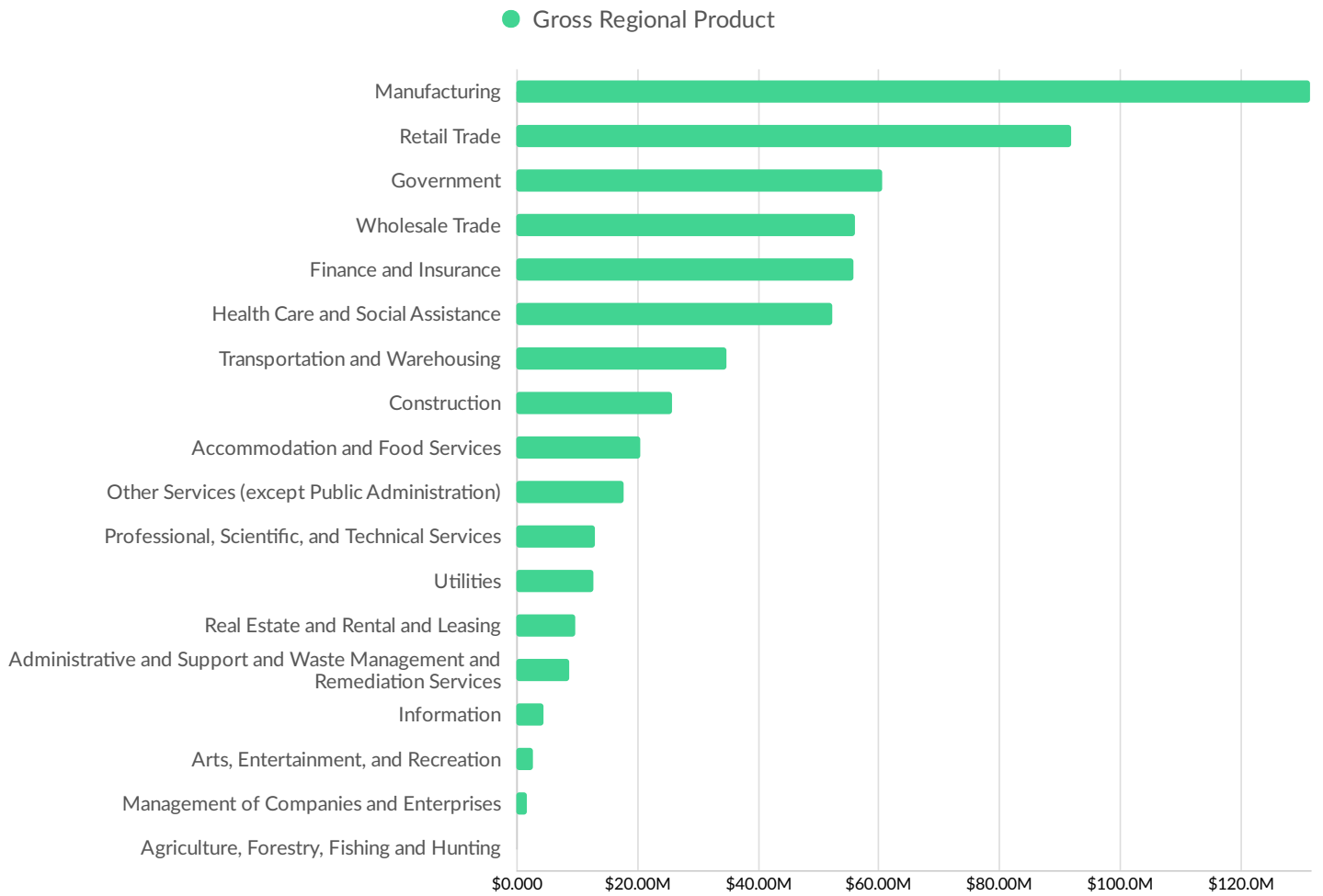
Top Growing Industries



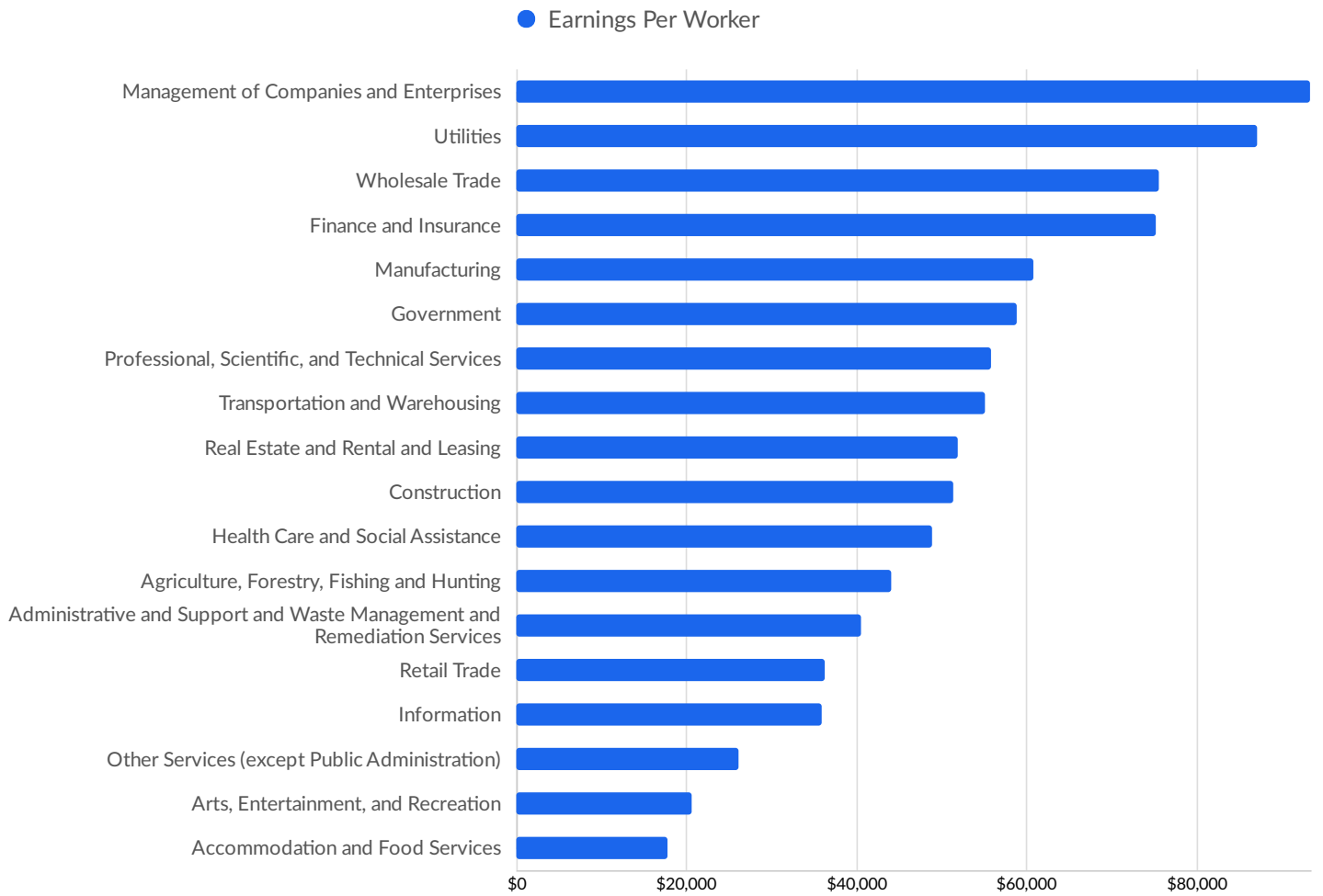
Top Industry Location Quotient

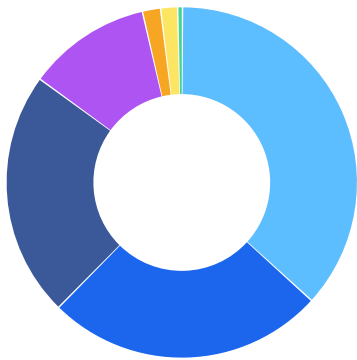

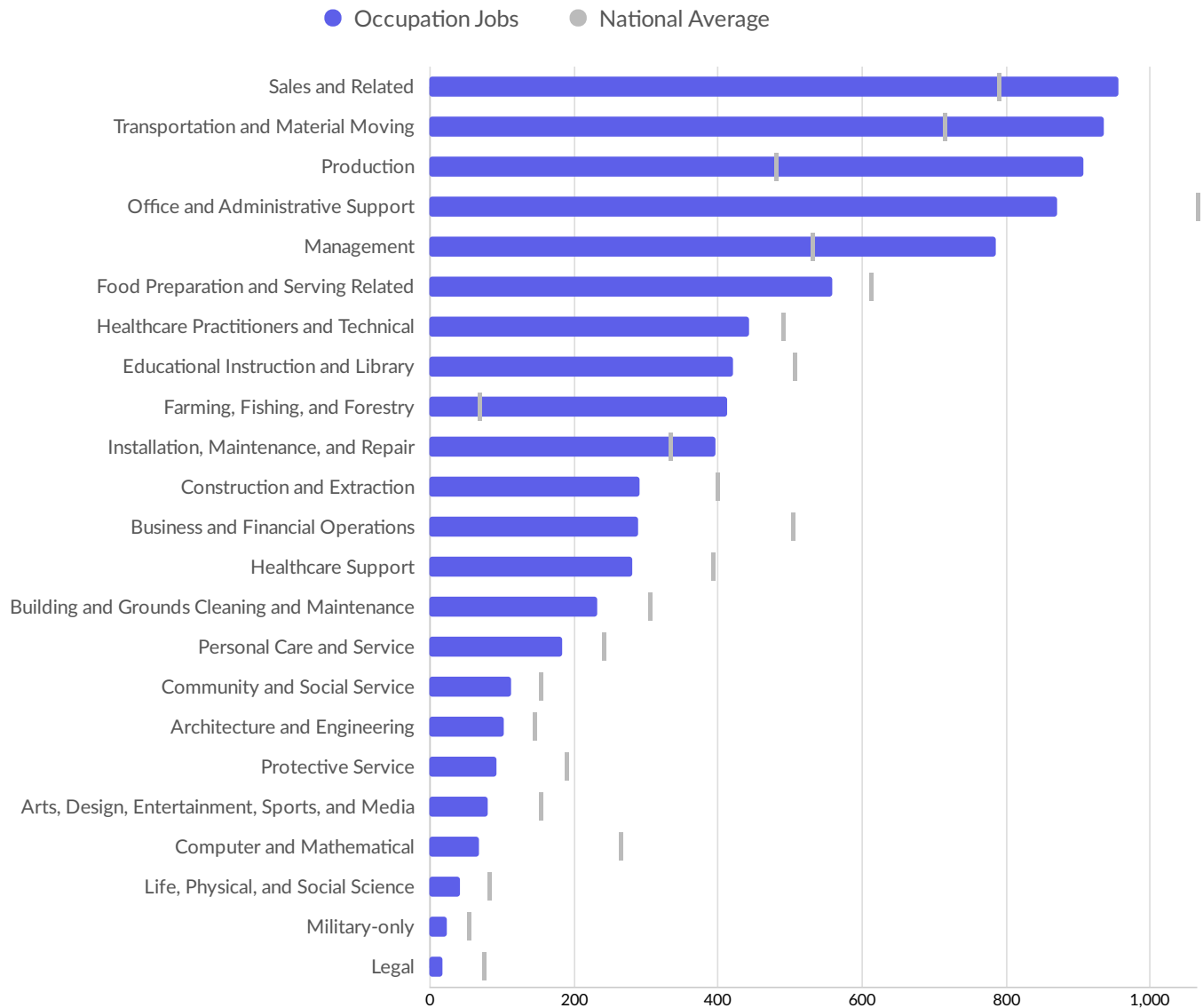

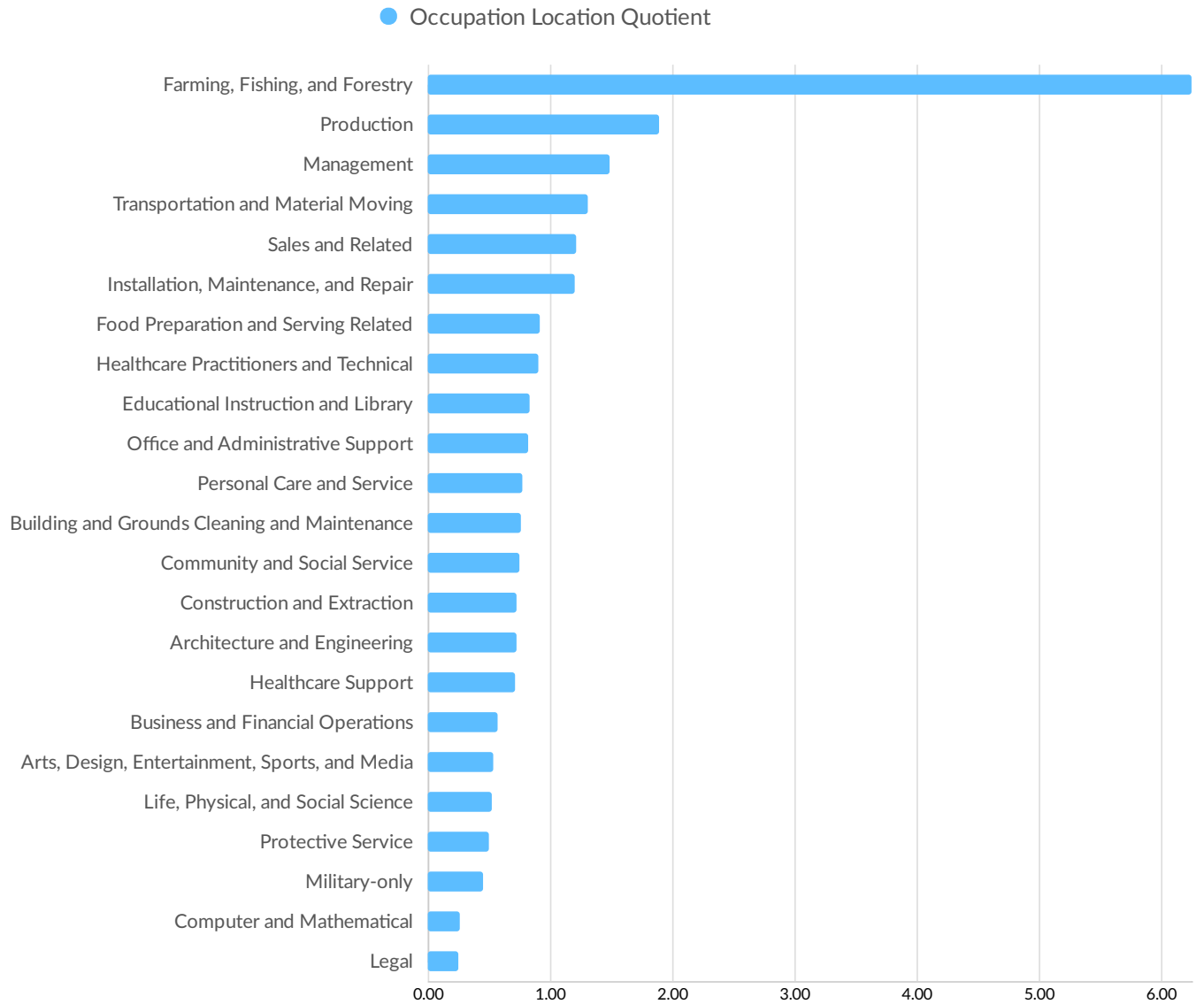
Largest Occupations



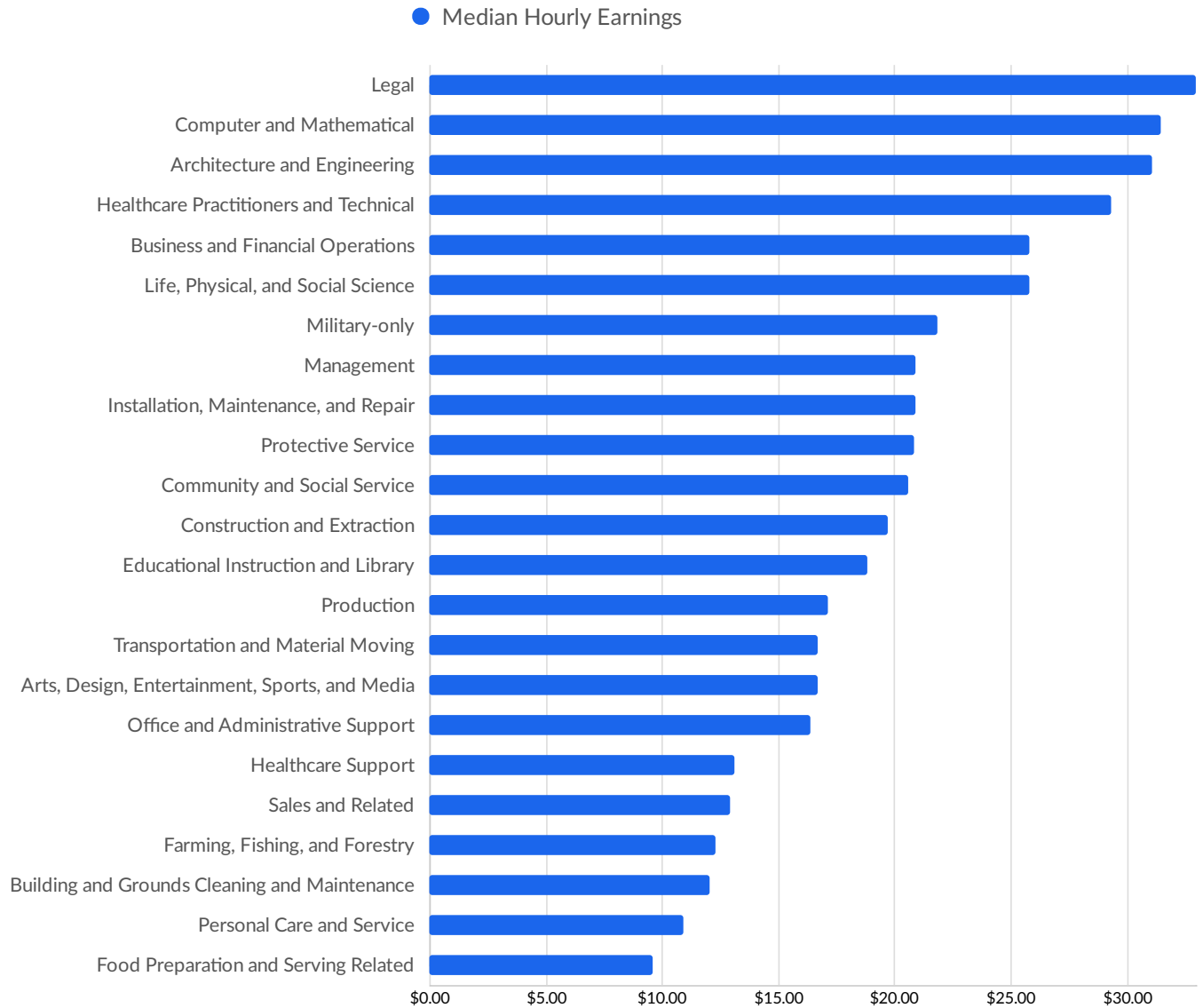
Top Growing Occupations



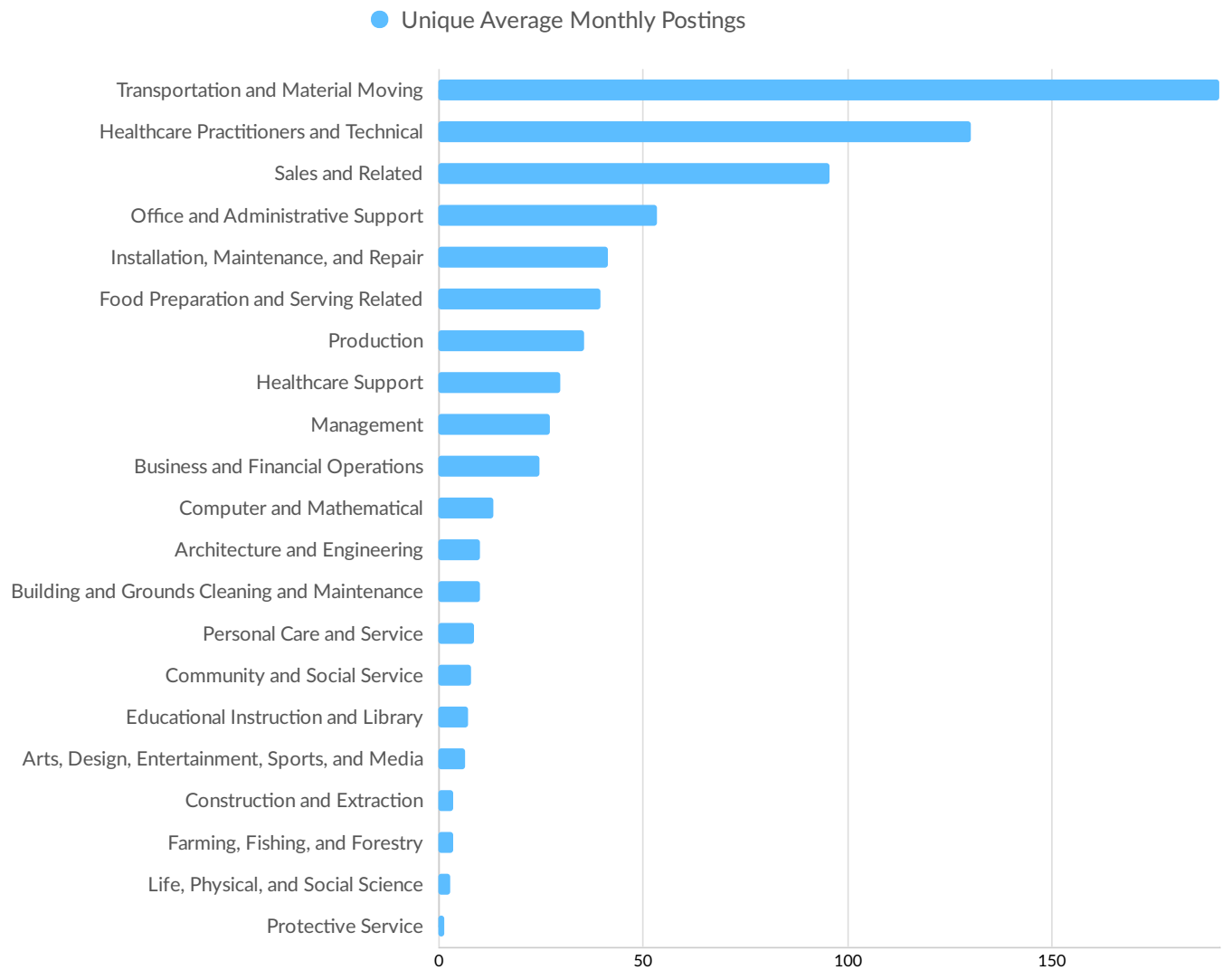
Top Occupation Location Quotient



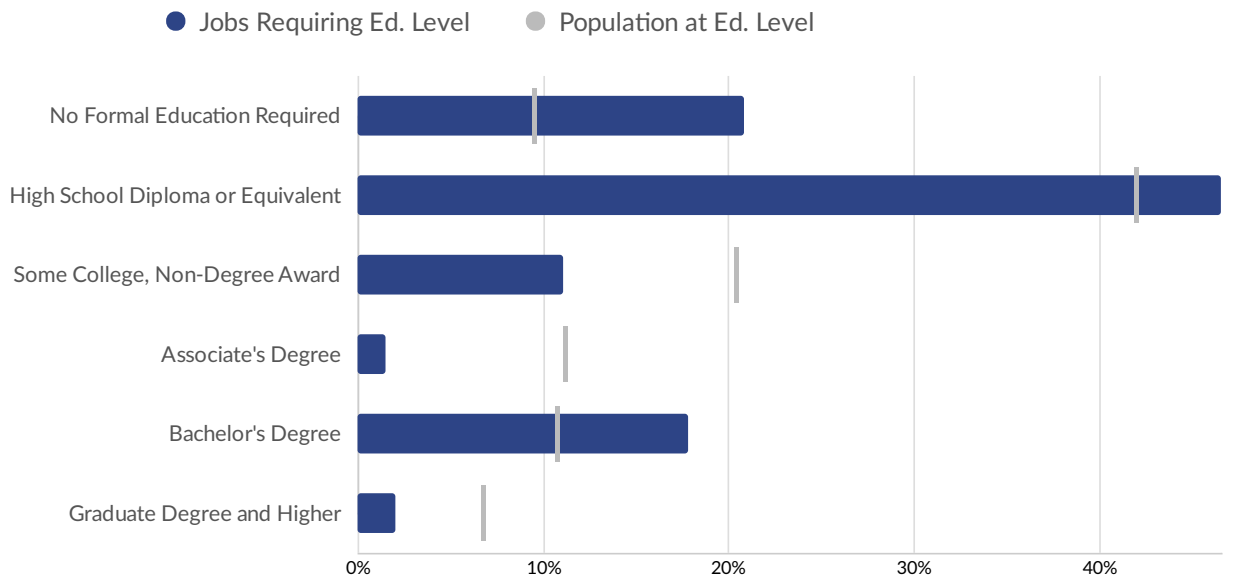
