Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population **increased by 1.3**% since 2015, growing by 444. Population is expected to **increase by 0.8**% between 2020 and 2025, adding 287.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 7.2% in Oneida County, WI from 18,818 to 17,459. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 0.0% by 7.2%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 61.9% to 58.5% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.8% of Oneida County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.3% below the national average), and **11.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.1% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity










Unemployment Rate Trends

Oneida County, WI had a September 2021 unemployment rate of 3.34%, decreasing from 4.75% 5 years before.






Oneida County, WI has 5,253 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this






Oneida County, WI has 2,980 veterans. The national average for

an area this size is 1.977.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Oneida County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 10,640 people 55 or older, while there are 16,548 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Oneida County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 14,400 racially diverse people, while there are 1,920 here.




Property Crime






Top Industry Location Quotient








Top Industry GRP




