




Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity





As of 2020 the region's population increased by 4.2% since 2015, growing by 901. Population is expected to increase by 3.5% between 2020 and 2025, adding 793.








Unemployment Rate Trends

Vilas County, WI had a September 2021 unemployment rate of 3.84%, decreasing from 5.57% 5 years before.






Millennials

Vilas County, WI has 2,721 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,607.




Veterans

Vilas County, WI has 2,059 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,230.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Vilas County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,654 people 55 or older, while there are 11,391 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Vilas County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 9,005 racially diverse people, while there are 3,272 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Location Quotient






Top Industry GRP





Top Occupation Location Quotient









