- As of 2021 the region's population increased by 0.3% since 2016, growing by 990. Population is expected to increase by 0.1% between 2021 and 2026, adding 236.
- From 2016 to 2021, jobs declined by 3.9% in Centergy from 176,529 to 169,563. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 0.4% by 3.5%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 65.1% to 63.8% between 2016 and 2021.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.4% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.9% below the national average), and **12.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2021 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity





As of 2021 the region's population increased by 0.3% since 2016, growing by 990. Population is expected to increase by 0.1% between 2021 and 2026, adding 236.




















Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Location Quotient






Top Industry GRP








