

- From 2016 to 2021, jobs increased by 3.0% in Vilas County, WI from 9,088 to 9,360. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 0.4% by 3.4%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 51.6% to 51.7% between 2016 and 2021.
- Concerning educational attainment, 19.9% of Vilas County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (0.4% below the national average), and 10.1% hold an Associate's Degree (1.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2021 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).



Educational Attainment






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends




Unemployment Rate Trends

Vilas County, WI had a November 2021 unemployment rate of 2.33%, decreasing from 5.57% 5 years before.






Millennials

millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,607.






Vilas County, WI has 2,059 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1.230.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Vilas County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,654 people 55 or older, while there are 11,391 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Vilas County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 9,005 racially diverse people, while there are 3,272 here.




Property Crime






Top Industry Location Quotient








Top Industry GRP





Top Occupation Location Quotient









