

- As of 2021 the region's population **declined by 0.8**% since 2016, falling by 229. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.0**% between 2021 and 2026, losing 11.
- From 2016 to 2021, jobs declined by 5.3% in Lincoln County, WI from 12,091 to 11,454. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 0.7% by 6.0%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 65.9% to 64.4% between 2016 and 2021.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.6% of Lincoln County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.7% below the national average), and **13.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2021 are Insurance Carriers, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

Educational Attainment






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Unemployment Rate Trends

Lincoln County, WI had a March 2022 unemployment rate of 3.65%, increasing from 3.52% 5 years before.






Millennials

Lincoln County, WI has 4,304 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,681.




Veterans

Lincoln County, WI has 2,051 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,532.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Lincoln County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,204 people 55 or older, while there are 11,315 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Lincoln County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 11,103 racially diverse people, while there are 1,471 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Location Quotient






Top Industry GRP





Largest Occupations






Top Growing Occupations





Top Occupation Location Quotient









