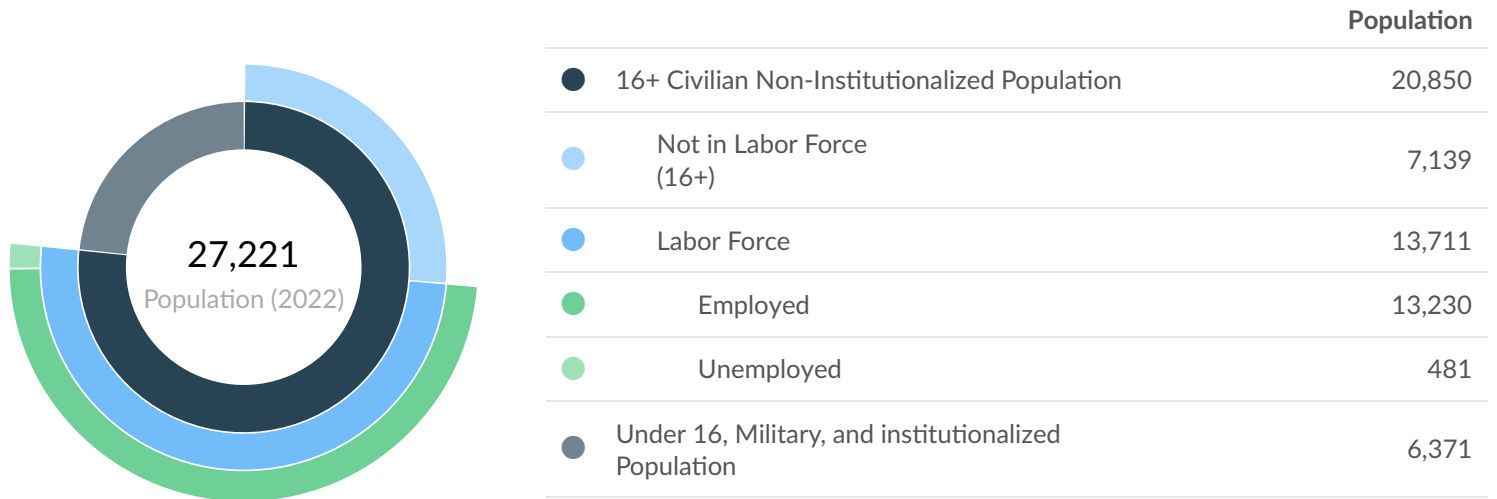
Median household income is **\$11.1K below** the national median household income of \$65.0K.

Takeaways

- As of 2021 the region's population **increased by 2.8%** since 2016, growing by 738. Population is expected to **increase by 2.3%** between 2021 and 2026, adding 636.
- From 2016 to 2021, jobs **declined by 1.2%** in Juneau County, WI from 10,503 to **10,382**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 1.8% by 3.0%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 66.5% to 64.5% between 2016 and 2021**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.0% of Juneau County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.3% below the national average), and **10.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.1% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2021 are State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

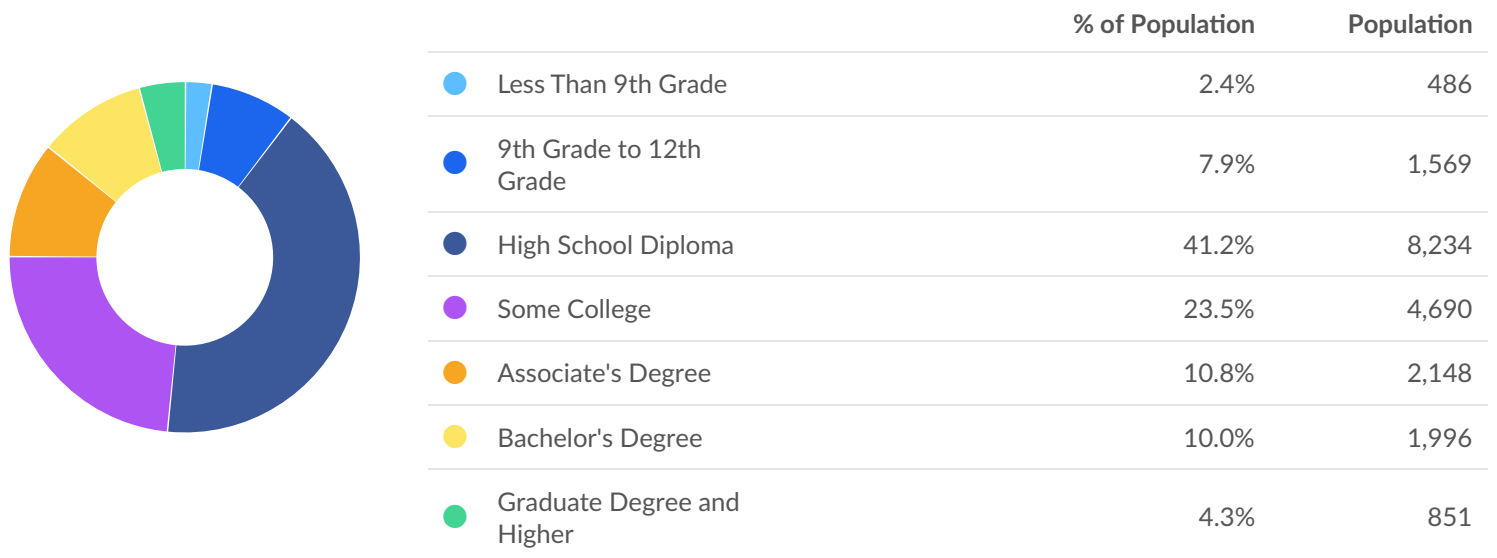

Jun 2022 Labor Force Breakdown



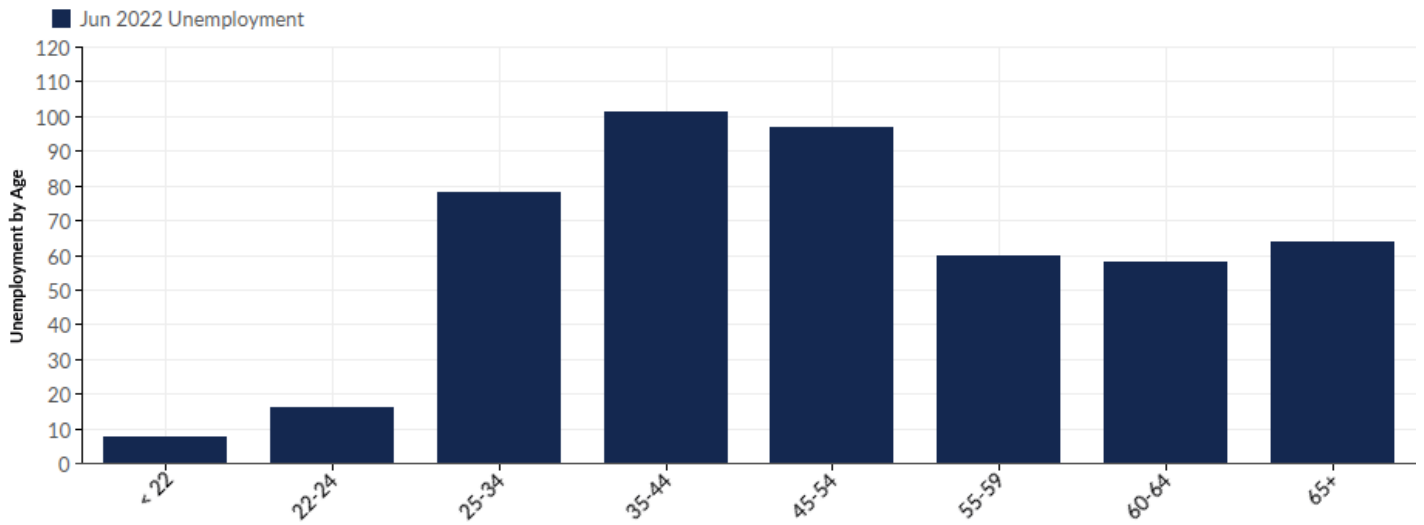
Educational Attainment

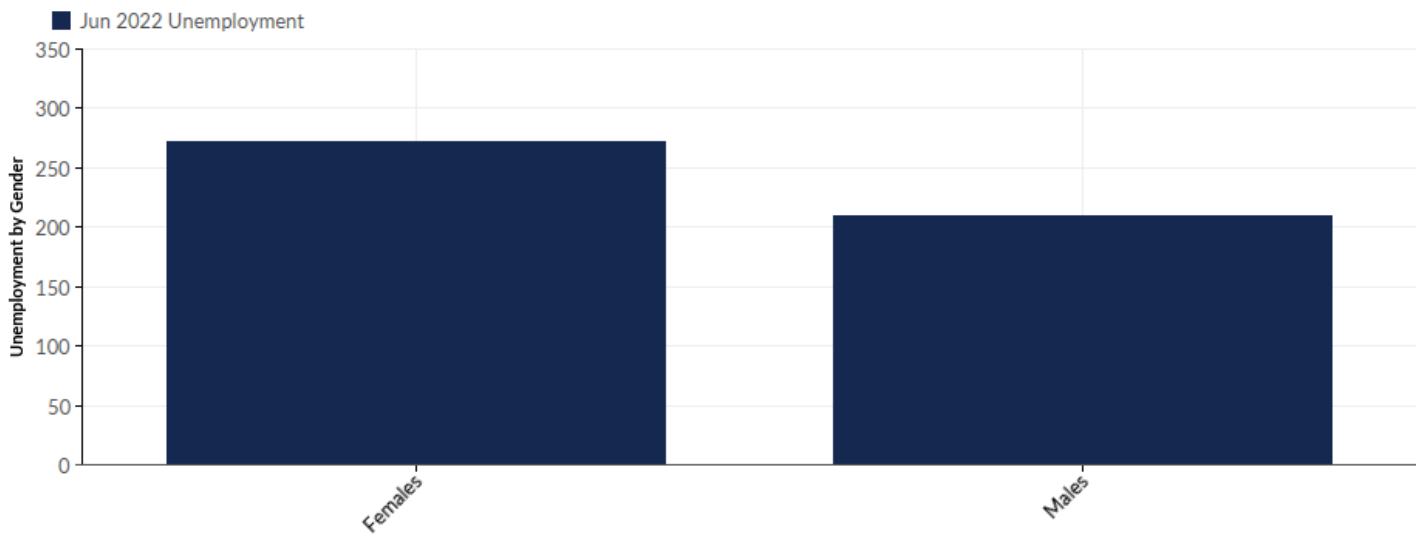

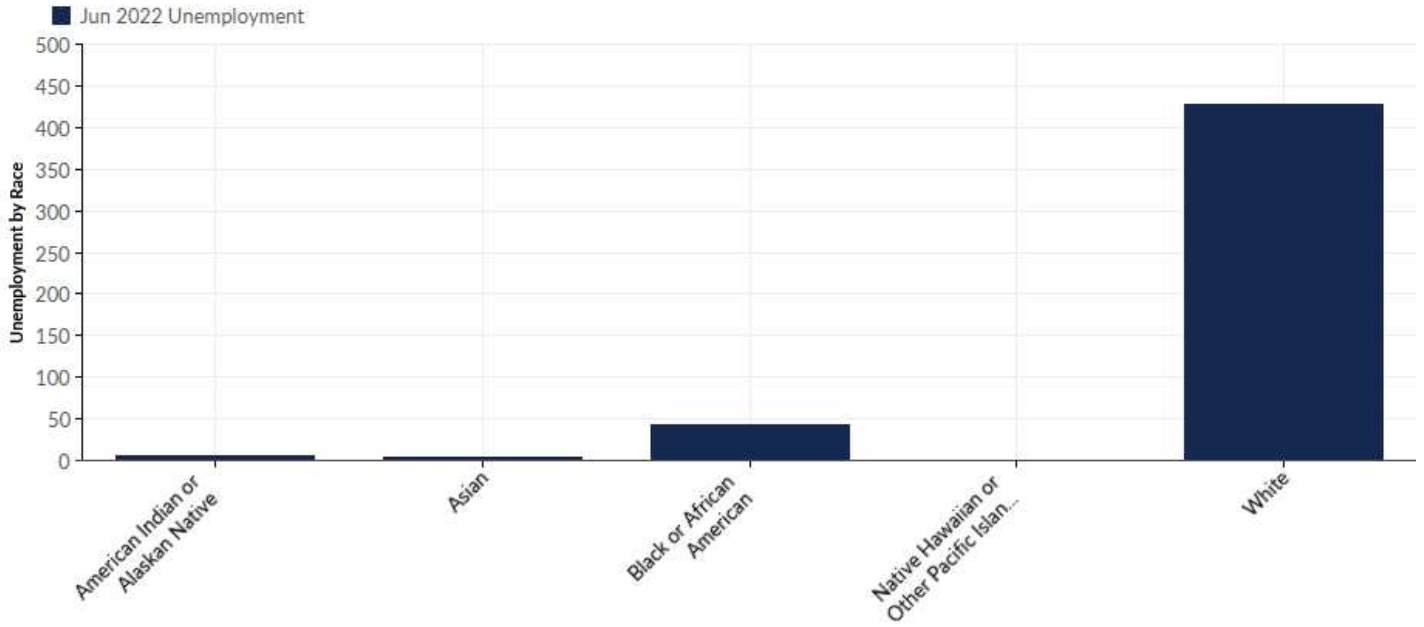

Unemployment by Gender



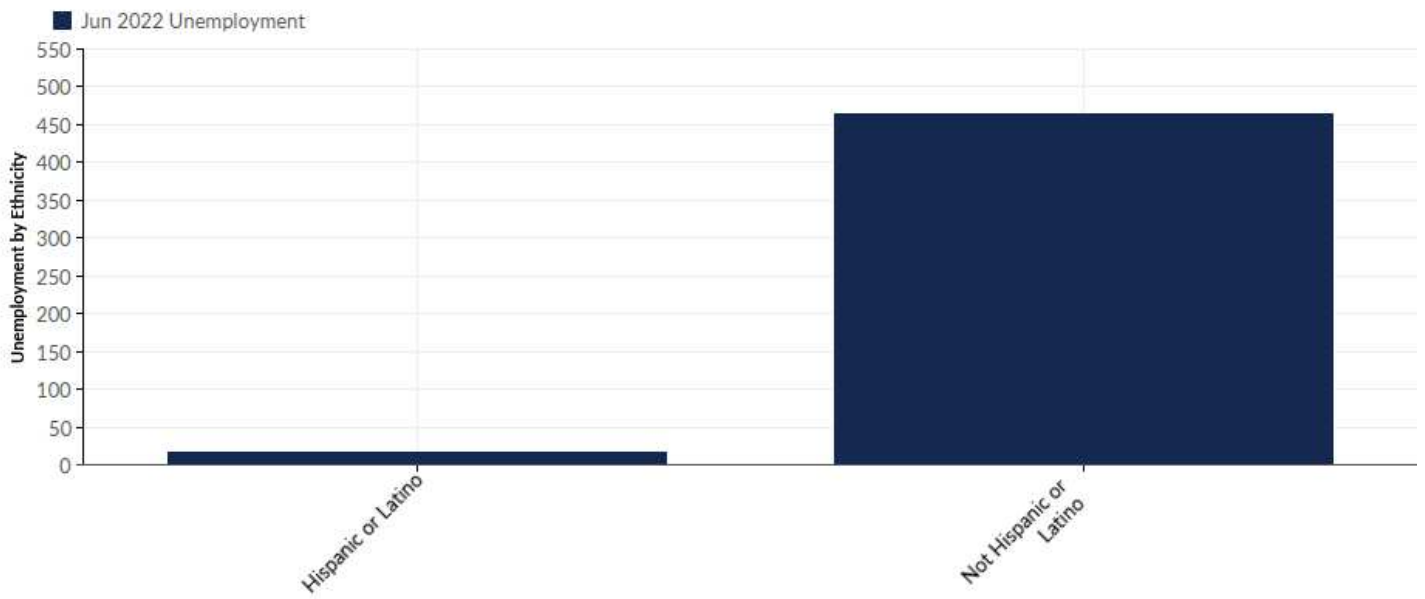

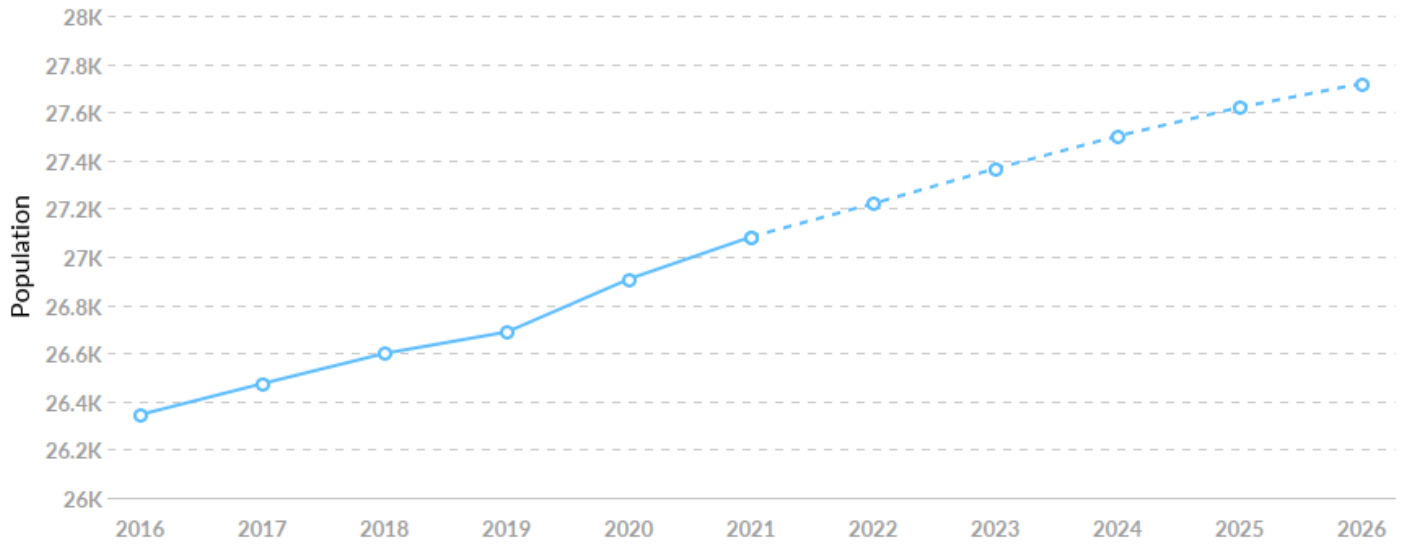

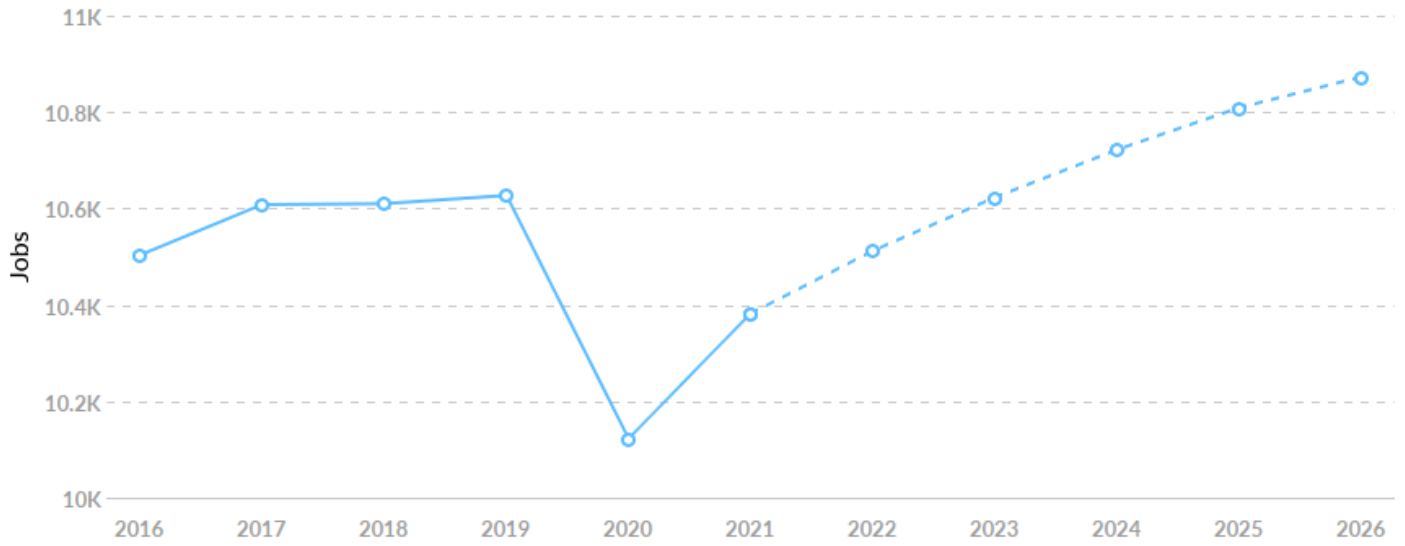

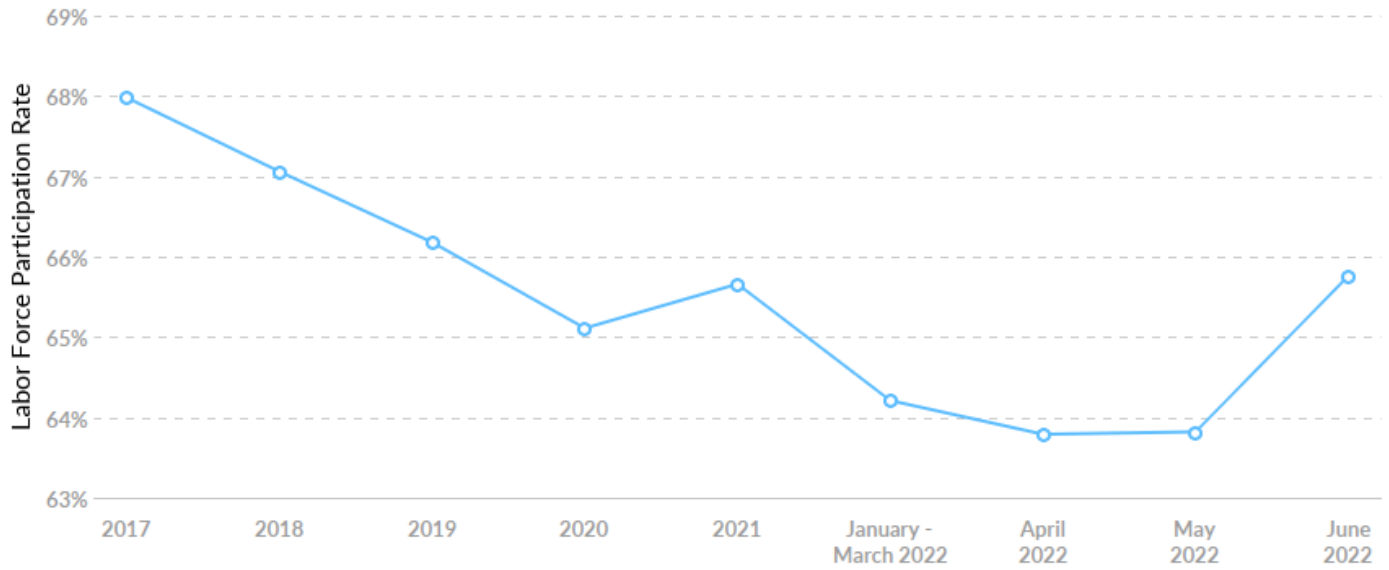
Job Trends

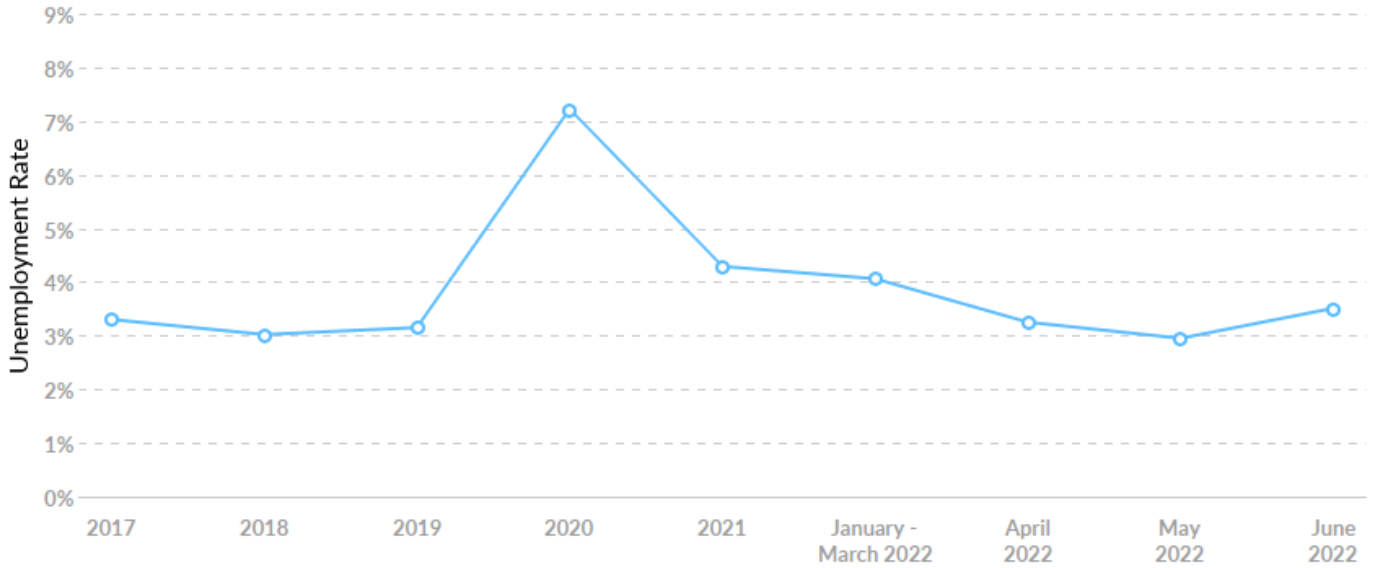

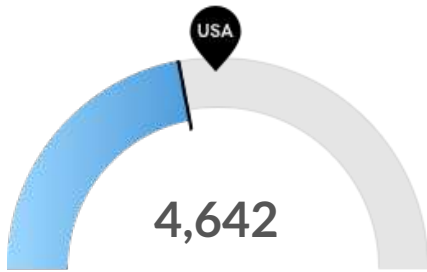
Unemployment Rate Trends

Juneau County, WI had a June 2022 unemployment rate of 3.51%, **increasing from 3.30%** 5 years before.



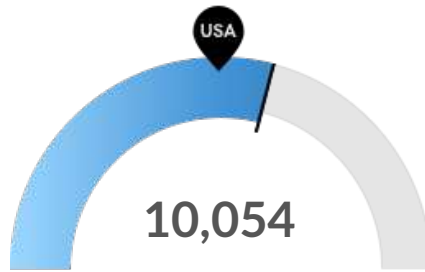

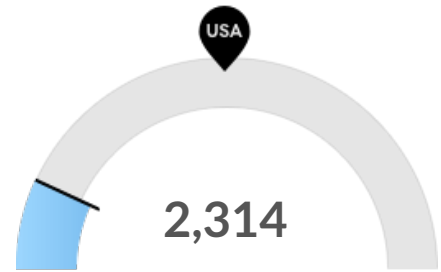
Millennials

Juneau County, WI has 4,642 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,545.



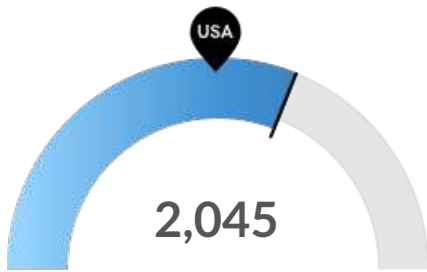
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Juneau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,009 people 55 or older, while there are 10,054 here.



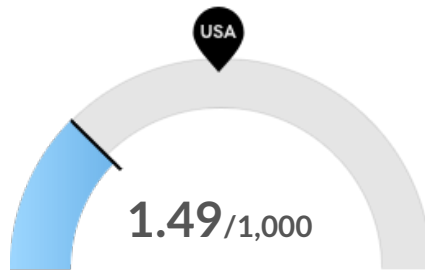
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Juneau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 10,838 racially diverse people, while there are 2,314 here.



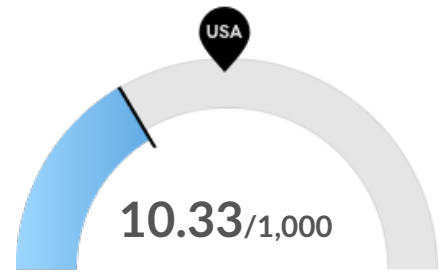
Veterans

Juneau County, WI has 1.49 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.62 per 1,000 people.

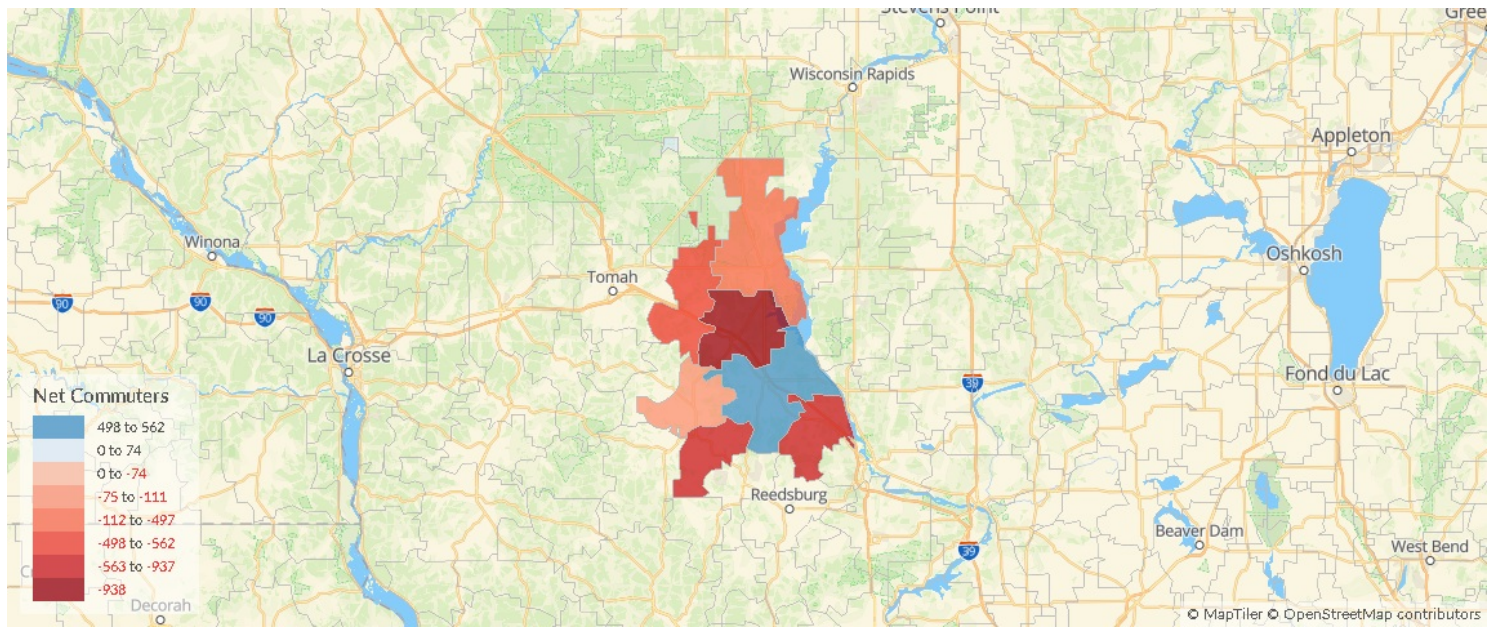


Property Crime

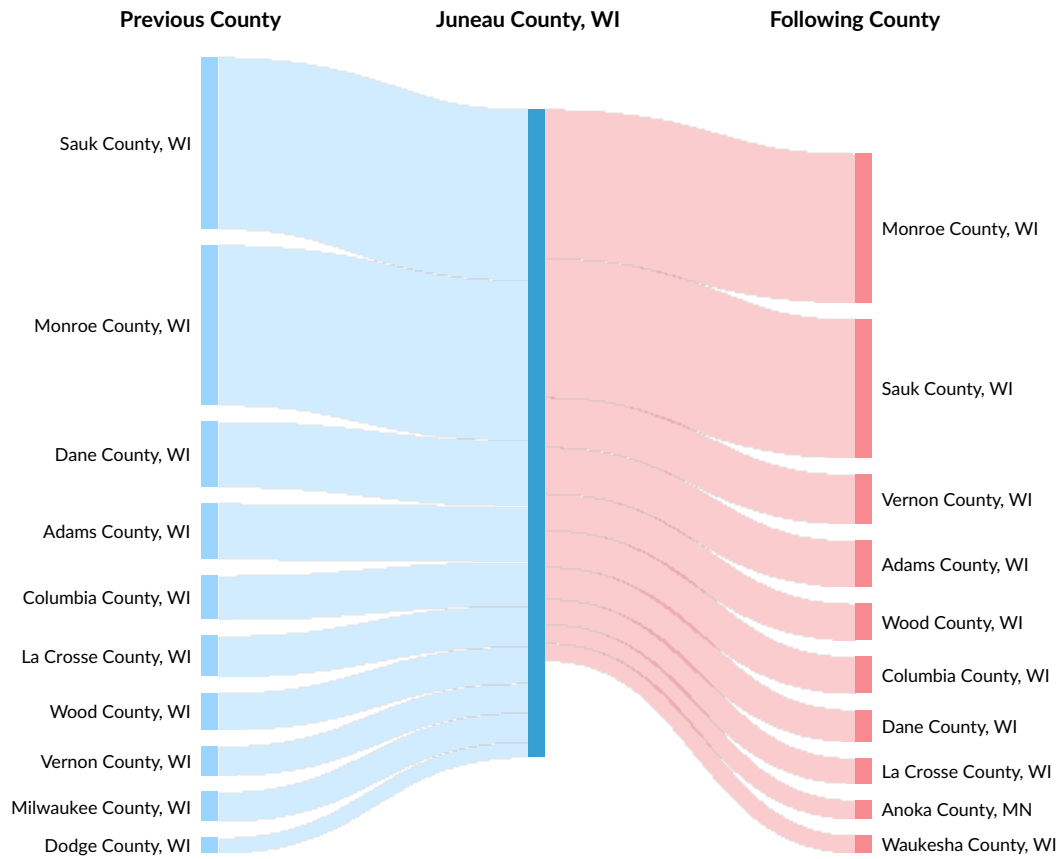

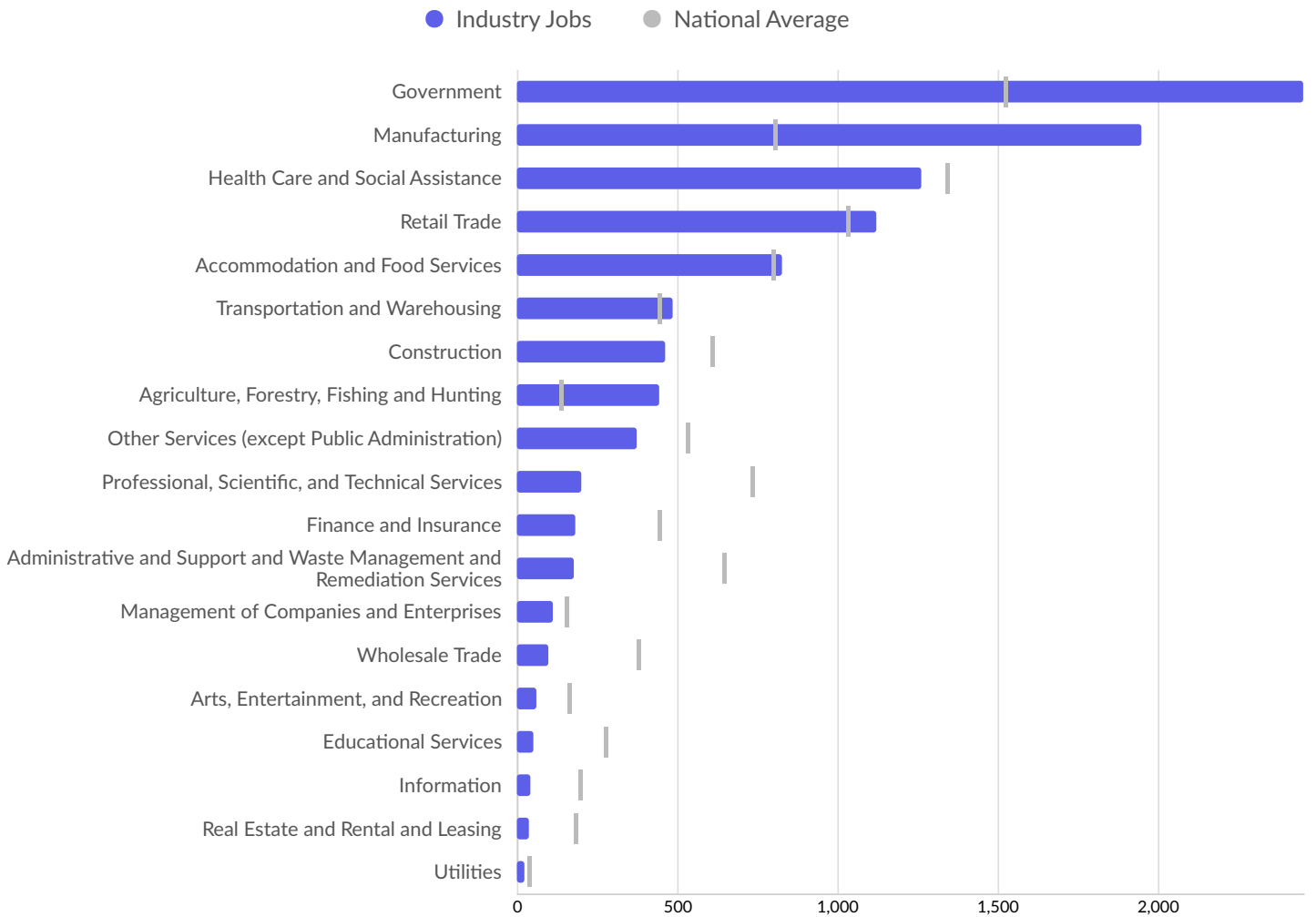

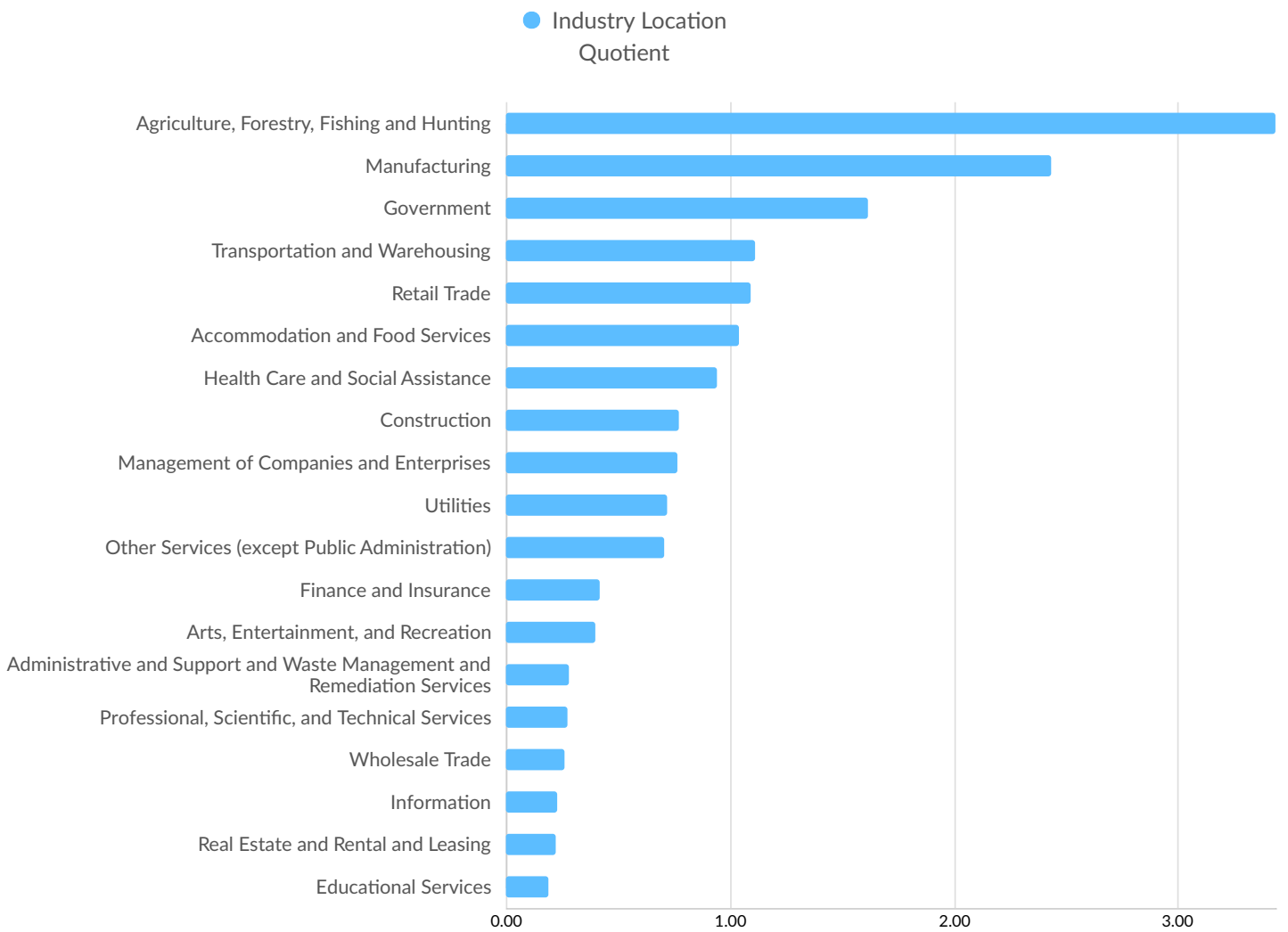

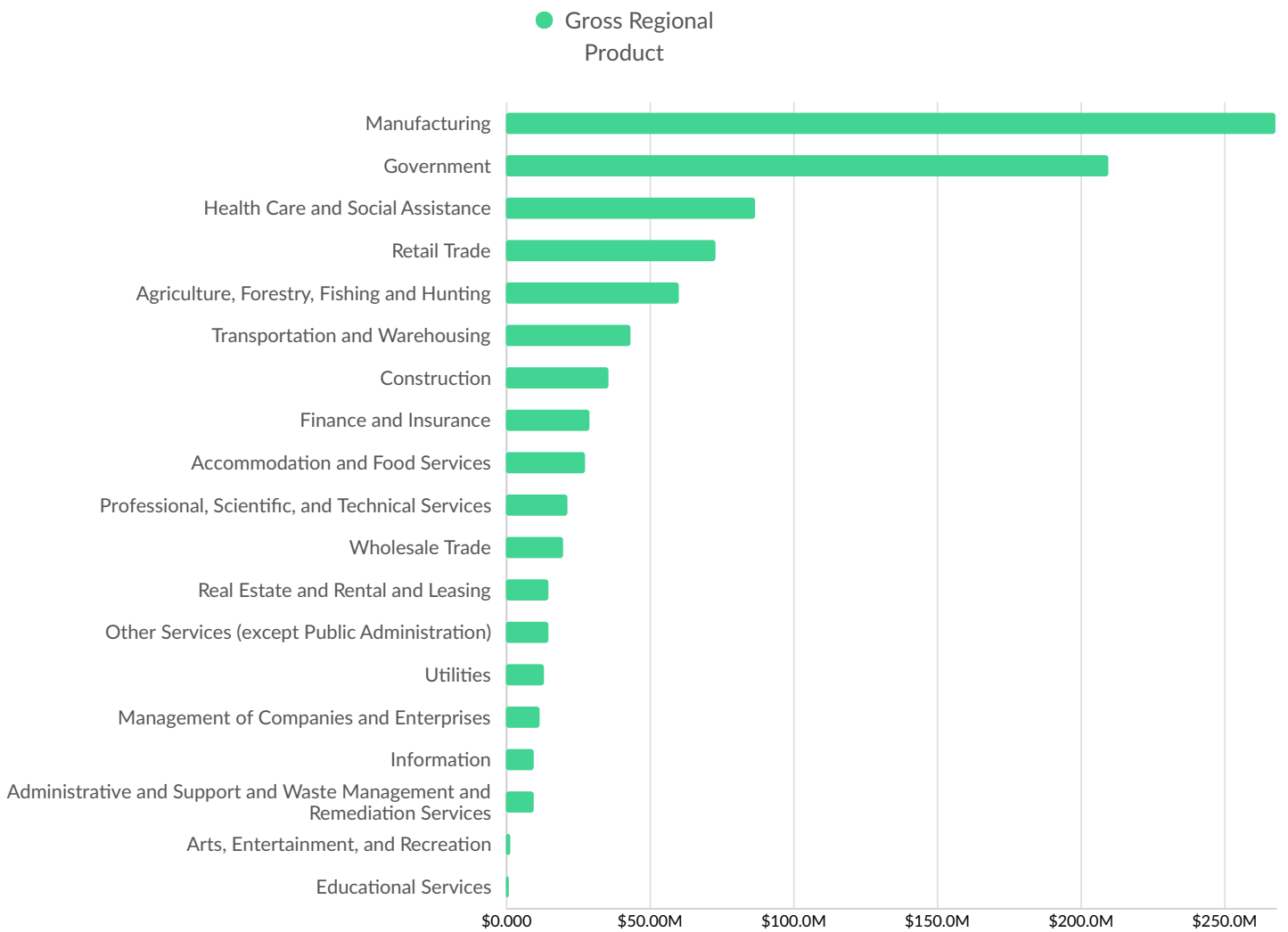
Top Growing Industries



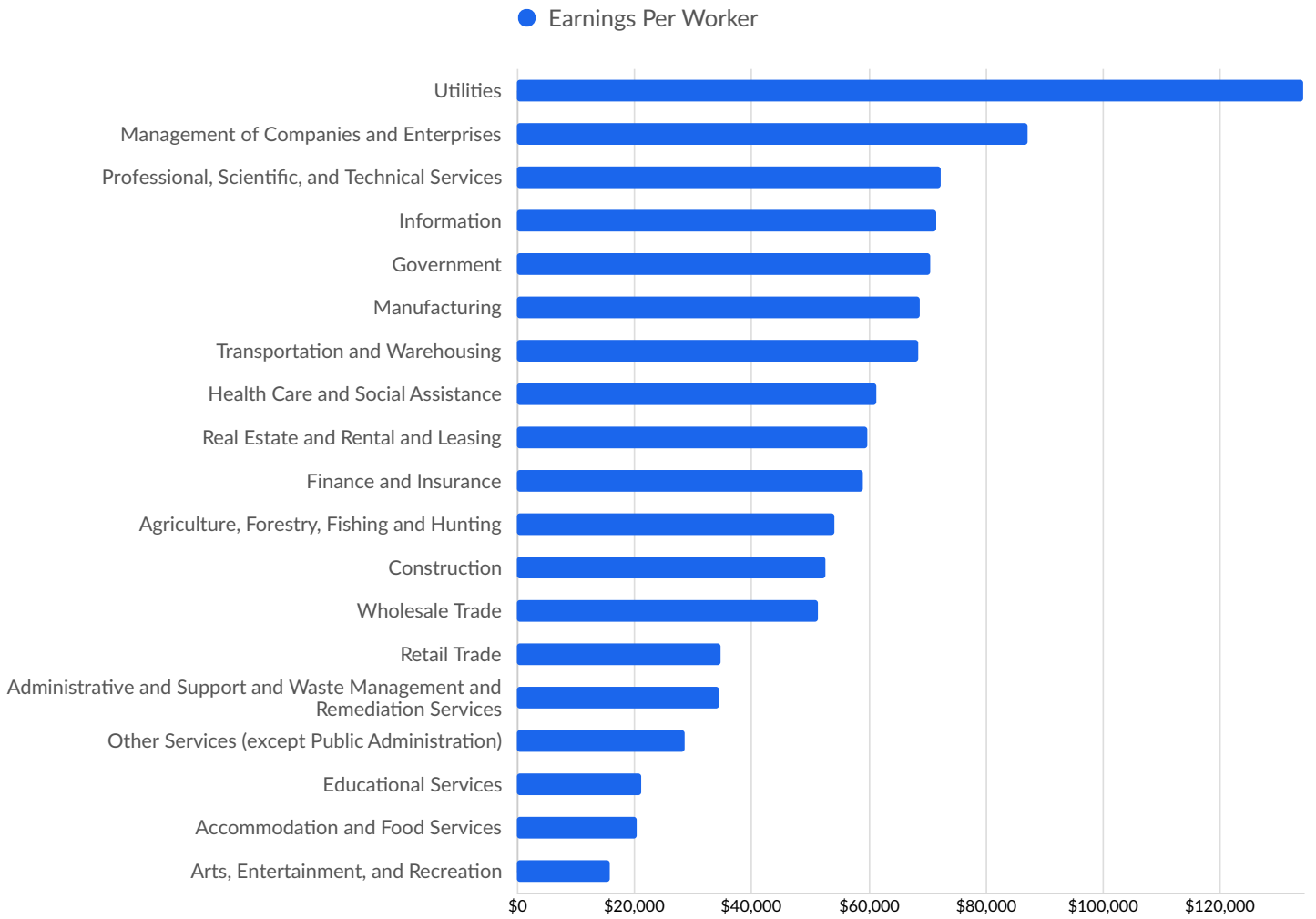
Top Industry Location Quotient

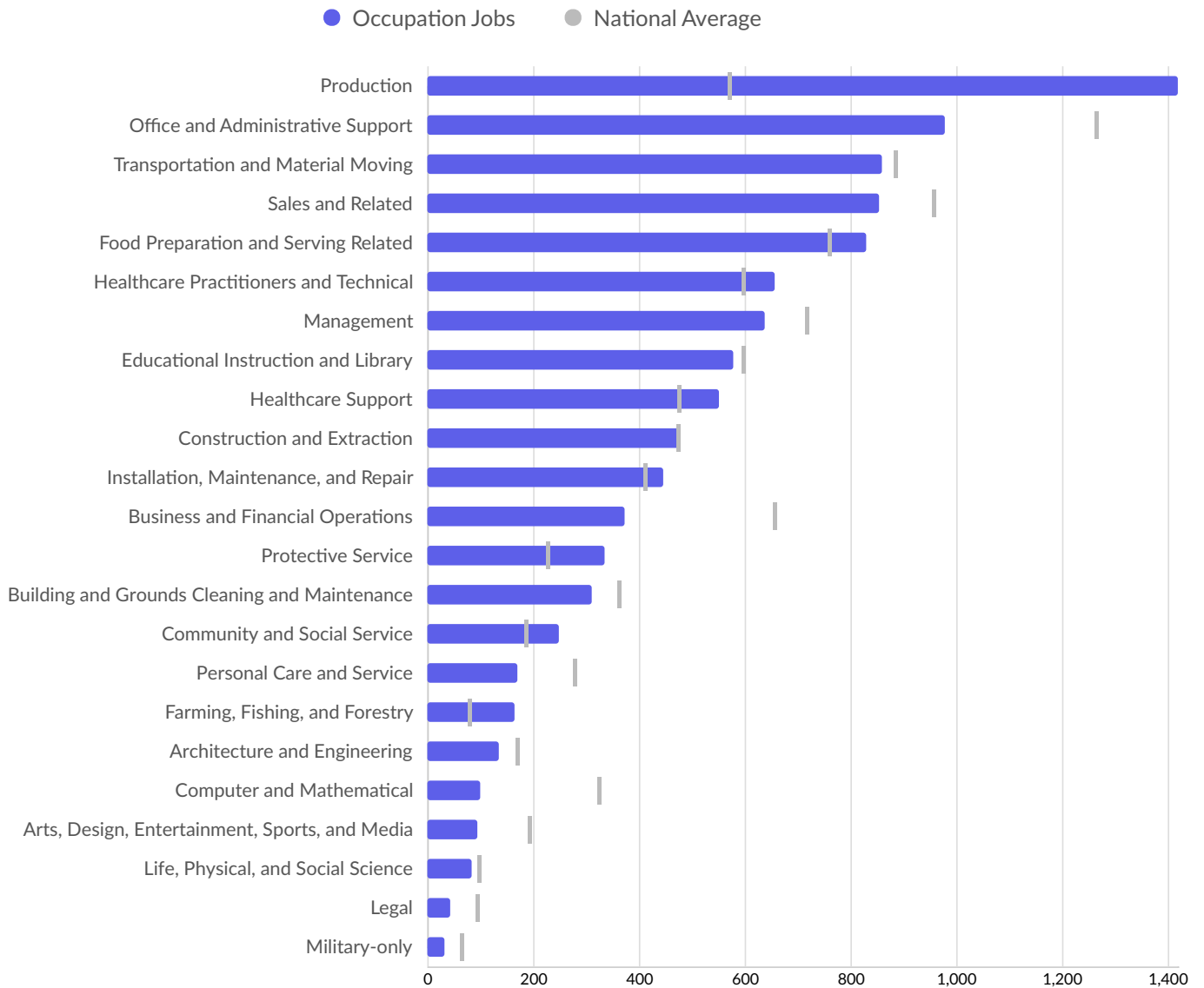

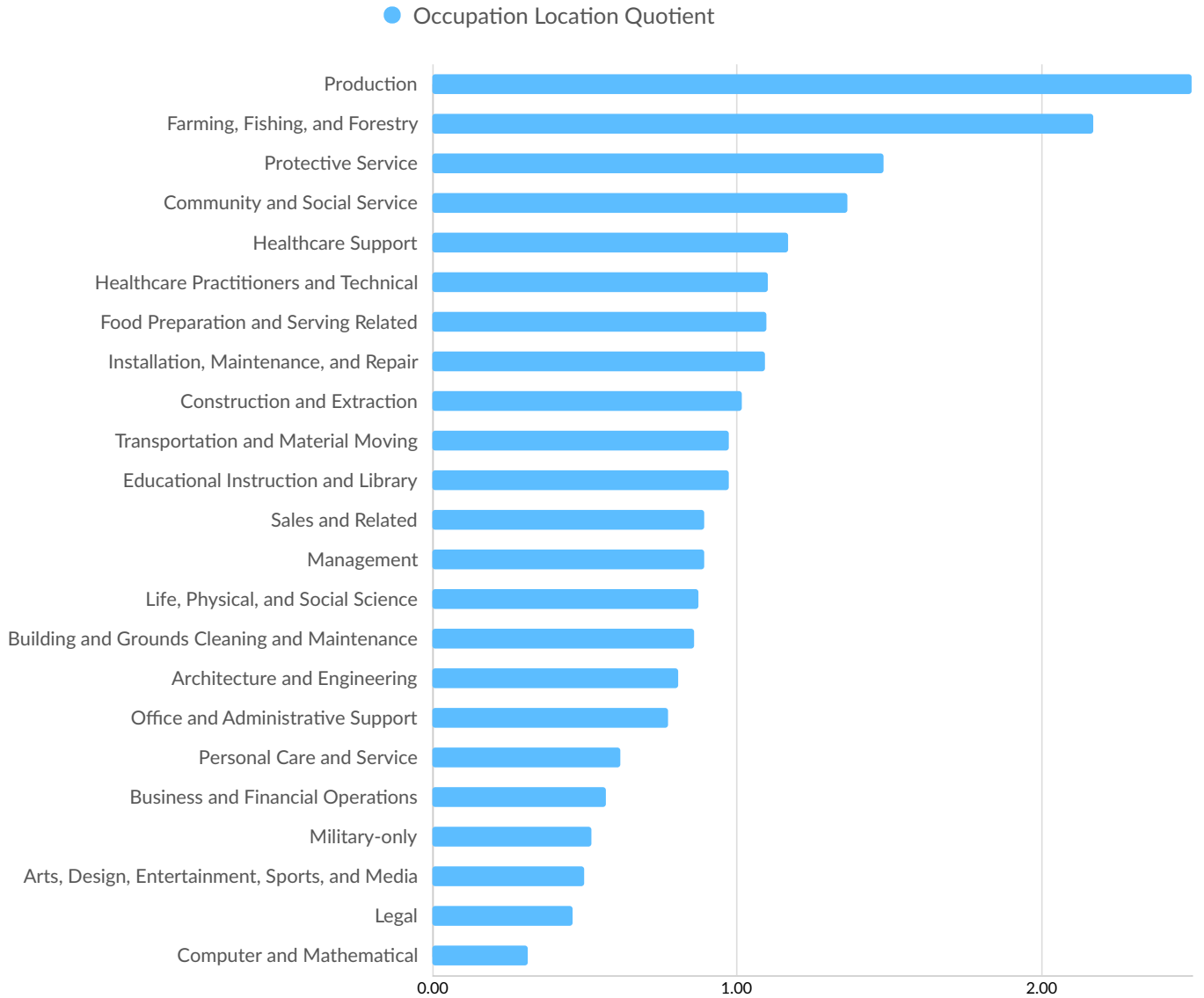

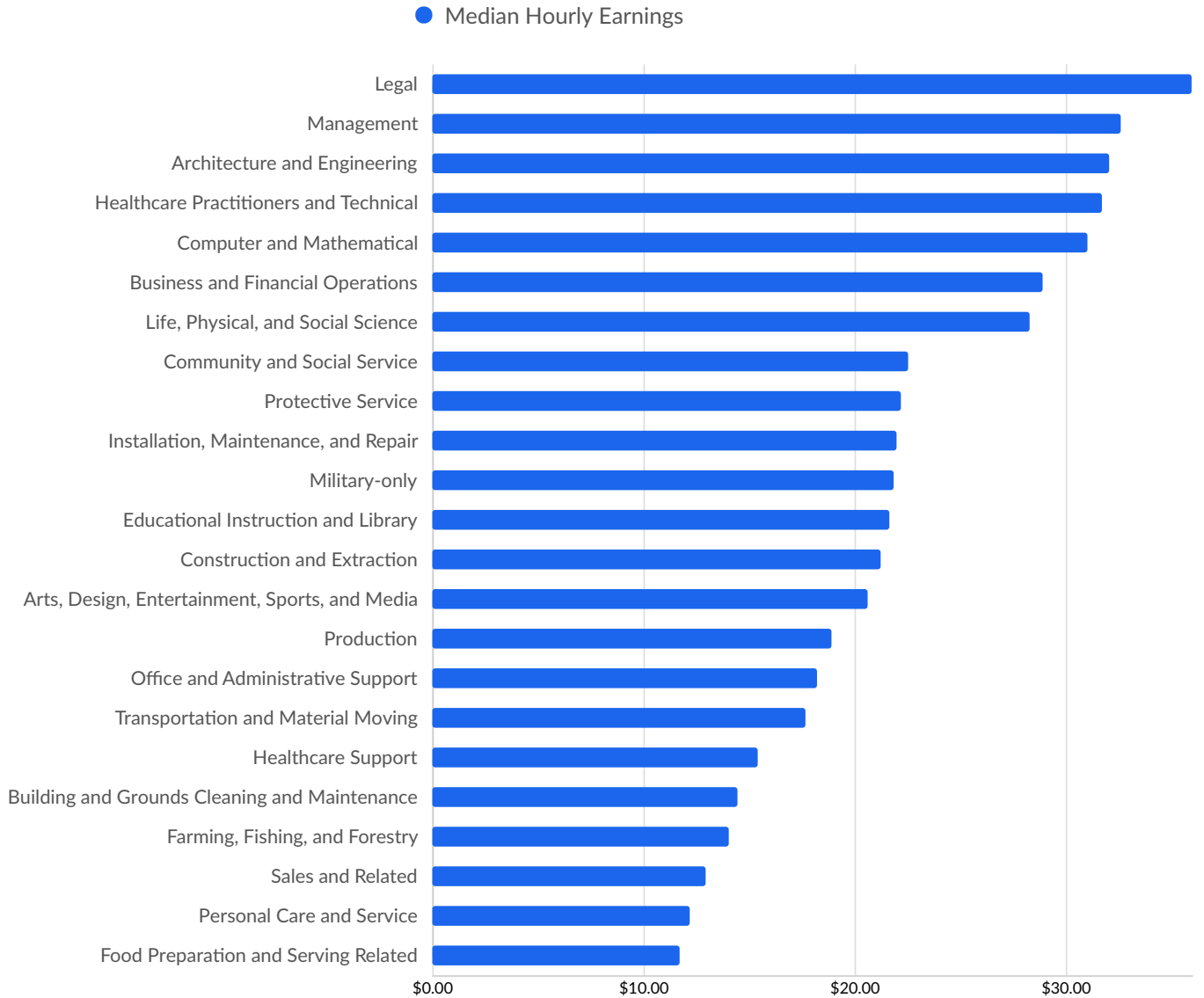
Top Growing Occupations



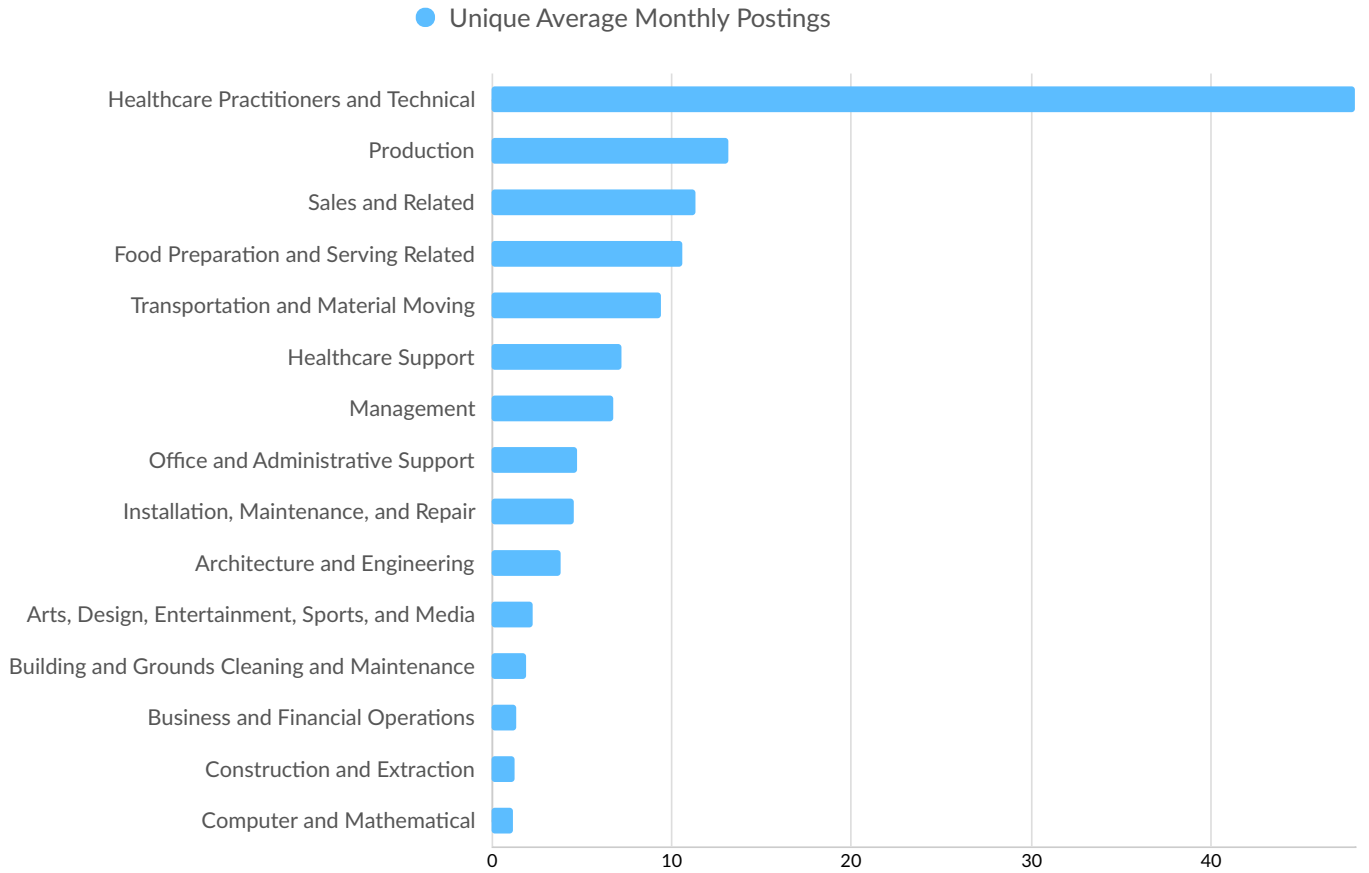
Top Occupation Location Quotient



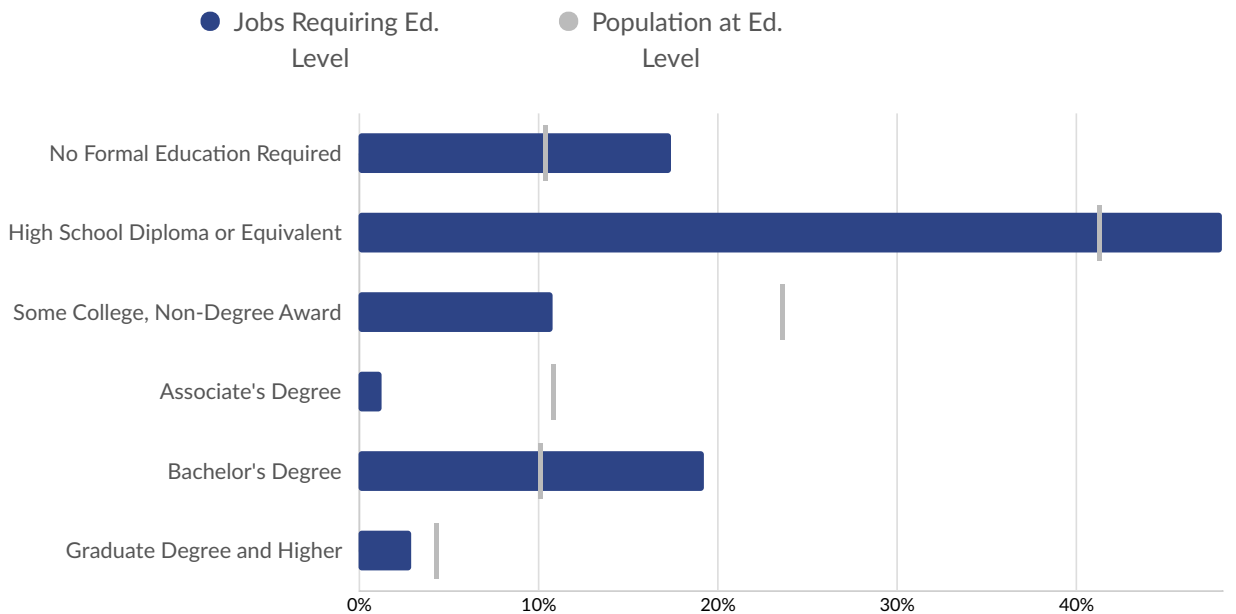
