Jobs decreased by 751 over the last 5 years and are projected to decrease by 82 over the next 5 years. \$51.9K

Median household income is **\$17.1K below** the national median household income of \$69.0K.

Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 6.1% since 2017, growing by 1,213. Population is expected to increase by 4.0% between 2022 and 2027, adding 839.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 13.6% in Adams County, WI from 5,517 to 4,766. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 2.4% by 16.0%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 49.2% to 42.2% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.1% of Adams County**, **WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.8% below the national average), and **8.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Crop Production, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).







Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity









Unemployment Rate Trends


Adams County, WI had a December 2022 unemployment rate of 4.95%, decreasing from 5.05% 5 years before.



Adams County, WI has 2,998 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,264.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,205 people 55 or older, while there are 10,533 here. 2,200


Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,495 racially diverse people, while there are 2,200 here.




Veterans

Adams County, WI has 1.74 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime










Top Industry Location Quotient





Largest Occupations






Top Growing Occupations






Top Occupation Earnings



Median Hourly Earnings


