
#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 2.6% since 2017, growing by 500. Population is expected to increase by 3.4% between 2022 and 2027, adding 674.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 2.8% in Langlade County, WI from 8,429 to 8,189. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 2.4% by 5.2%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 61.7% to 55.0% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.2% of Langlade County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.6% below the national average), and **11.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Crop Production, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.











## **Unemployment by Ethnicity**







## **Job Trends**






Langlade County, WI had a December 2022 unemployment rate of 3.09%, decreasing from 4.18% 5 years before.




#### Millennials

Langlade County, WI has 2,861 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 3,984.




#### Veterans

Langlade County, WI has 1,611 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,024.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Langlade County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 5,797 people 55 or older, while there are 8,368 here.














