



#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 2.3% since 2017, growing by 3,136. Population is expected to increase by 2.5% between 2022 and 2027, adding 3,436.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 1.1% in Marathon County, WI from 75,637 to 74,808. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 2.4% by 3.5%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 68.7% to 65.7% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **18.4% of Marathon County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.4% below the national average), and **14.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.2% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Dairy Product Manufacturing.




#### Dec 2022 Labor Force Breakdown



#### **Educational Attainment**













### **Job Trends**






Marathon County, WI had a December 2022 unemployment rate of 1.89%, decreasing from 2.92% 5 years before.




#### **Millennials**

millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 28,117.






Marathon County, WI has 8,018 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 7,229.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Racial diversity is low in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 56,014 racially diverse people, while there are 17,021 here.




#### **Property Crime**








#### **Top Industry Location Quotient**





#### **Largest Occupations**








In 2021, there were 2,470 graduates in Marathon County, WI. This pipeline has grown by 5% over the last 5 years.
