Median household income is \$3.5K below the national median household income of \$69.0K.

Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population **declined by 0.5%** since 2017, falling by 330. Population is expected to **decrease by 1.4%** between 2022 and 2027, losing 951.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 5.7% in Portage County, WI from 38,075 to 35,895. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 2.4% by 8.1%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 66.3% to 63.9% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, 24.5% of Portage County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (3.7% above the national average), and 13.2% hold an Associate's Degree (4.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Insurance Carriers, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Fruit and Vegetable Preserving and Specialty Food Manufacturing.

Dec 2022 Labor Force Breakdown




Educational Attainment





Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity









Portage County, WI had a December 2022 unemployment rate of 2.26%, decreasing from 3.05% 5 years before.














Top Industry Location Quotient









Unique Average Monthly Postings


