
### **Takeaways**

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 6.1% since 2017, growing by 1,213. Population is expected to increase by 4.0% between 2022 and 2027, adding 839.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 13.8% in Adams County, WI from 5,517 to 4,758. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.4% by 17.2%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 49.2% to 42.2% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.1% of Adams County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.8% below the national average), and **8.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Crop Production, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).











# **Unemployment by Ethnicity**







### **Job Trends**






Adams County, WI had a January 2023 unemployment rate of 5.99%, increasing from 4.68% 5 years before.

Adams County, WI has 2,998 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,264.




#### Veterans

Adams County, WI has 1,740 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,096.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,205 people 55 or older, while there are 10,533 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,495 racially diverse people, while there are 2,200 here.




#### **Property Crime**








### **Top Industry Location Quotient**







### **Top Occupation Location Quotient**









