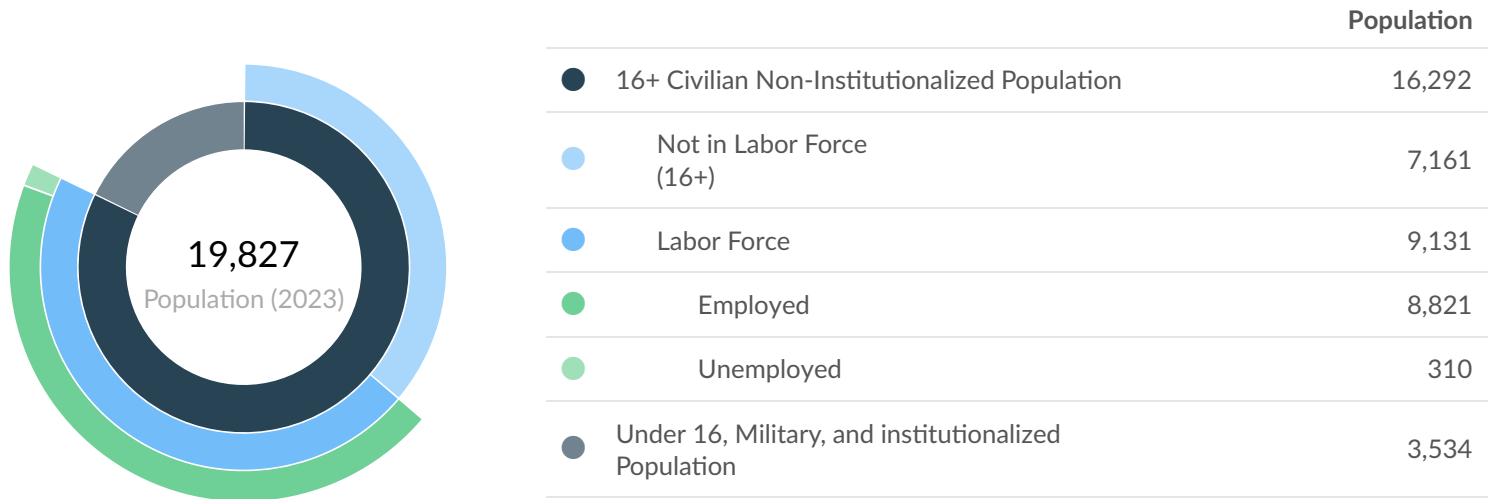

## Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population **increased by 2.6%** since 2017, growing by 500. Population is expected to **increase by 3.4%** between 2022 and 2027, adding 674.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs **declined by 2.7%** in Langlade County, WI from 8,429 to **8,203**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 3.4% by 6.1%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 61.7% to 55.0% between 2017 and 2022**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.2% of Langlade County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.6% below the national average), and **11.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Crop Production, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

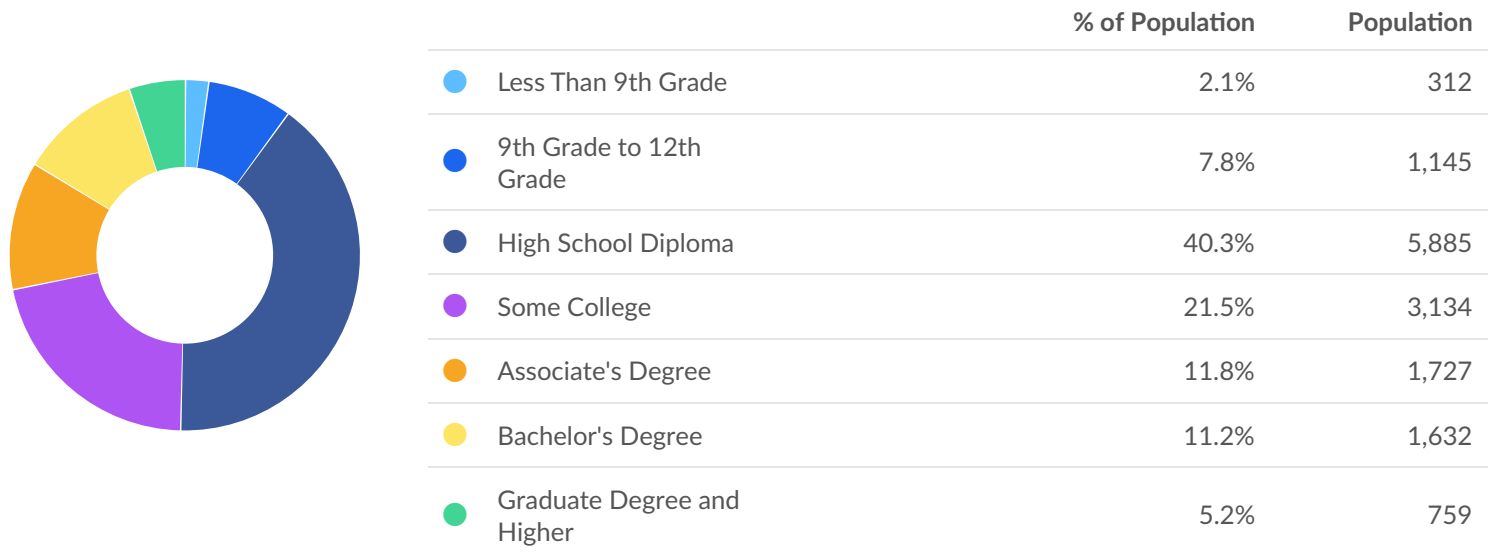

## Jan 2023 Labor Force Breakdown



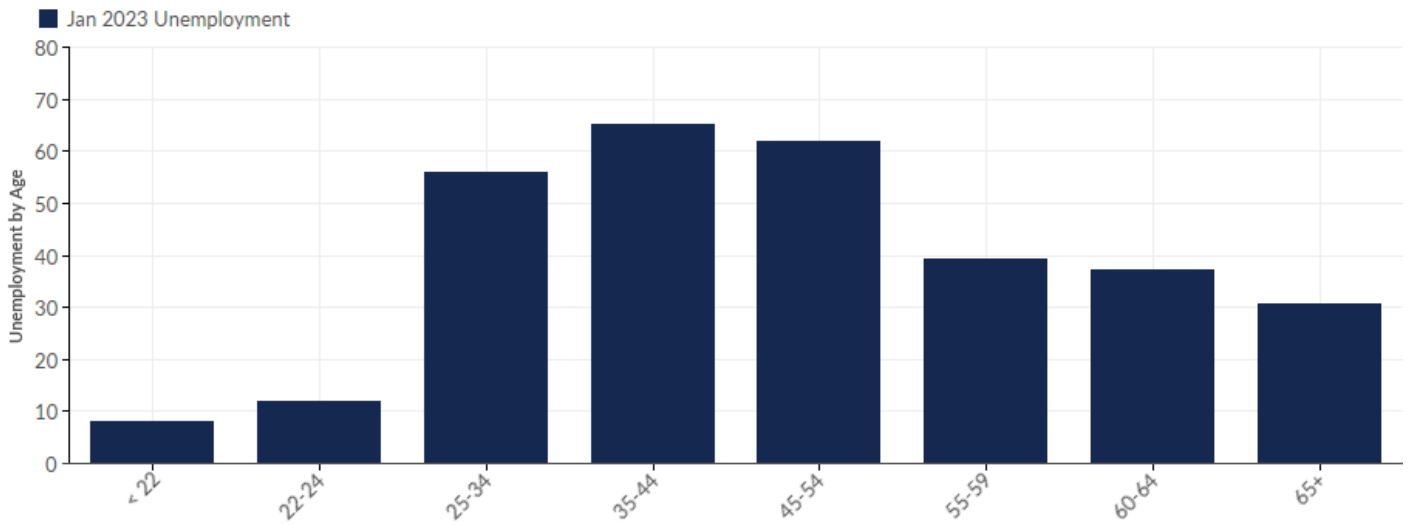
## Educational Attainment

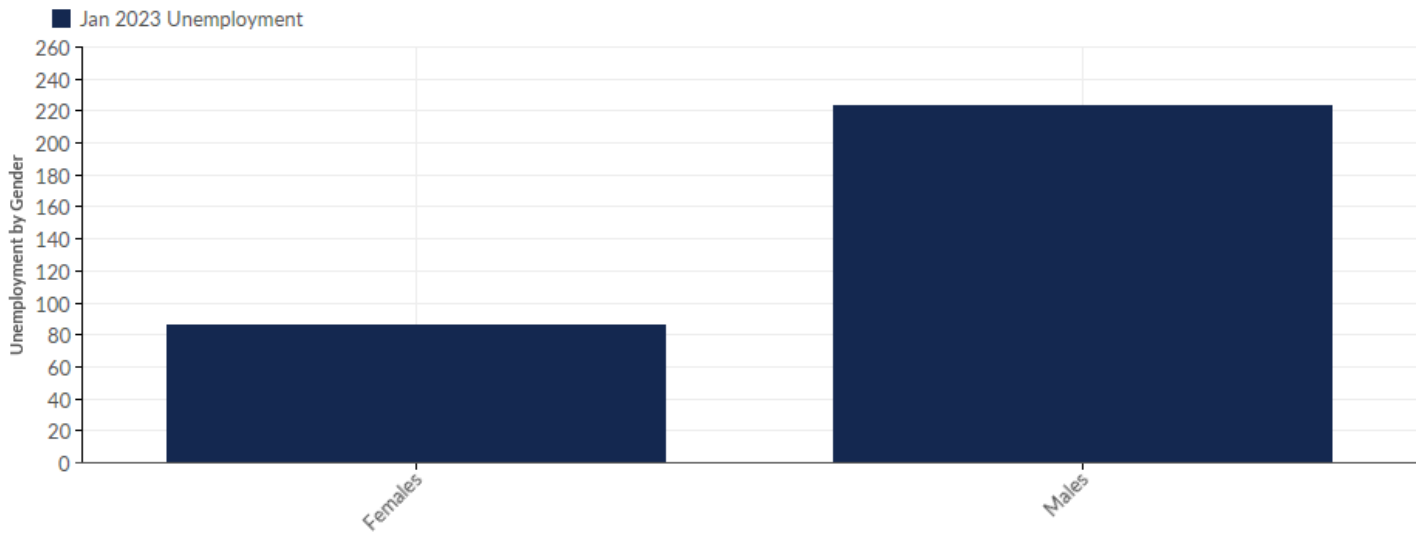

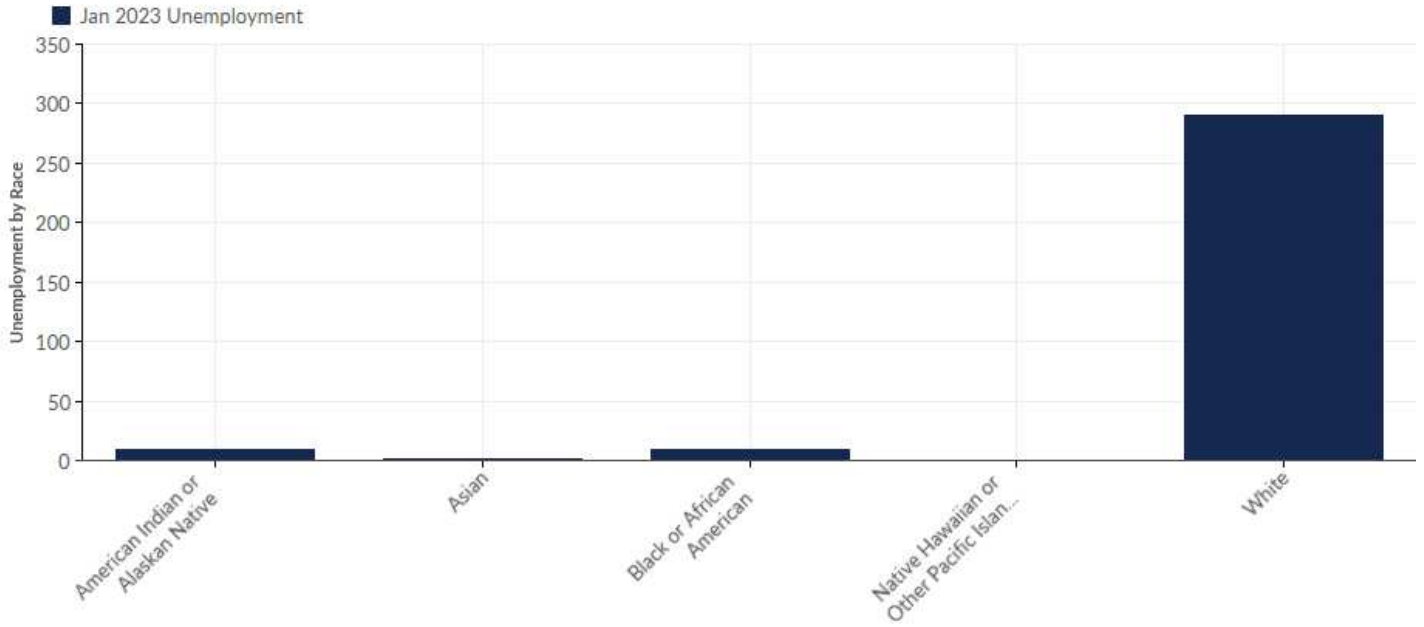

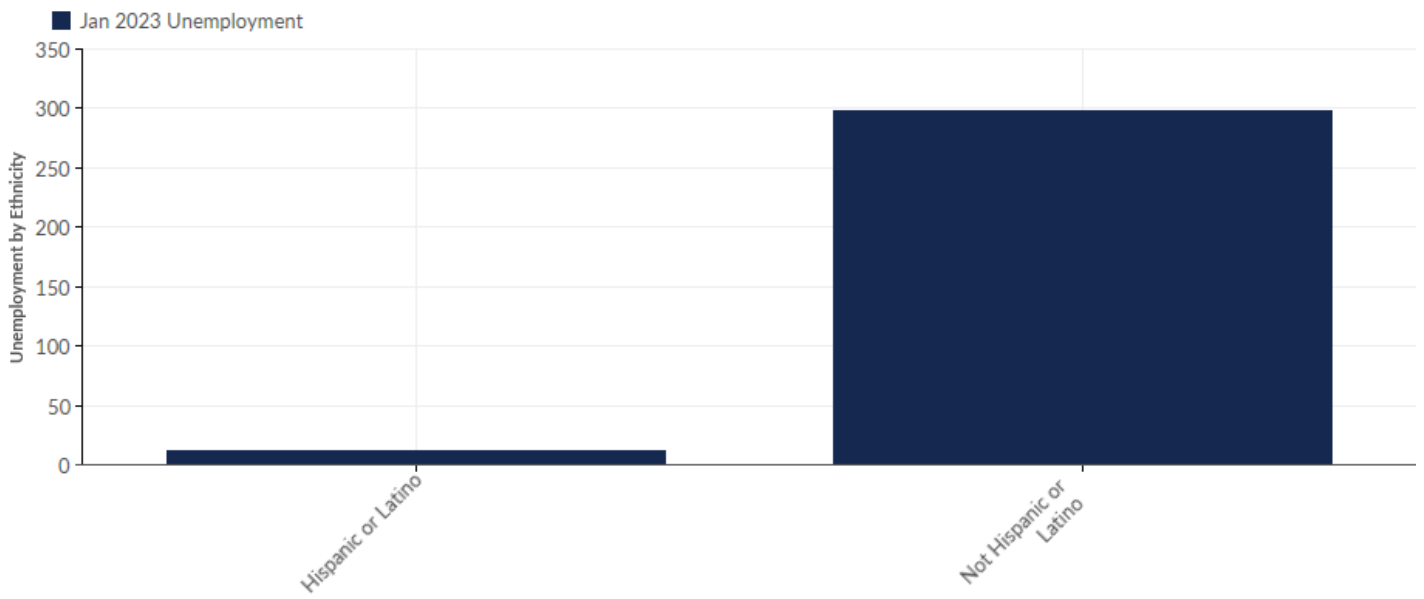

## Unemployment by Ethnicity

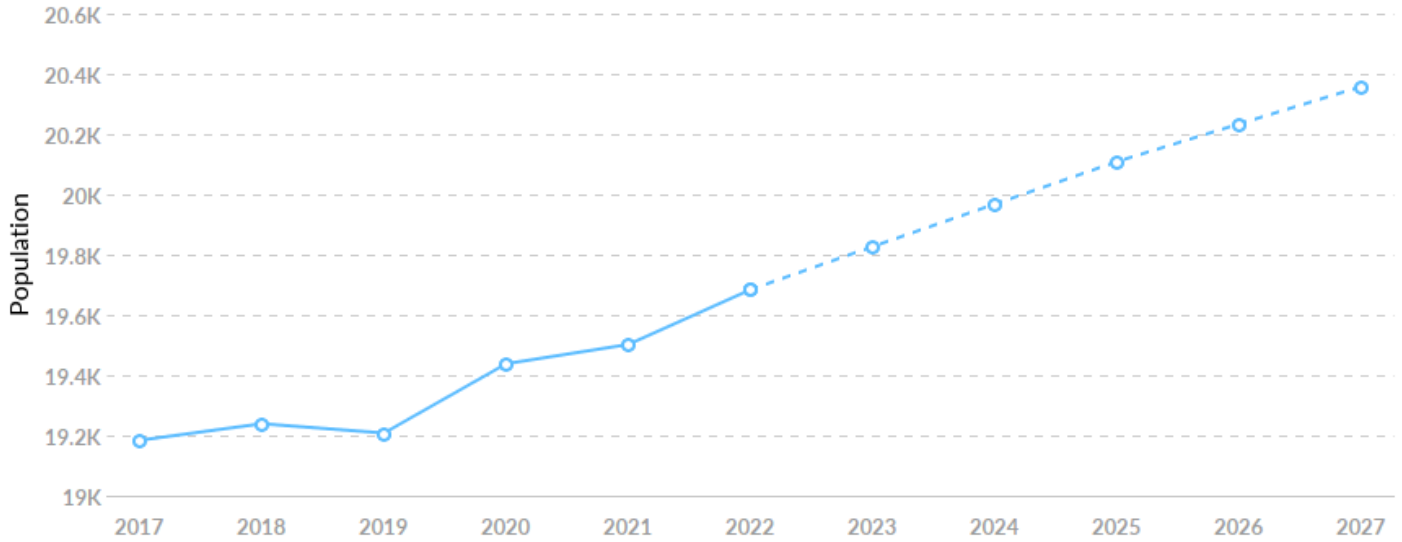

## Population Trends

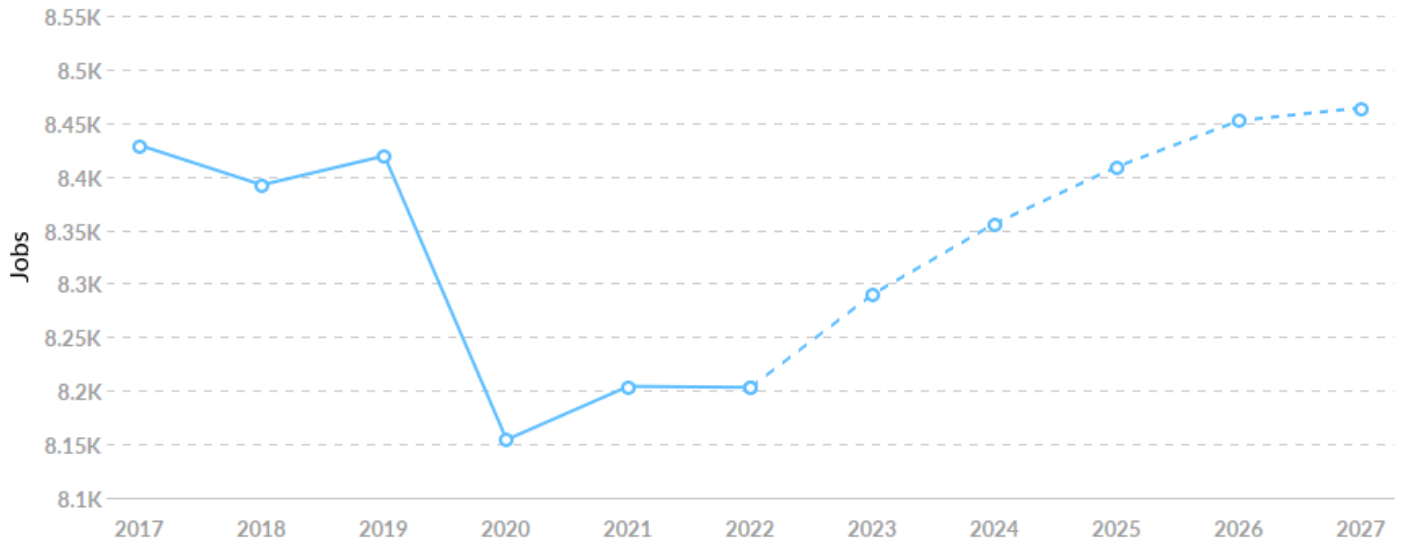

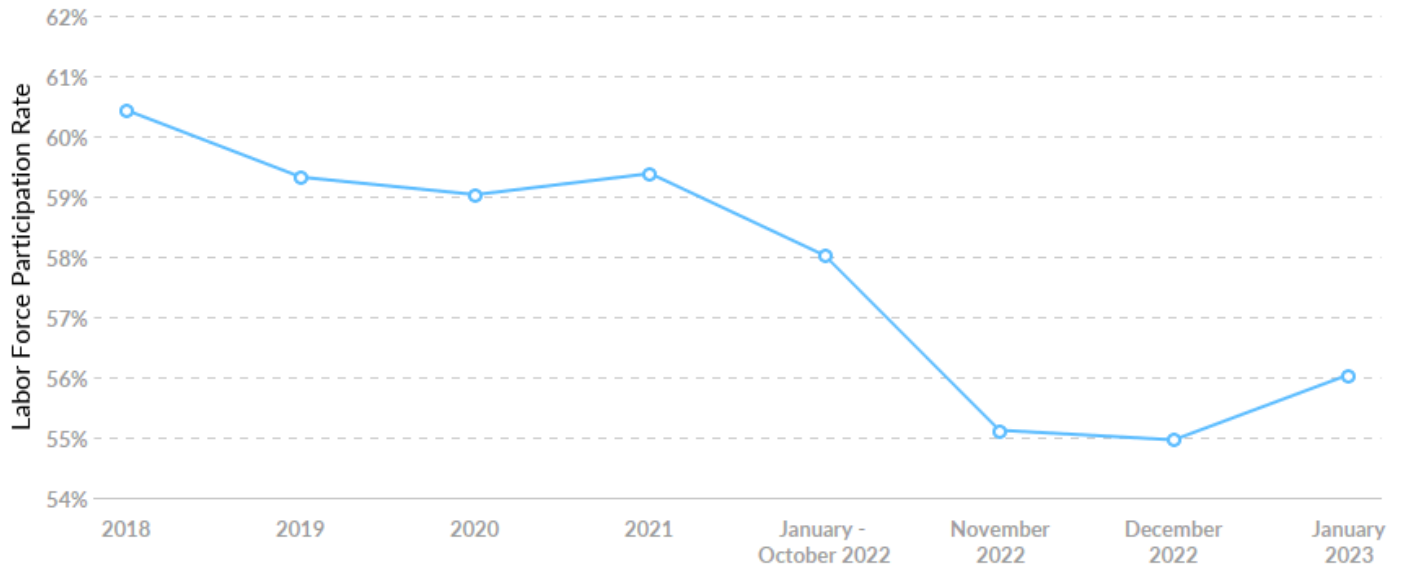
## Job Trends

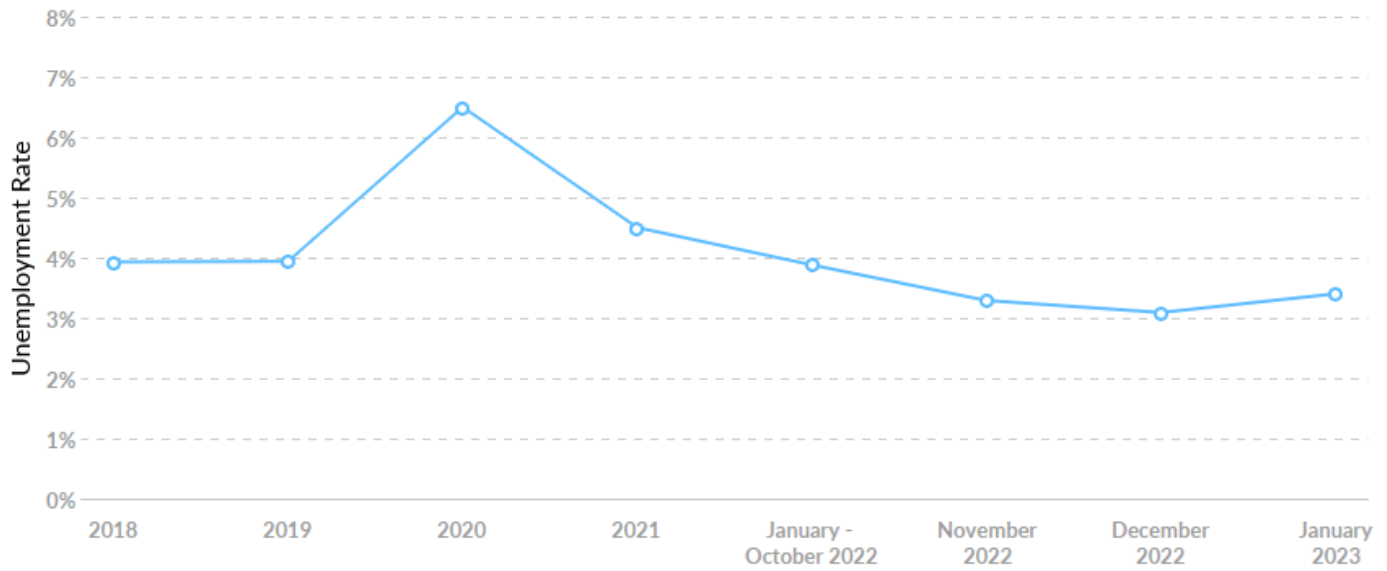

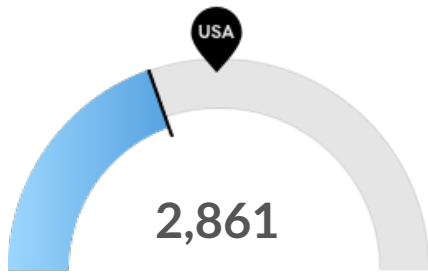
## Unemployment Rate Trends

Langlade County, WI had a January 2023 unemployment rate of 3.40%, **decreasing from 3.93%** 5 years before.



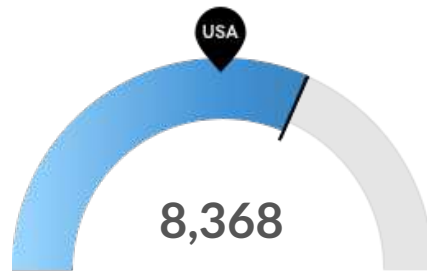

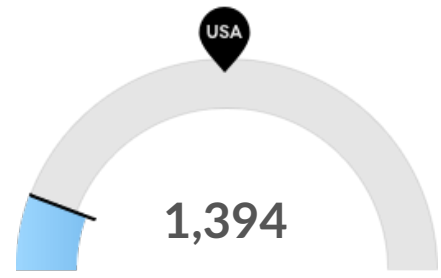
**Millennials**

Langlade County, WI has 2,861 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 3,984.



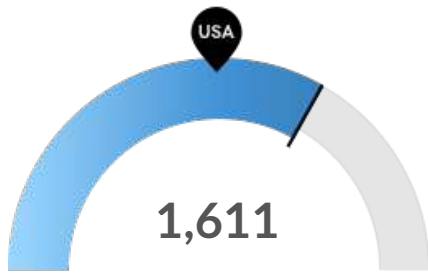
**Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Langlade County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 5,797 people 55 or older, while there are 8,368 here.



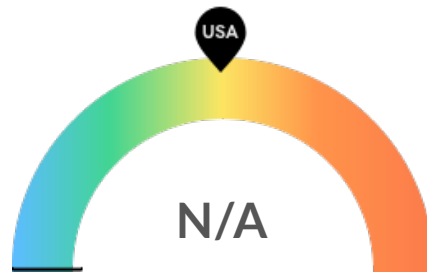
**Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is low in Langlade County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 7,936 racially diverse people, while there are 1,394 here.



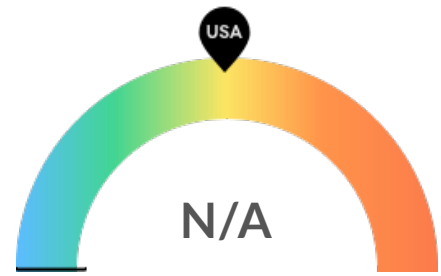

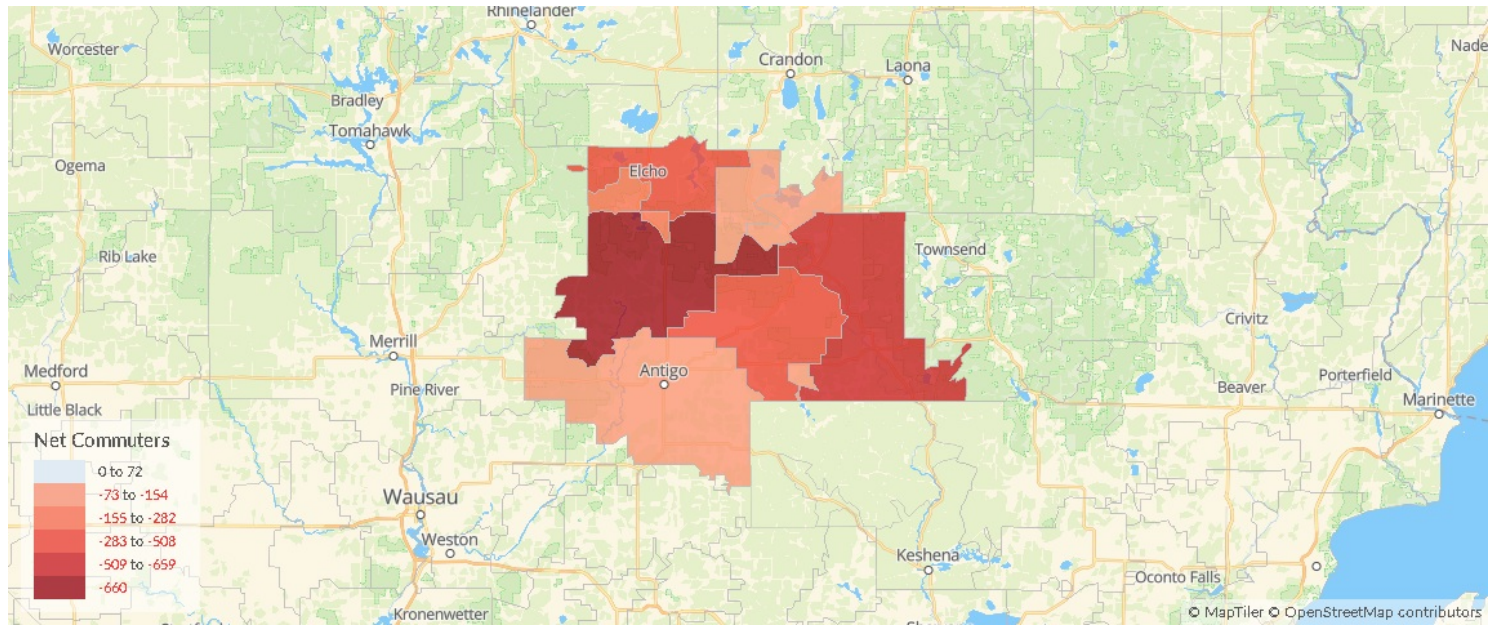

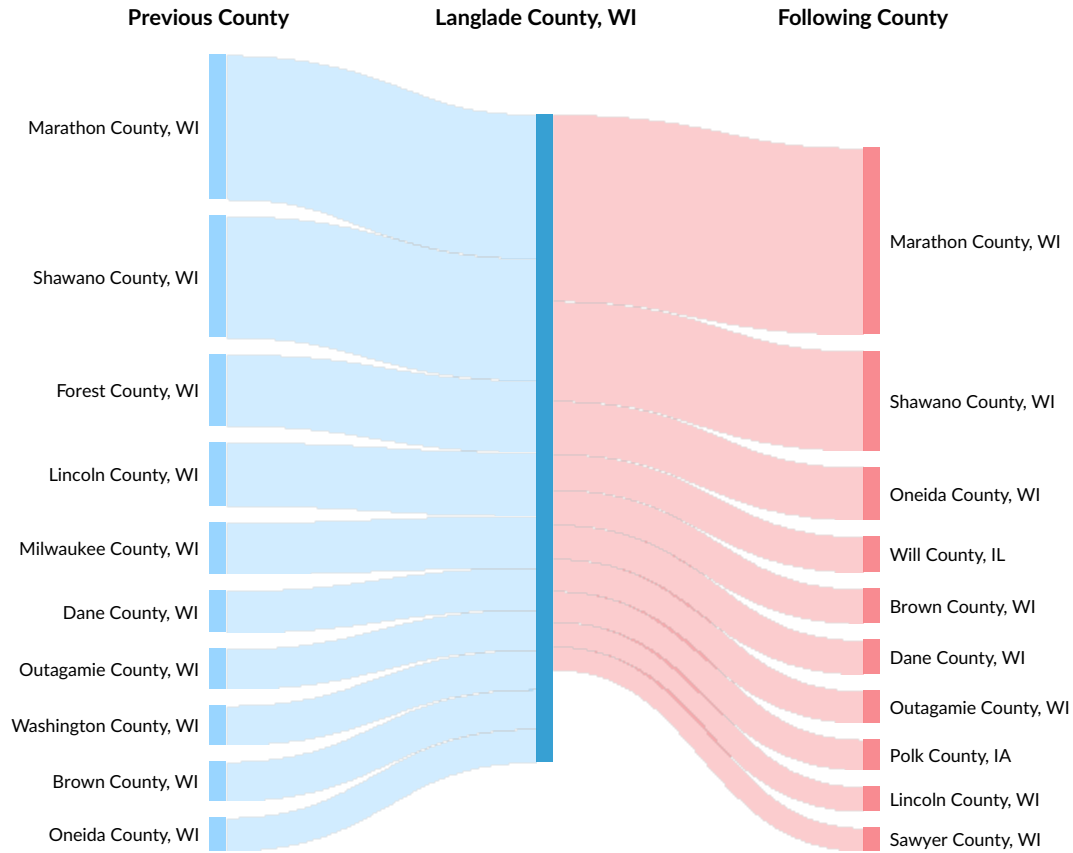

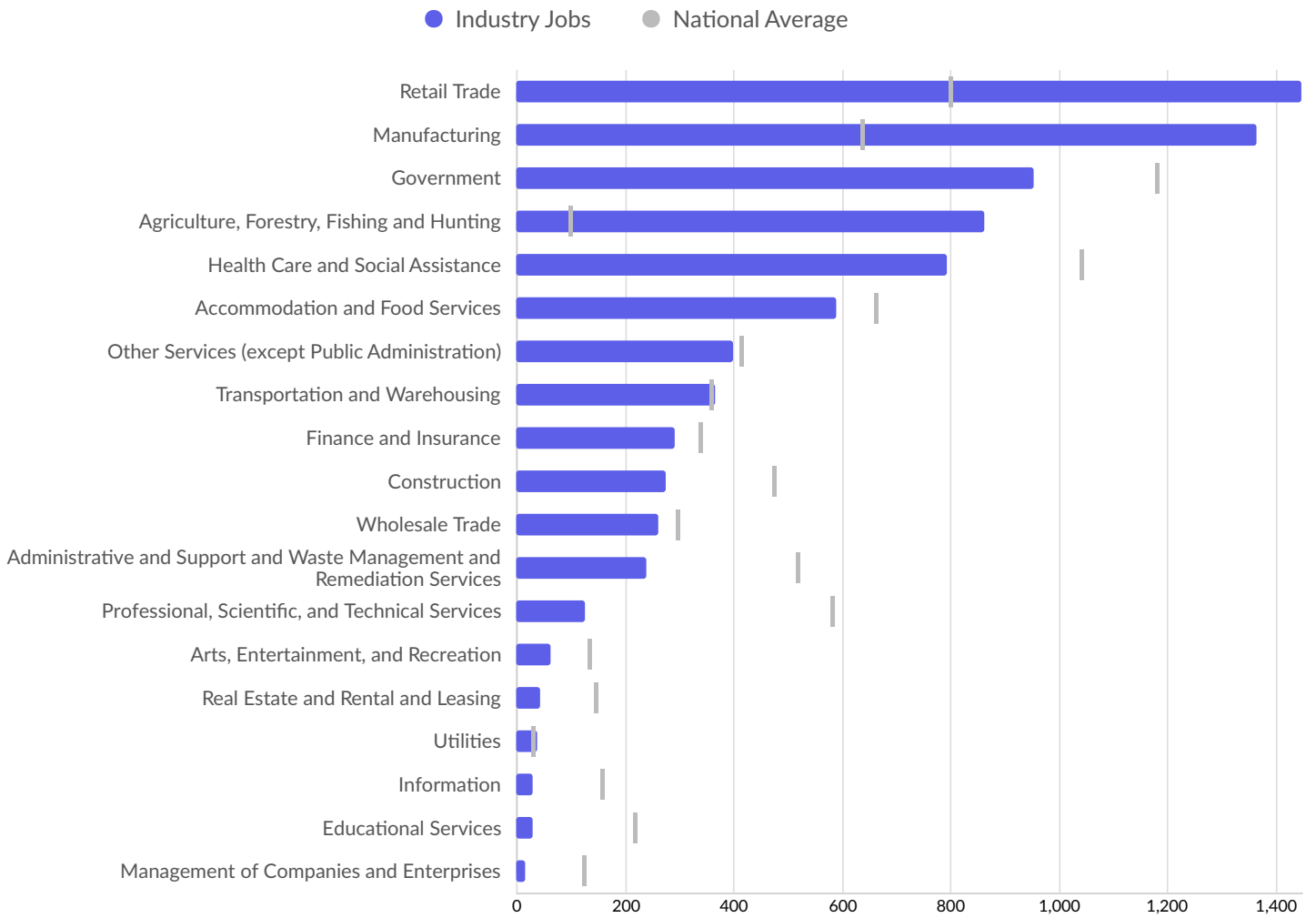

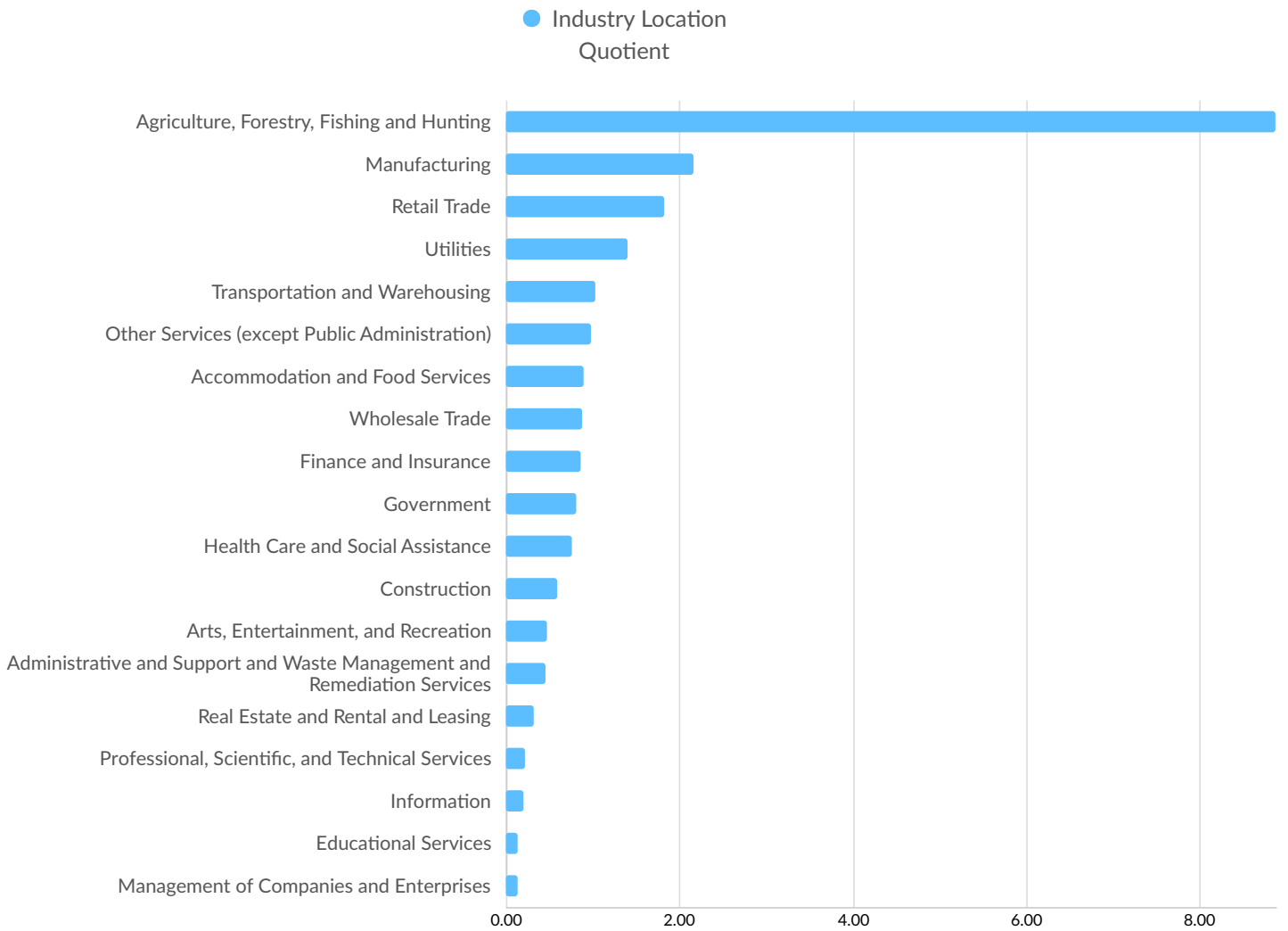

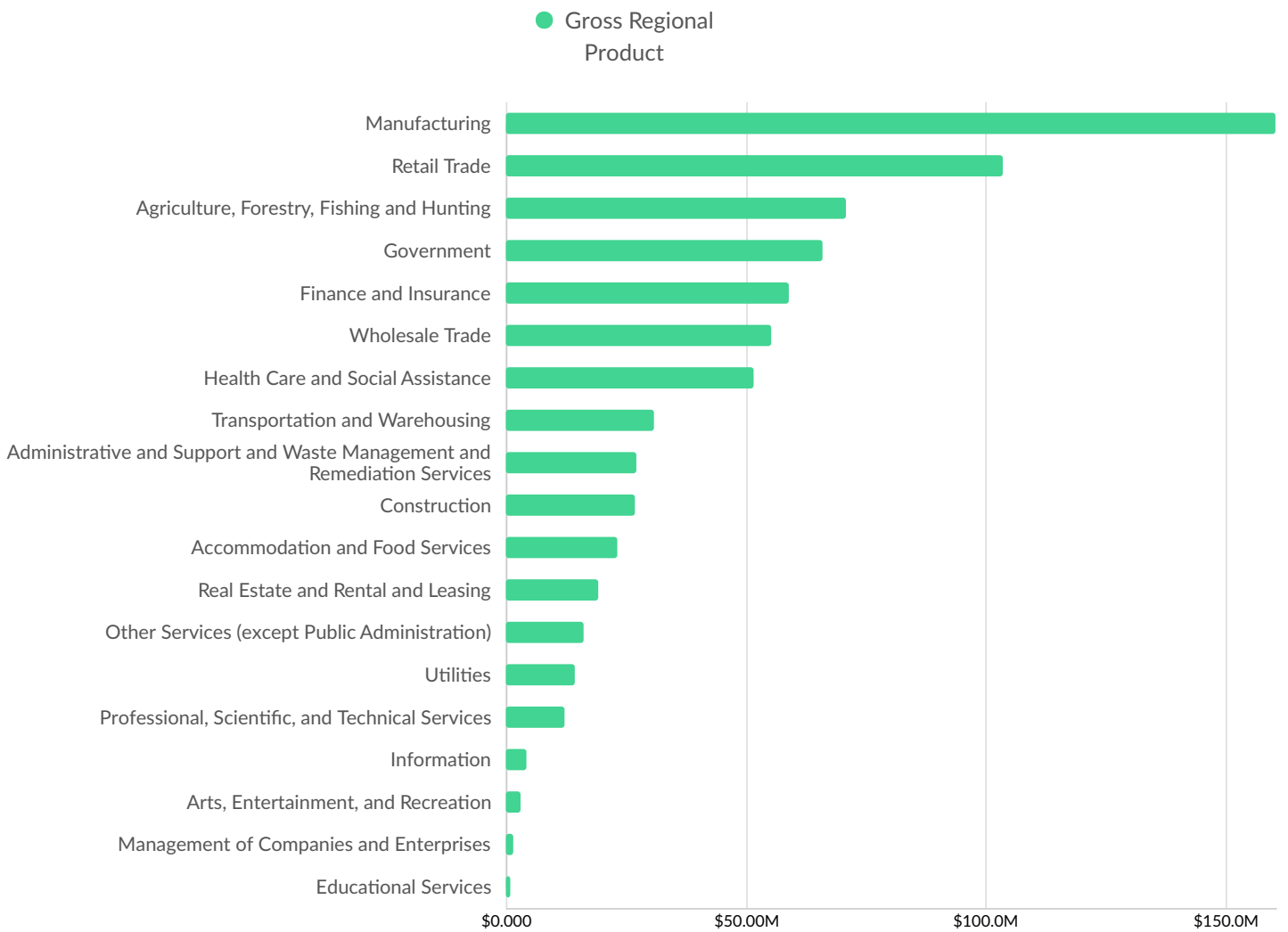
## Top Growing Industries



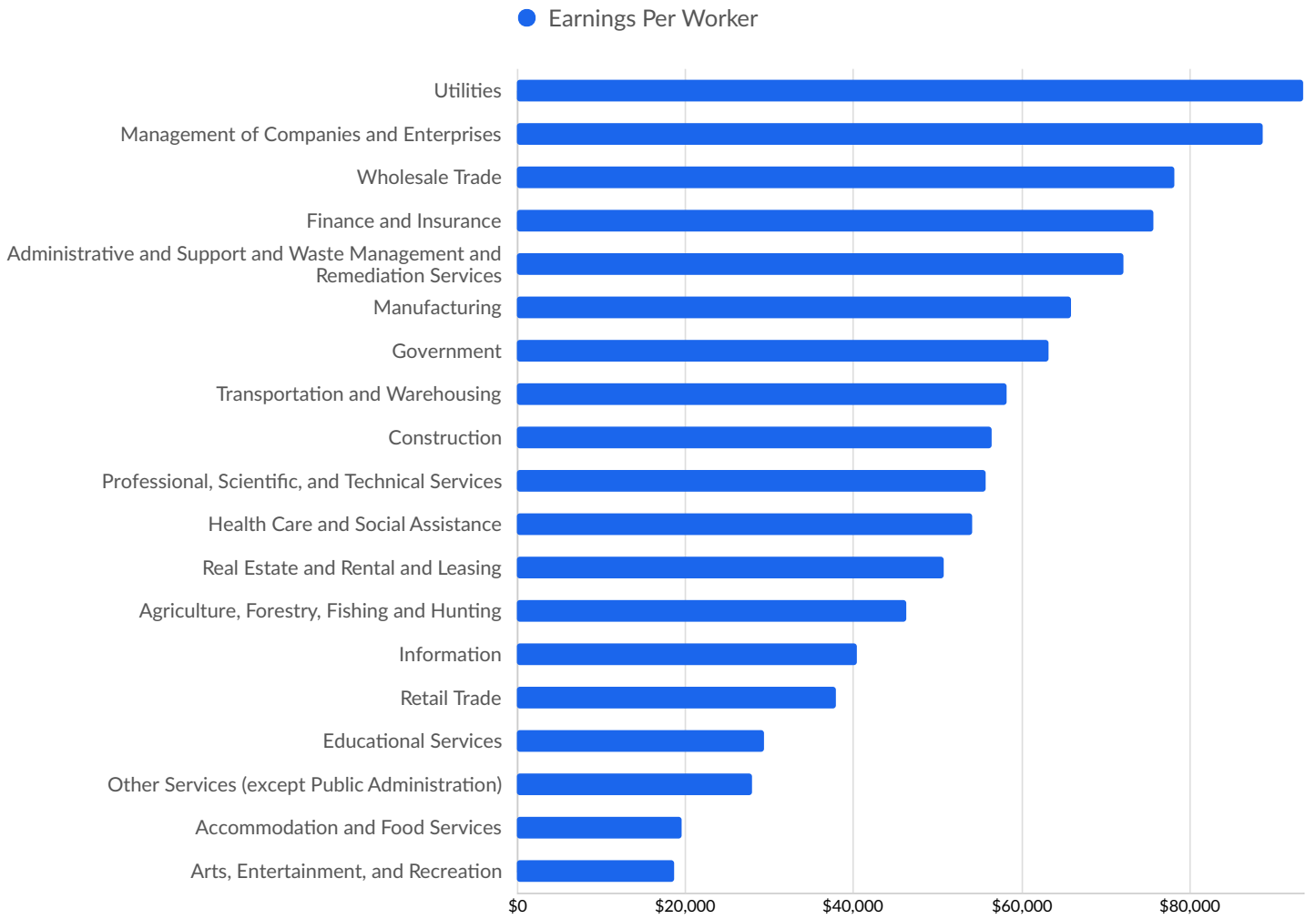
## Top Industry Location Quotient

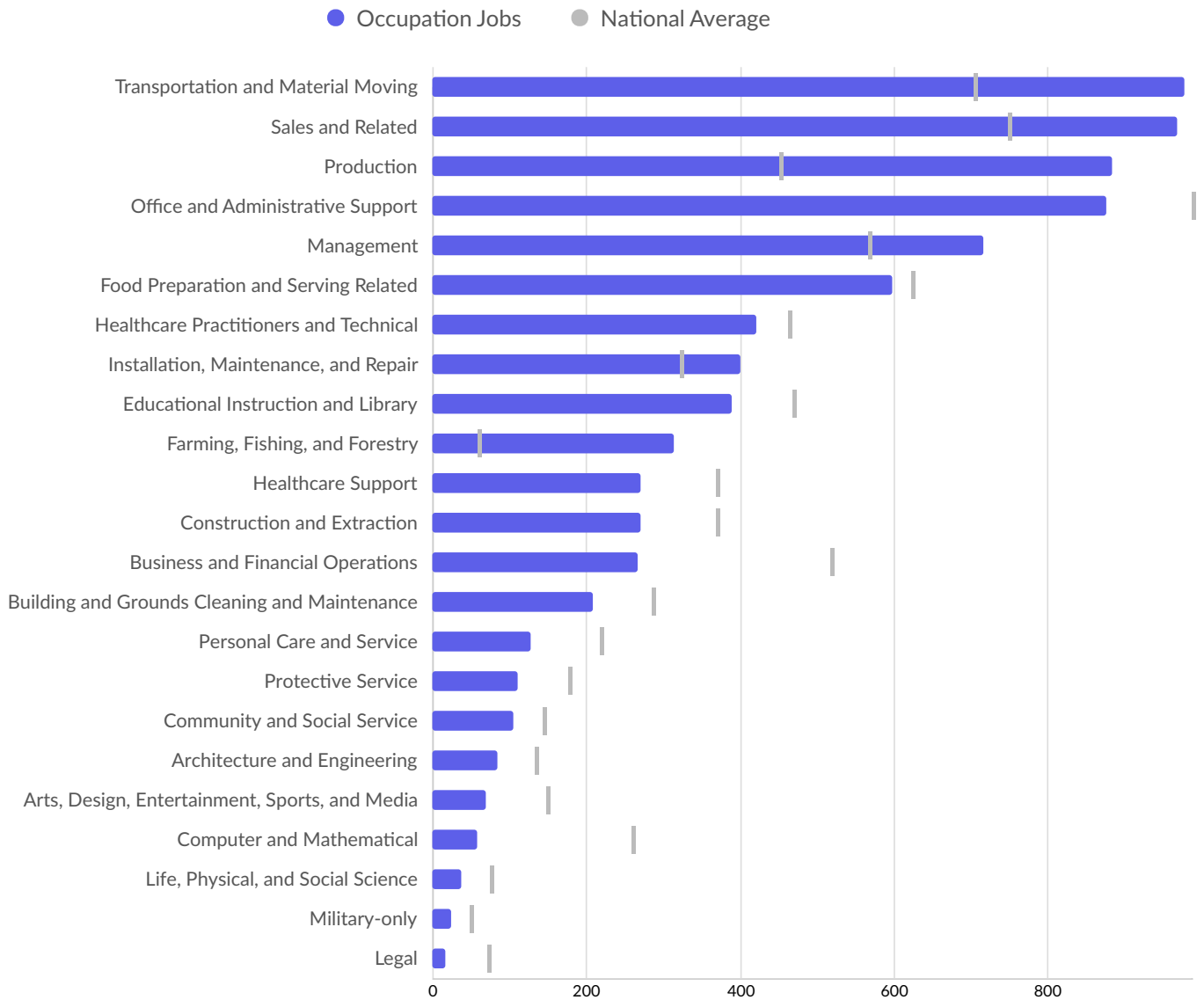

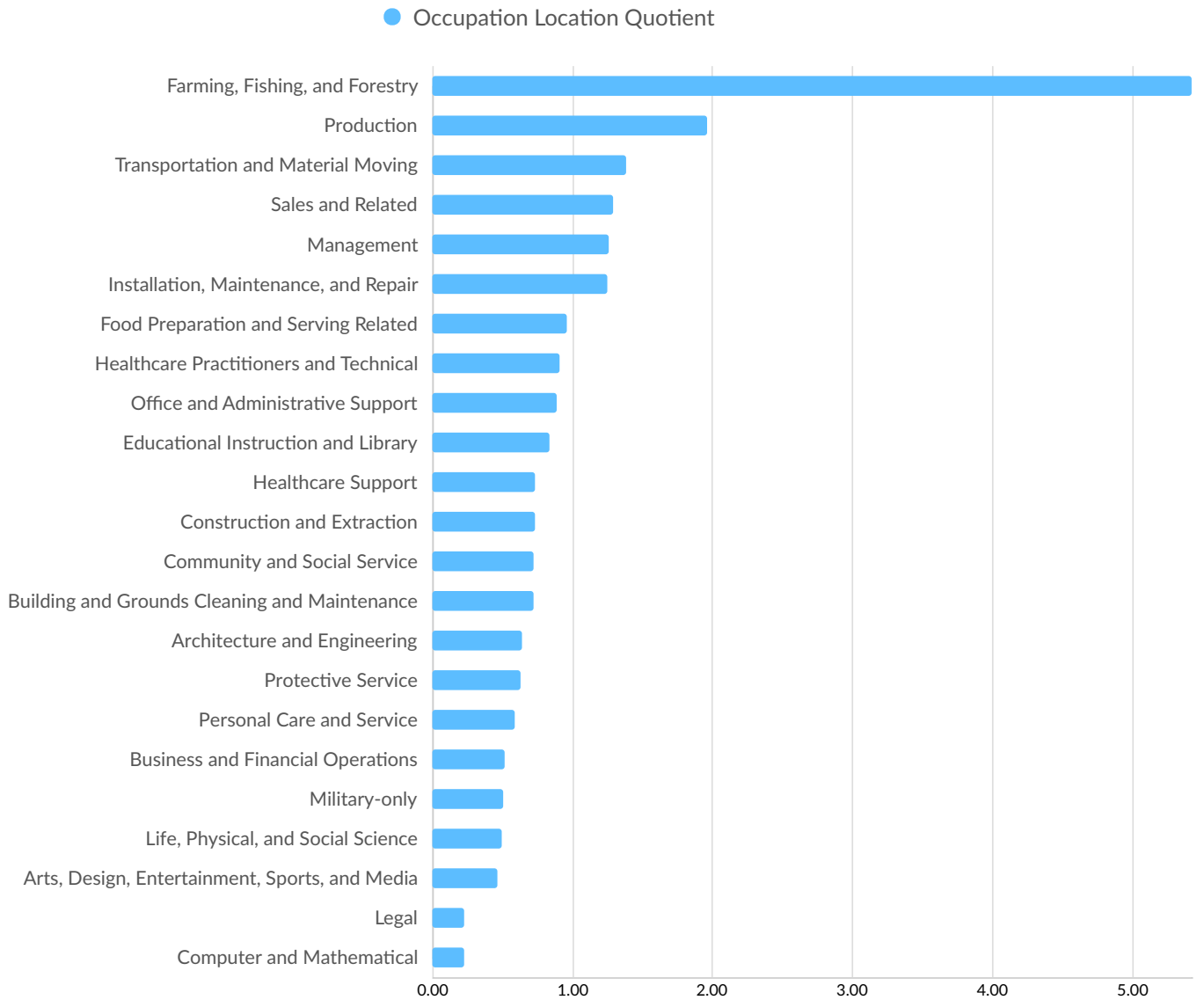
## Largest Occupations



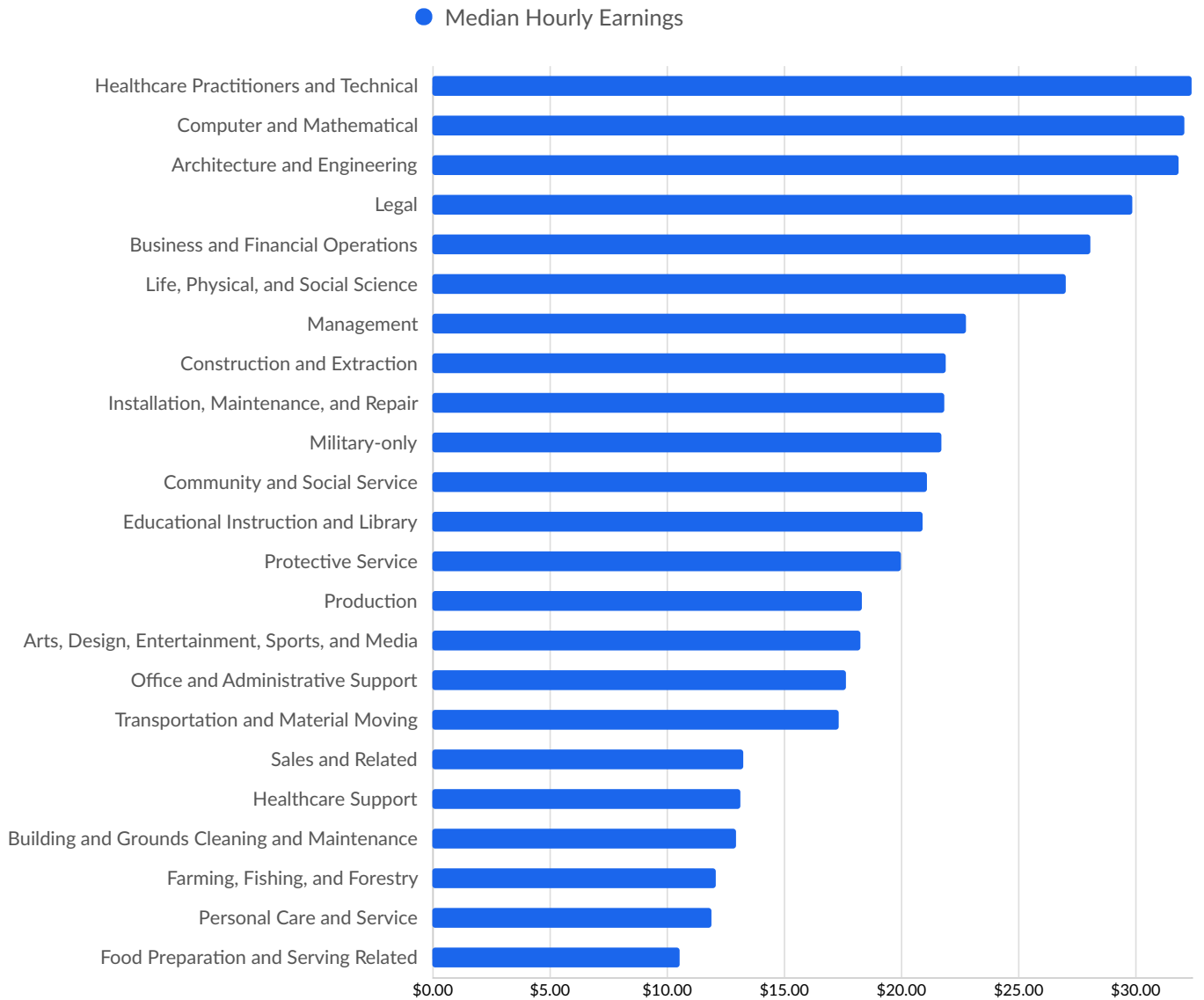
## Top Growing Occupations



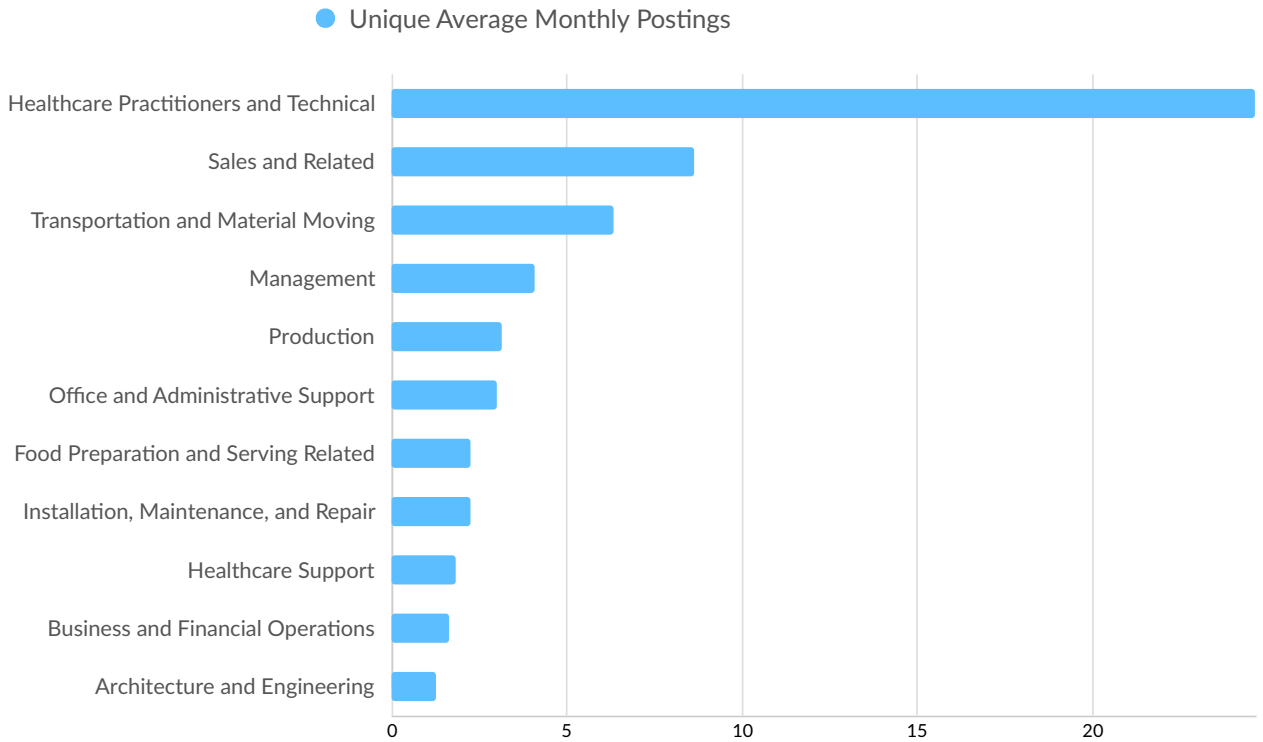
## Top Occupation Location Quotient



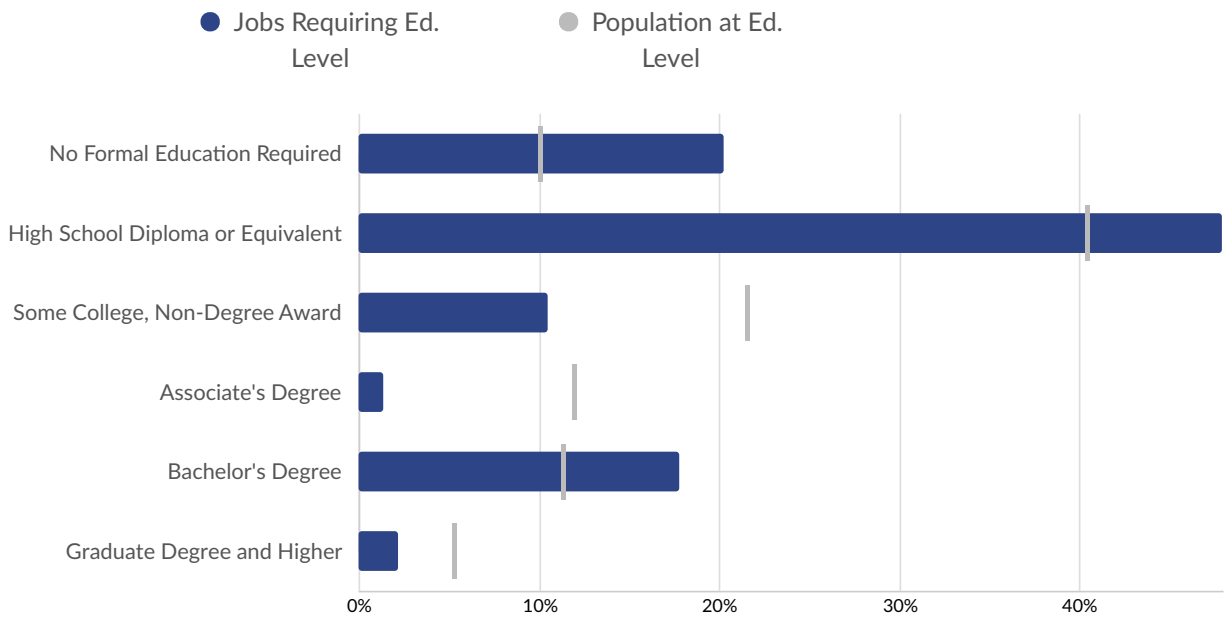
