Median household income is \$15.7K below the national median household income of \$69.0K.

#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2022 the region's population **increased by 2.6%** since 2017, growing by 500. Population is expected to **increase by 3.4%** between 2022 and 2027, adding 674.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 2.7% in Langlade County, WI from 8,429 to 8,203. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.4% by 6.1%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 61.7% to 55.0% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.2% of Langlade County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.6% below the national average), and **11.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Crop Production, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

#### **Educational Attainment**


























#### **Top Industry Location Quotient**








