Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 4.5% since 2017, growing by 1,252. Population is expected to increase by 6.6% between 2022 and 2027, adding 1,921.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 5.1% in Lincoln County, WI from 11,788 to 11,184. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.4% by 8.5%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 67.3% to 60.0% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.3% of Lincoln County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (7.5% below the national average), and **12.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Insurance Carriers, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.




Jan 2023 Labor Force Breakdown









Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Lincoln County, WI had a January 2023 unemployment rate of 2.98%, decreasing from 3.11% 5 years before.




Millennials

millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,830.






Lincoln County, WI has 1,711 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,499.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Lincoln County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,483 people 55 or older, while there are 11,693 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Lincoln County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 11,614 racially diverse people, while there are 1,620 here.




Property Crime






Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Location Quotient






Top Industry GRP





Top Occupation Location Quotient









