

#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2022 the region's population **declined by 0.5**% since 2017, falling by 330. Population is expected to **decrease by 1.4**% between 2022 and 2027, losing 951.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 5.5% in Portage County, WI from 38,075 to 35,970. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.4% by 8.9%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 66.3% to 63.9% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **24.5% of Portage County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.7% above the national average), and **13.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Insurance Carriers, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Fruit and Vegetable Preserving and Specialty Food Manufacturing.




#### Jan 2023 Labor Force Breakdown




#### **Educational Attainment**









# **Unemployment by Ethnicity**





As of 2022 the region's population declined by 0.5% since 2017, falling by 330. Population is expected to decrease by 1.4% between 2022 and 2027, losing 951.



#### **Job Trends**






Portage County, WI had a January 2023 unemployment rate of 2.76%, decreasing from 2.98% 5 years before.






Portage County, WI has 12,457 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 14,394.




#### **Veterans**

Portage County, WI has 4,056 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 3,701.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is about average in Portage County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 20,946 people 55 or older, while there are 22,084 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Portage County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 28,676 racially diverse people, while there are 6,829 here.




#### **Property Crime**








#### **Top Industry Location Quotient**






### **Top Industry GRP**





#### **Largest Occupations**







# **Educational Pipeline**

In 2021, there were 2,102 graduates in Portage County, WI. This pipeline has shrunk by 3% over the last 5 years.
