#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 2.1% since 2017, growing by 7,003. Population is expected to increase by 2.4% between 2022 and 2027, adding 7,864.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 2.7% in Centergy from 176,610 to 171,814. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 6.5%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 64.9% to 60.5% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.5% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.3% below the national average), and **13.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.




### Apr 2023 Labor Force Breakdown


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
























