Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 1.6% since 2017, growing by 432. Population is expected to increase by 1.2% between 2022 and 2027, adding 321.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 1.5% in Juneau County, WI from 10,596 to 10,440. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 5.3%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 66.7% to 62.7% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.3% of Juneau County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.5% below the national average), and **11.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.




Apr 2023 Labor Force Breakdown








Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity





As of 2022 the region's population increased by 1.6% since 2017, growing by 432. Population is expected to increase by 1.2% between 2022 and 2027, adding 321.



Job Trends






Juneau County, WI had an April 2023 unemployment rate of 2.23%, decreasing from 3.03% 5 years before.






Millennials




Veterans

Juneau County, WI has 2,062 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,408.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Juneau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 7,967 people 55 or older, while there are 9,993 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Juneau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 10,907 racially diverse people, while there are 2,399 here.




Property Crime






Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP











Top Occupation Employment Concentration


Top Occupation Earnings




