
Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 2.6% since 2017, growing by 500. Population is expected to increase by 3.4% between 2022 and 2027, adding 674.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 2.5% in Langlade County, WI from 8,769 to 8,551. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 6.3%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 61.7% to 55.4% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.2% of Langlade County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.6% below the national average), and **11.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Crop Production, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.








Unemployment by Gender




Unemployment by Race

Unemployment by Ethnicity












Langlade County, WI had an April 2023 unemployment rate of 3.00%, decreasing from 3.93% 5 years before.




Millennials

Langlade County, WI has 1,611 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,024.




Retiring Soon

Racial diversity is low in Langlade County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 7,936 racially diverse people, while there are 1,394 here.














Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP






Top Growing Occupations






Top Occupation Employment Concentration










