Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population **declined by 0.5%** since 2017, falling by 330. Population is expected to **decrease by 1.4%** between 2022 and 2027, losing 951.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 4.9% in Portage County, WI from 39,032 to 37,101. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 8.7%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 66.3% to 64.2% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **24.5% of Portage County**, **WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.7% above the national average), and **13.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Insurance Carriers, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Fruit and Vegetable Preserving and Specialty Food Manufacturing.







Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity










Unemployment Rate Trends

Portage County, WI had an April 2023 unemployment rate of 2.14%, decreasing from 2.98% 5 years before.












Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration







Top Growing Occupations




Top Occupation Employment Concentration



Top Occupation Earnings




Top Posted Occupations



Unique Average Monthly Postings



Educational Pipeline

In 2021, there were 2,102 graduates in Portage County, WI. This pipeline has shrunk by 3% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Business Administration and Management, General" (Bachelor's), "Biology/Biological Sciences, General" (Bachelor's), and "Liberal Arts and Sciences, General Studies and Humanities, Other" (Associate's).
