
### **Takeaways**

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 11.7% since 2017, growing by 2,536. Population is expected to increase by 12.4% between 2022 and 2027, adding 2,993.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs increased by 1.0% in Vilas County, WI from 9,276 to 9,368. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 2.8%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 52.2% to 47.1% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **18.5% of Vilas County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.3% below the national average), and **10.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).











# **Unemployment by Ethnicity**







### **Job Trends**






Vilas County, WI had an April 2023 unemployment rate of 4.79%, increasing from 3.96% 5 years before.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Vilas County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,991 people 55 or older, while there are 11,962 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Vilas County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 9,571 racially diverse people, while there are 3,465 here.




#### **Property Crime**






### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**






