

Median household income is \$11.0K below the national median household income of \$69.0K.


Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 2.4% since 2017, growing by 1,731. Population is expected to increase by 3.5% between 2022 and 2027, adding 2,619.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 3.1% in Wood County, WI from 41,869 to 40,591. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 6.9%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 60.2% to 53.9% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.4% of Wood County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (7.4% below the national average), and **13.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.7% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are General Freight Trucking, Outpatient Care Centers, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).




Apr 2023 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Wood County, WI had an April 2023 unemployment rate of 2.56%, decreasing from 3.41% 5 years before.








Wood County, WI has 5,353 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 3.890.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Wood County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 22,016 people 55 or older, while there are 27,307 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Wood County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 30,142 racially diverse people, while there are 6,278 here.




Property Crime












Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP





Top Occupation Employment Concentration




