Median household income is \$17.1K below the national median household income of \$69.0K.


Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 6.6% since 2017, growing by 1,321. Population is expected to increase by 3.1% between 2022 and 2027, adding 651.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 12.0% in Adams County, WI from 5,934 to 5,223. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 15.8%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 49.2% to 41.8% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.1% of Adams County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.8% below the national average), and **8.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Crop Production, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Traveler Accommodation.








Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity












Adams County, WI had an August 2023 unemployment rate of 5.10%, increasing from 4.69% 5 years before.




Millennials

Adams County, WI has 2,997 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,316.




Veterans

Adams County, WI has 1,740 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,092.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,361 people 55 or older, while there are 10,838 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,729 racially diverse people, while there are 2,267 here.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP






Top Growing Occupations





Top Occupation Employment Concentration




Top Occupation Earnings




