Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population **increased by 1.5%** since 2017, growing by 392. Population is expected to **increase by 0.9%** between 2022 and 2027, adding 230.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 1.2% in Juneau County from 10,596 to 10,466. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 5.0%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 66.7% to 62.4% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.3% of Juneau County residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.5% below the national average), and **11.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.









Unemployment by Ethnicity












Population Characteristics

Juneau County has 4,651 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,463.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Juneau County. The national average for an area this size is 8,051 people 55 or older, while there are 10,227 here. 2,426


Racial Diversity

Violent Crime


Juneau County has 1.49 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Growing Occupations



Top Occupation Employment Concentration




Top Occupation Earnings




