


Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 2.0% since 2017, growing by 375. Population is expected to increase by 3.7% between 2022 and 2027, adding 717.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 2.1% in Langlade County, WI from 8,769 to 8,581. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 5.9%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 61.7% to 55.6% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.2% of Langlade County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.6% below the national average), and **11.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Crop Production, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.










Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Langlade County, WI had an August 2023 unemployment rate of 4.09%, increasing from 3.93% 5 years before.




Langlade County, WI has 2,853 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this






Veterans

Langlade County, WI has 1,611 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,024.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Langlade County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 5,861 people 55 or older, while there are 8,440 here.




Violent Crime












Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP








Top Occupation Employment Concentration




