

Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 2.3% since 2017, growing by 631. Population is expected to increase by 6.5% between 2022 and 2027, adding 1,847.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 4.9% in Lincoln County, WI from 12,314 to 11,714. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 8.7%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 67.3% to 61.2% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.3% of Lincoln County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (7.6% below the national average), and **12.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Insurance Carriers, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.





Aug 2023 Labor Force Breakdown



Educational Attainment






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Lincoln County, WI had an August 2023 unemployment rate of 3.62%, increasing from 3.11% 5 years before.






Millennials




Veterans

Retirement risk is high in Lincoln County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,504 people 55 or older, while there are 11,970 here.




Violent Crime

Lincoln County, WI has 2.95 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.




Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Lincoln County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 11,669 racially diverse people, while there are 1,608 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP




Top Growing Occupations





Top Occupation Employment Concentration











