#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 1.8% since 2017, growing by 2,433. Population is expected to increase by 2.9% between 2022 and 2027, adding 3,950.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 0.0% in Marathon County, WI from 77,474 to 77,465. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 3.8%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 68.7% to 65.2% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **18.4% of Marathon County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.4% below the national average), and **14.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.2% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Dairy Product Manufacturing.




#### Aug 2023 Labor Force Breakdown



#### **Educational Attainment**













## **Job Trends**






Marathon County, WI had an August 2023 unemployment rate of 3.41%, increasing from 2.63% 5 years before.







#### **Millennials**

Marathon County, WI has 25,307 national average for an area this size is 28,052.






Marathon County, WI has 8,018 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 7,232.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 41,344 people 55 or older, while there are 46,157 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 56,734 racially diverse people, while there are 17,349 here.




#### **Property Crime**










### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**







## **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**



In 2022, there were 2,284 graduates in Marathon County, WI. This pipeline has grown by 2% over the last 5 years.
