- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 7.2% in Adams County, WI from 5,885 to 5,462. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 10.8%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 48.7% to 44.9% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.7% of Adams County**, **WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.4% below the national average), and **8.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Crop Production, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Traveler Accommodation.







Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity









Adams County, WI had a September 2023 unemployment rate of 4.43%, decreasing from 4.69% 5 years before.







Adams County, WI has 2,997 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,316.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,361 people 55 or older, while there are 10,838 here. 2,267


Racial Diversity

Violent Crime


Adams County, WI has 1.68 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 2.41 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Occupation Employment Concentration






