
Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 6.5% since 2018, growing by 582. Population is expected to increase by 8.2% between 2023 and 2028, adding 785.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 0.7% in Forest County, WI from 3,568 to 3,542. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 4.3%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 54.7% to 51.4% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.3% of Forest County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.8% below the national average), and **12.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.








Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity












Forest County, WI had a September 2023 unemployment rate of 4.42%, decreasing from 4.77% 5 years before.




Veterans

Forest County, WI has 652 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 486.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Forest County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 2,811 people 55 or older, while there are 3,971 here.




Violent Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP




Top Occupation Employment Concentration




