
### **Takeaways**

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 7.1% since 2018, growing by 13,824. Population is expected to increase by 8.2% between 2023 and 2028, adding 17,138.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 1.3% in Grow North from 85,122 to 84,019. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 4.9%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 61.3% to 56.4% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.6% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.5% below the national average), and **12.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).


























