
### **Takeaways**

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 2.6% since 2018, growing by 500. Population is expected to increase by 3.3% between 2023 and 2028, adding 643.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 1.2% in Langlade County, WI from 8,720 to 8,612. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 4.8%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 59.1% to 56.1% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.4% of Langlade County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.7% below the national average), and **12.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.1% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Crop Production, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).













As of 2023 the region's population increased by 2.6% since 2018, growing by 500. Population is expected to increase by 3.3% between 2023 and 2028, adding 643.



### **Job Trends**






Langlade County, WI had a September 2023 unemployment rate of 3.65%, decreasing from 3.93% 5 years before.


#### Millennials

Langlade County, WI has 2,853 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 3,977.




#### Veterans

Langlade County, WI has 1,611 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,024.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Langlade County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 5,861 people 55 or older, while there are 8,440 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Langlade County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,043 racially diverse people, while there are 1,406 here.




#### **Property Crime**












### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**







### **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**











