Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population **declined by 1.5%** since 2018, falling by 1,084. Population is expected to **decrease by 5.2%** between 2023 and 2028, losing 3,653.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 3.2% in Portage County, WI from 38,991 to 37,724. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 6.8%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 67.0% to 66.1% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **25.1% of Portage County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (4.0% above the national average), and **13.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.7% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Insurance Carriers, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Fruit and Vegetable Preserving and Specialty Food Manufacturing.







Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity









Portage County, WI had a September 2023 unemployment rate of 3.13%, increasing from 2.98% 5 years before.












Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Occupation Employment Concentration






Top Posted Occupations



Unique Average Monthly Postings



In 2022, there were 1,892 graduates in Portage County, WI. This pipeline has shrunk by 9% over the last 5 years.
