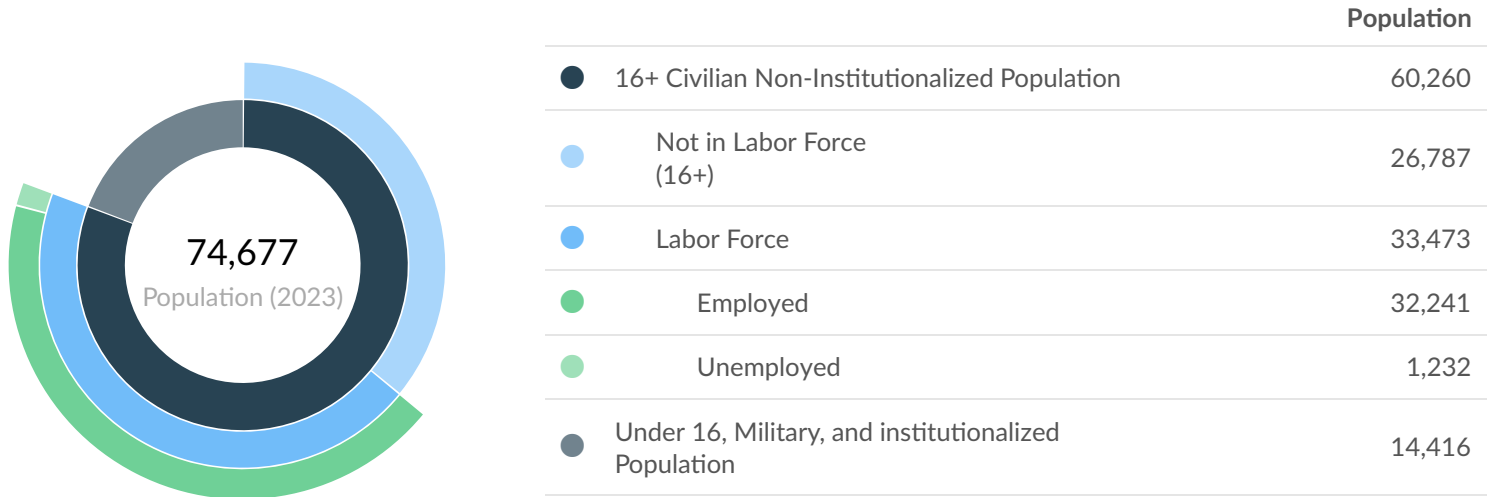
Median household income is **\$11.0K below** the national median household income of \$69.0K.

### Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population **increased by 2.5%** since 2018, growing by 1,850. Population is expected to **increase by 3.3%** between 2023 and 2028, adding 2,444.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs **declined by 3.8%** in Wood County, WI from 42,427 to **40,801**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 7.4%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 60.6% to 55.5% between 2018 and 2023**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.5% of Wood County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (7.6% below the national average), and **13.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.8% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are General Freight Trucking, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

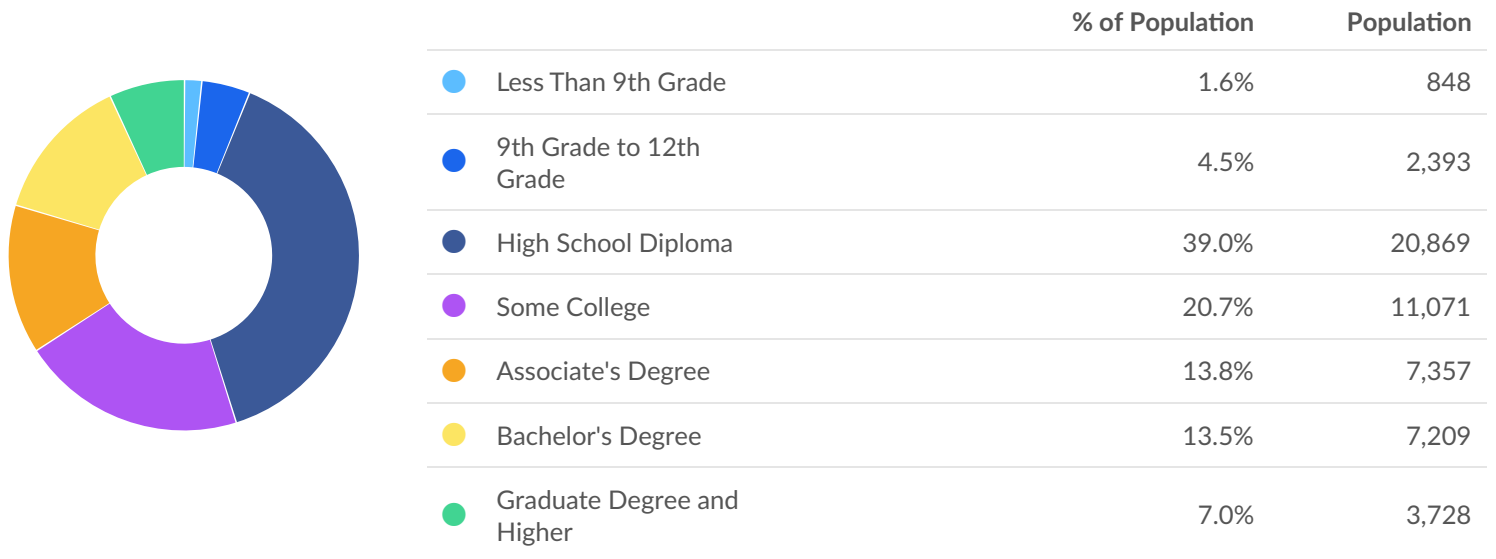

## Sep 2023 Labor Force Breakdown



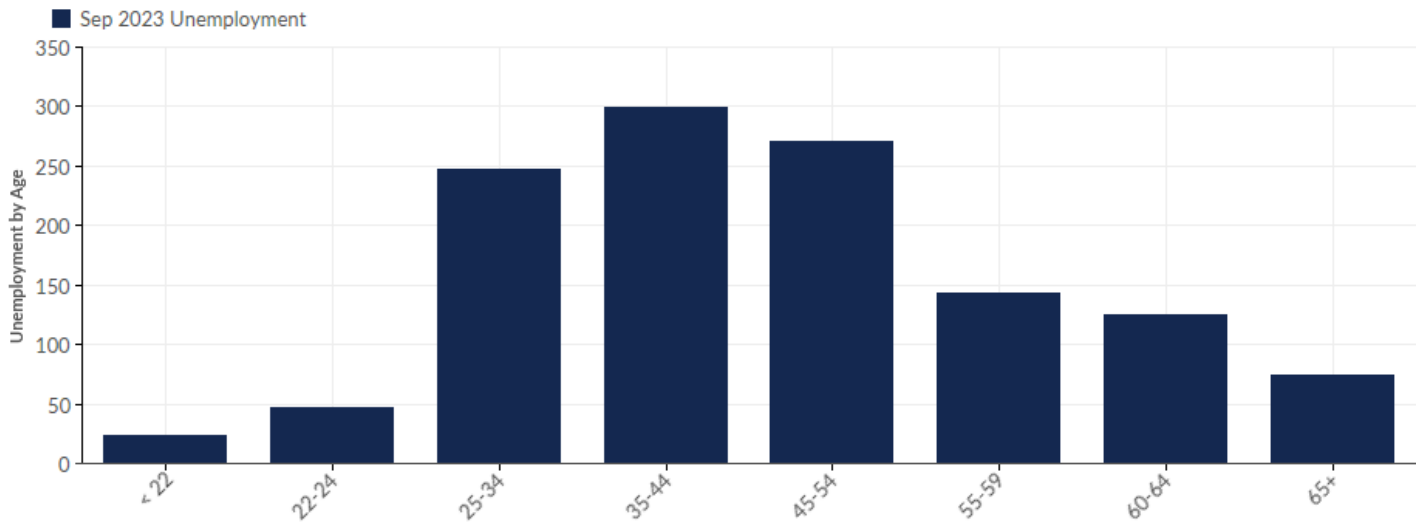
## Educational Attainment

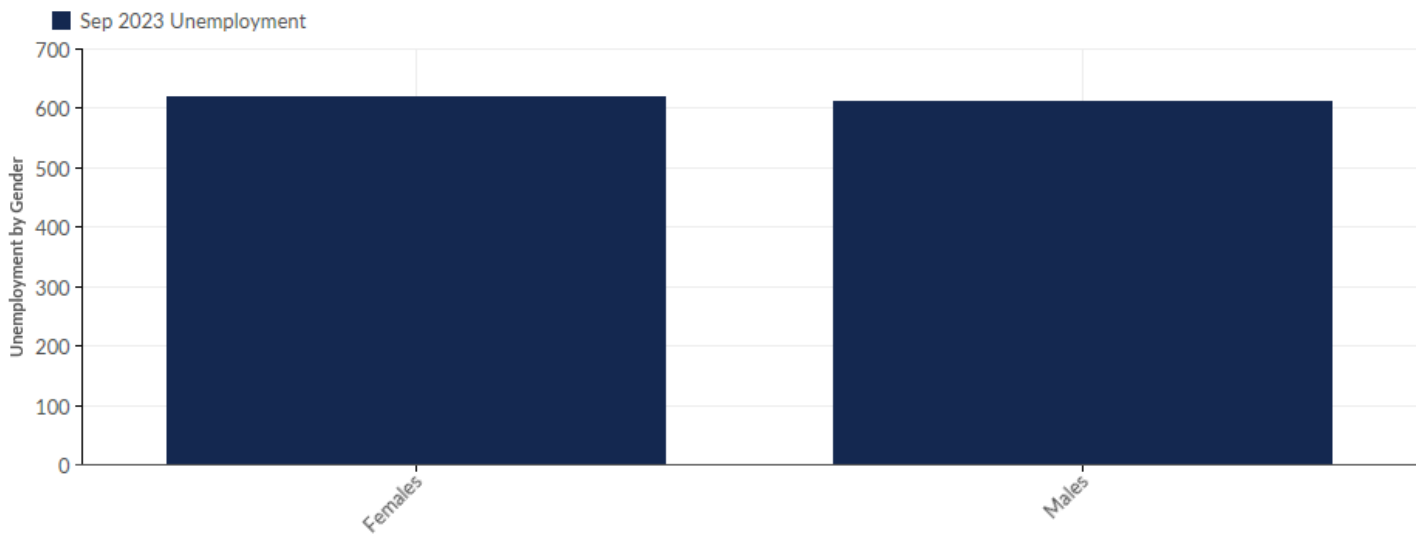

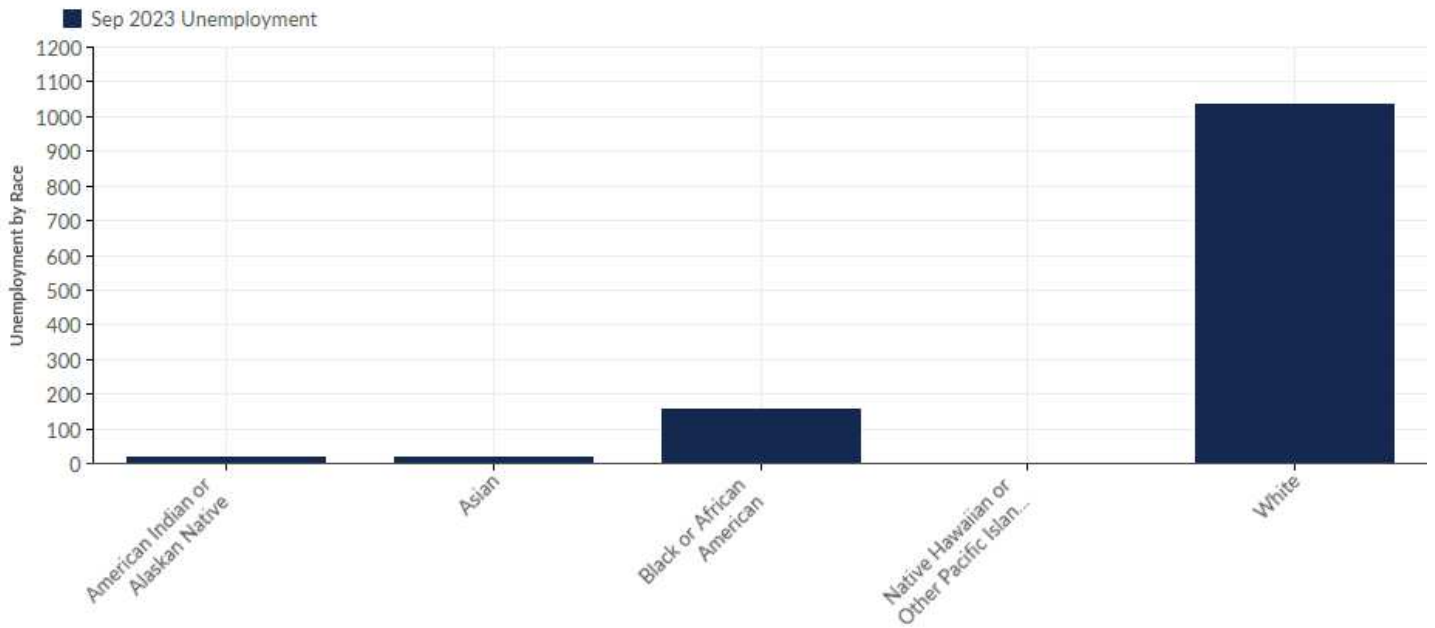

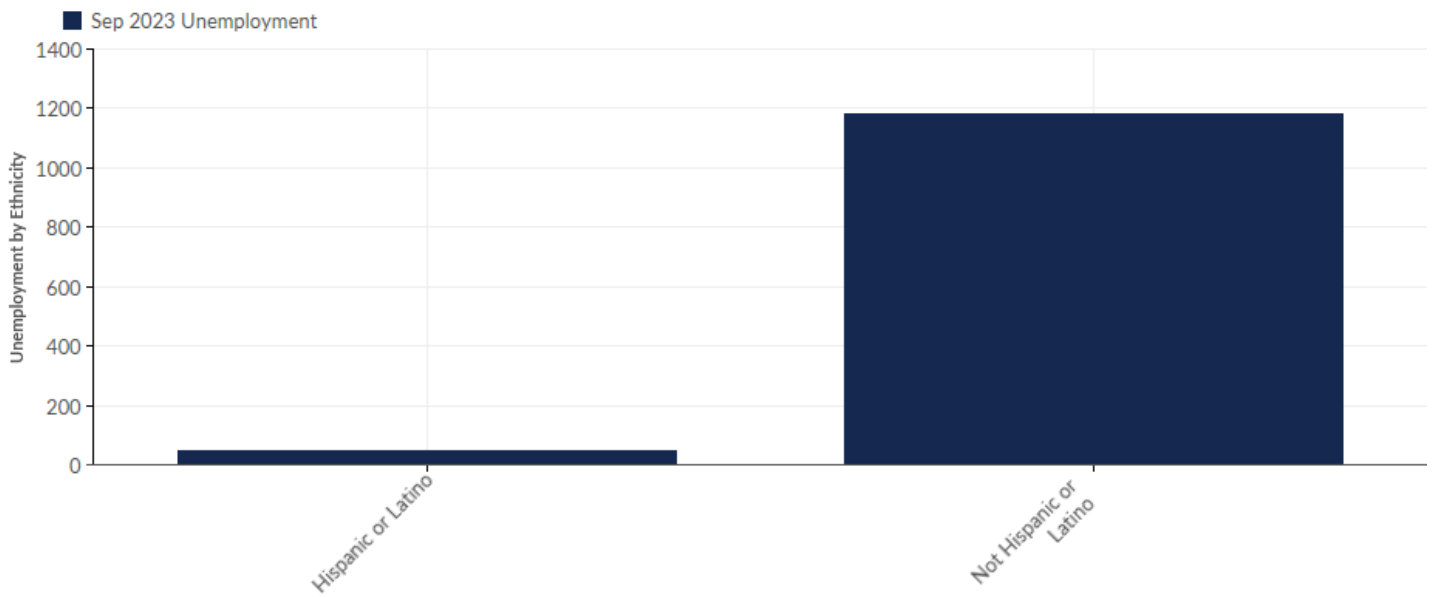

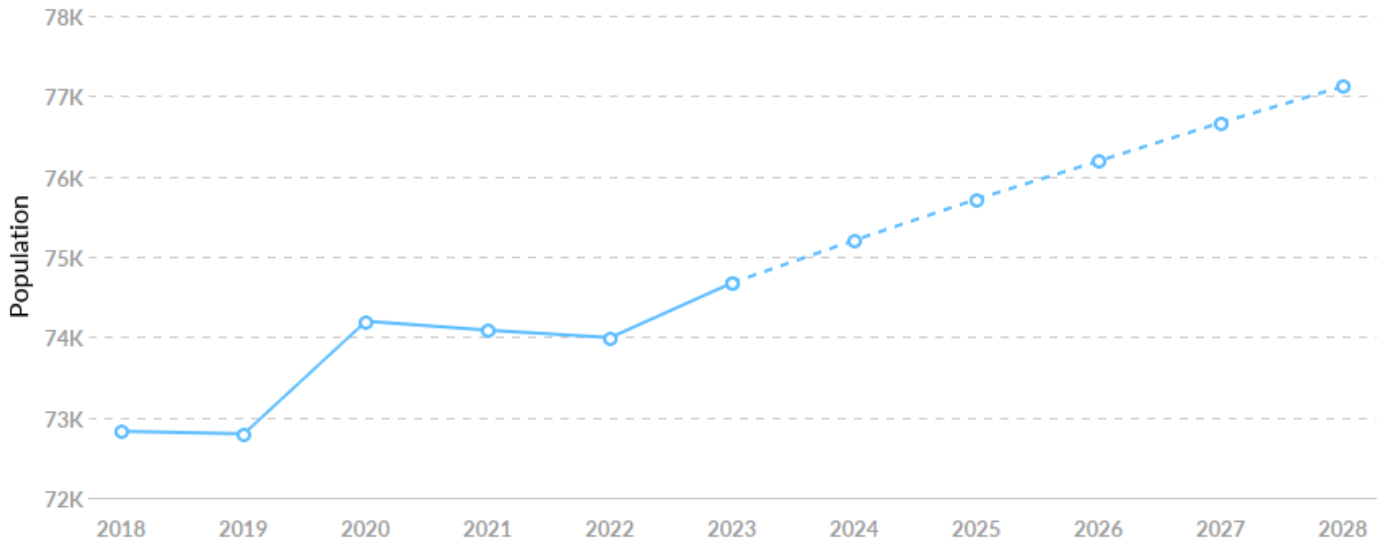

## Population Trends

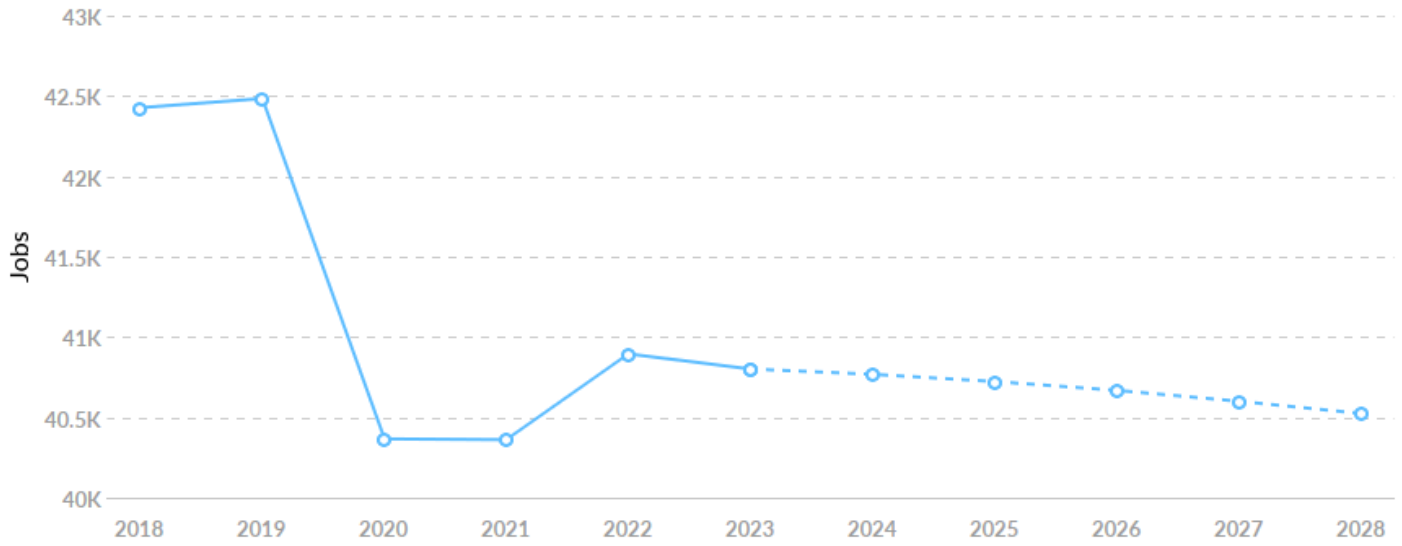

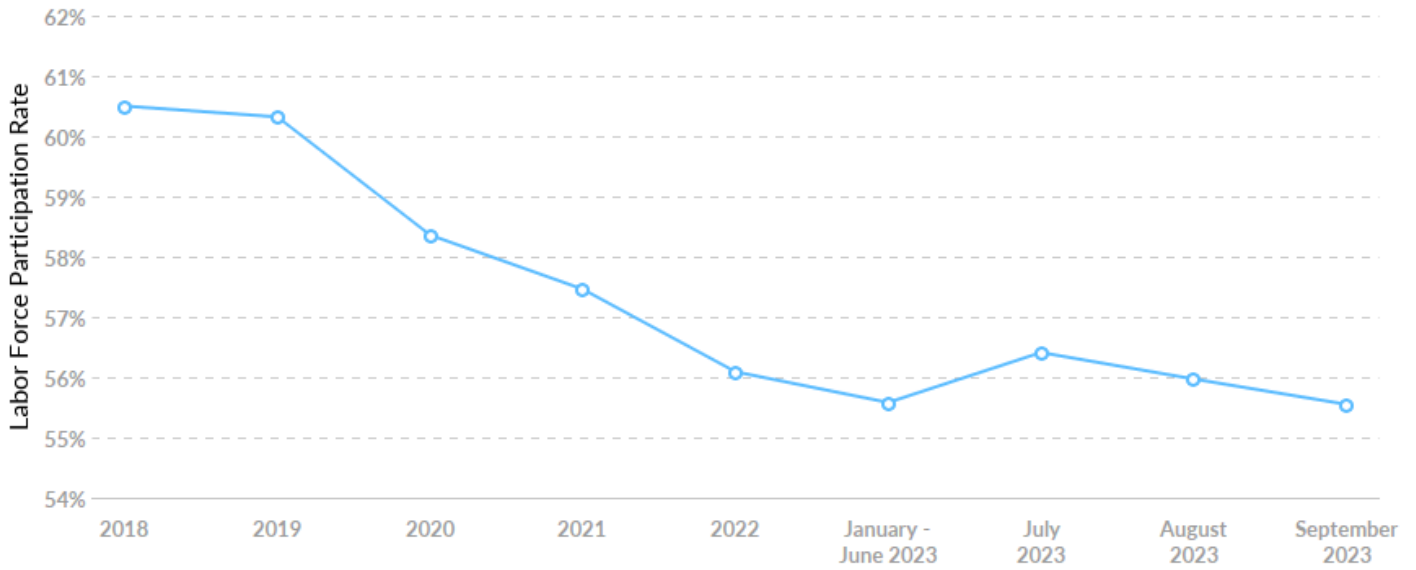
## Job Trends

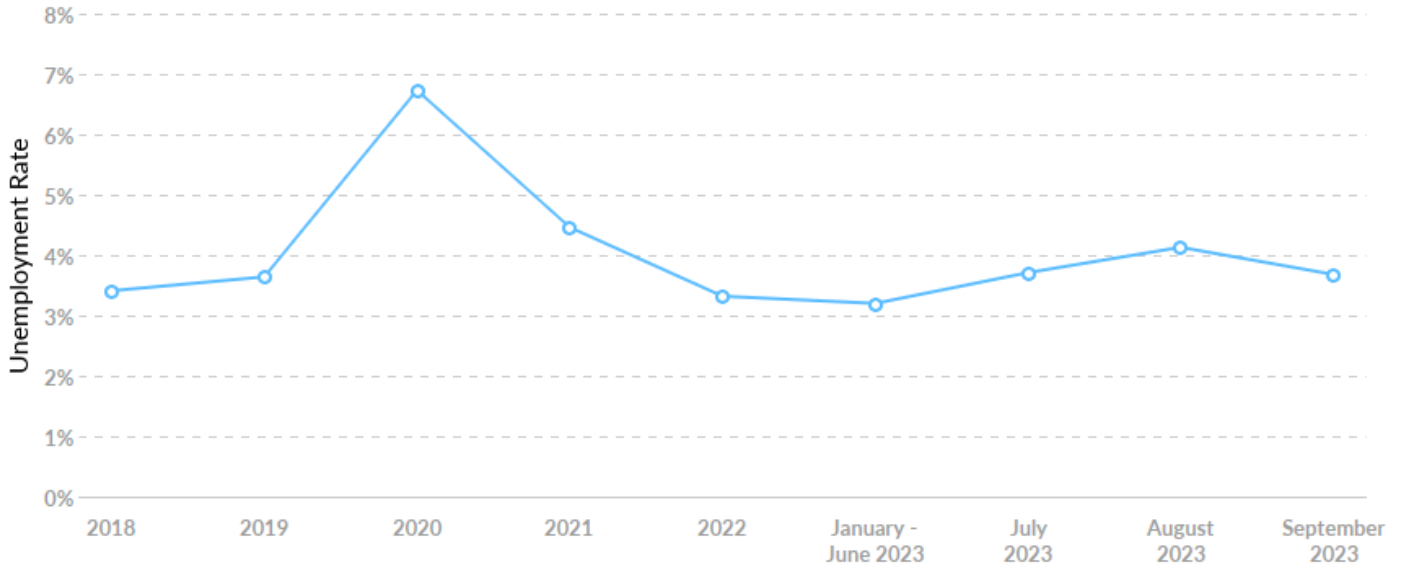

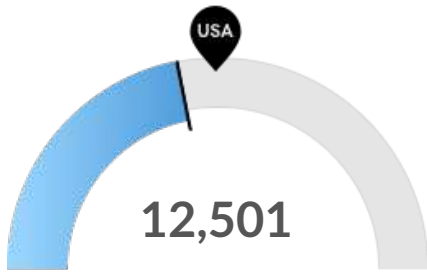
## Unemployment Rate Trends

Wood County, WI had a September 2023 unemployment rate of 3.68%, **increasing from 3.41%** 5 years before.



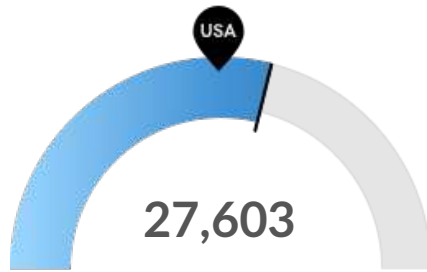

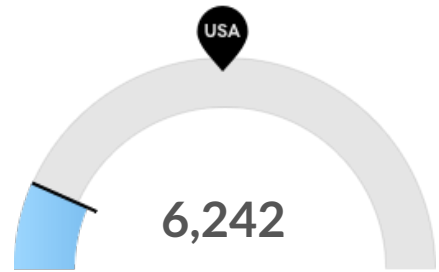
**Millennials**

Wood County, WI has 12,501 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 15,045.



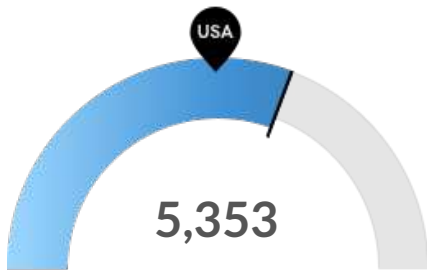
**Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Wood County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 22,174 people 55 or older, while there are 27,603 here.



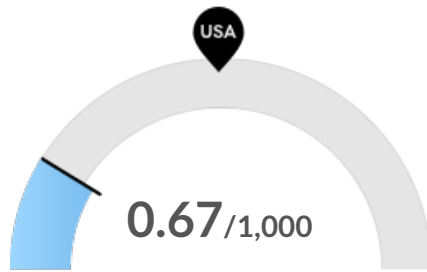
**Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is low in Wood County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 30,429 racially diverse people, while there are 6,242 here.



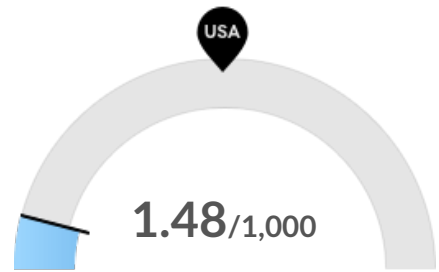
**Veterans**

Wood County, WI has 0.67 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 2.41 per 1,000 people.

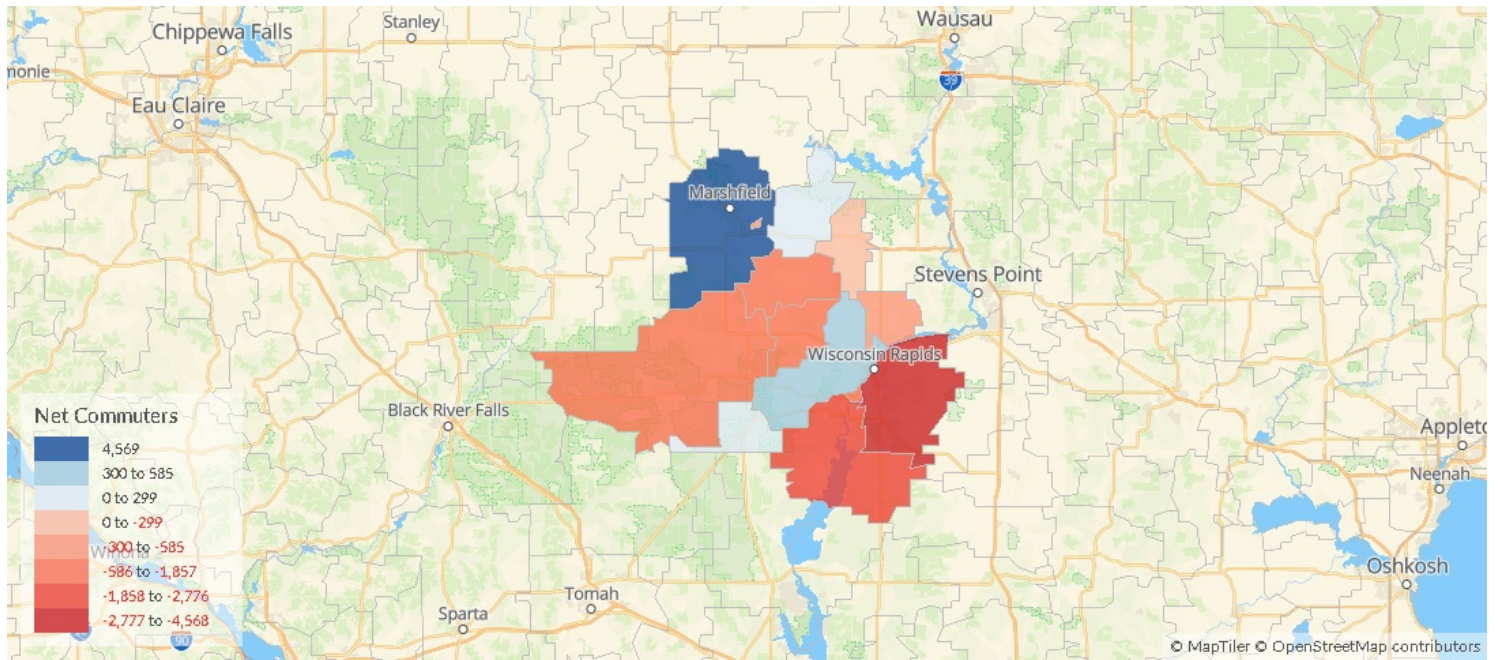


**Property Crime**

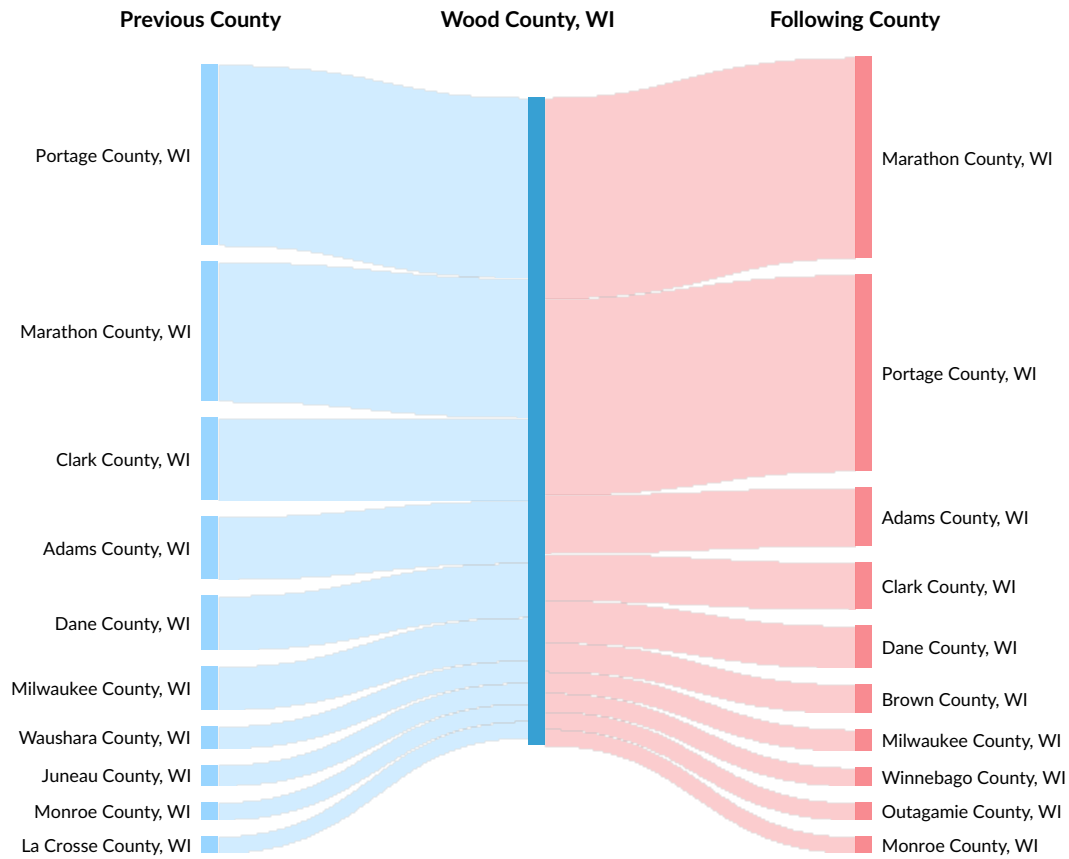

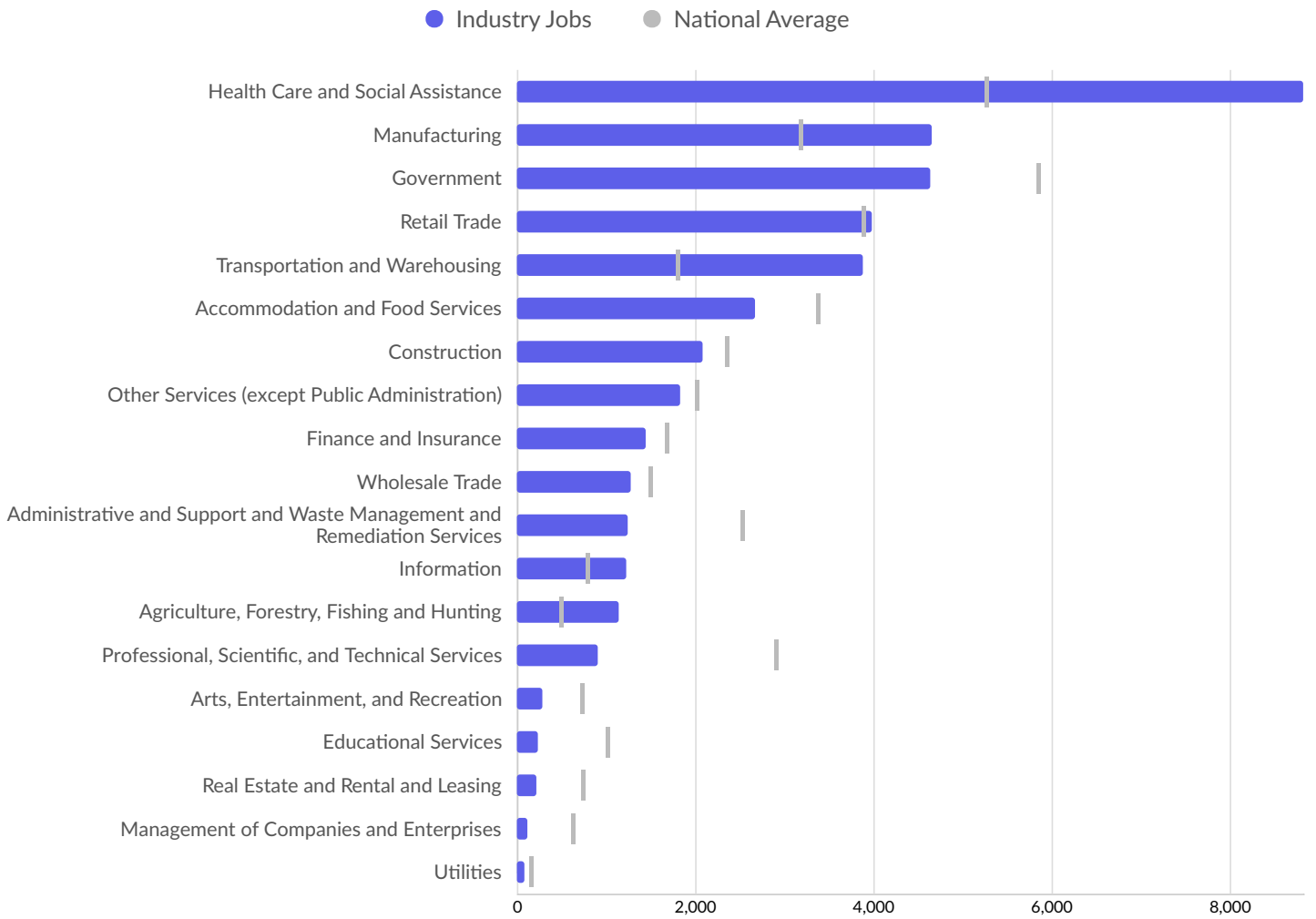

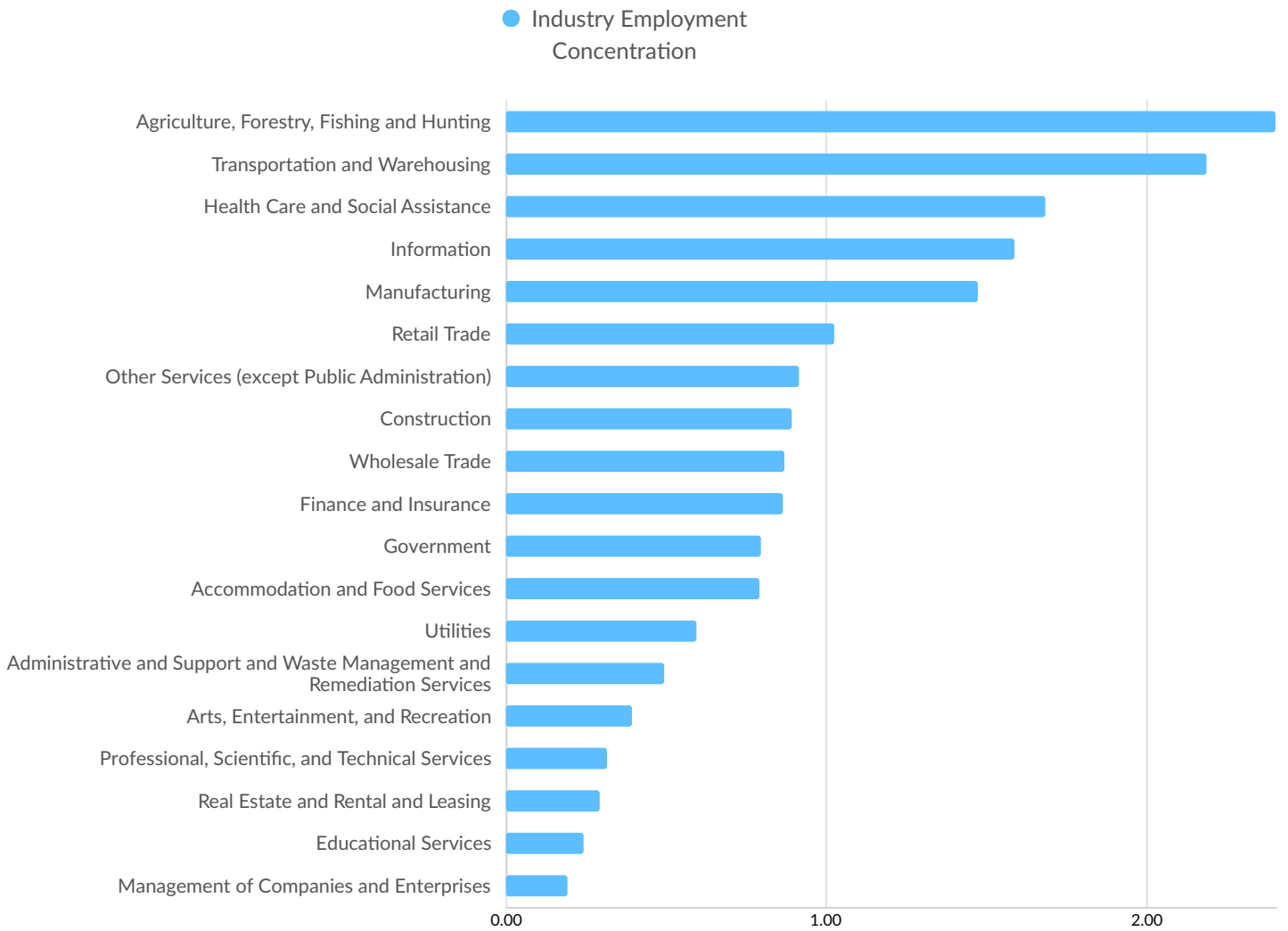

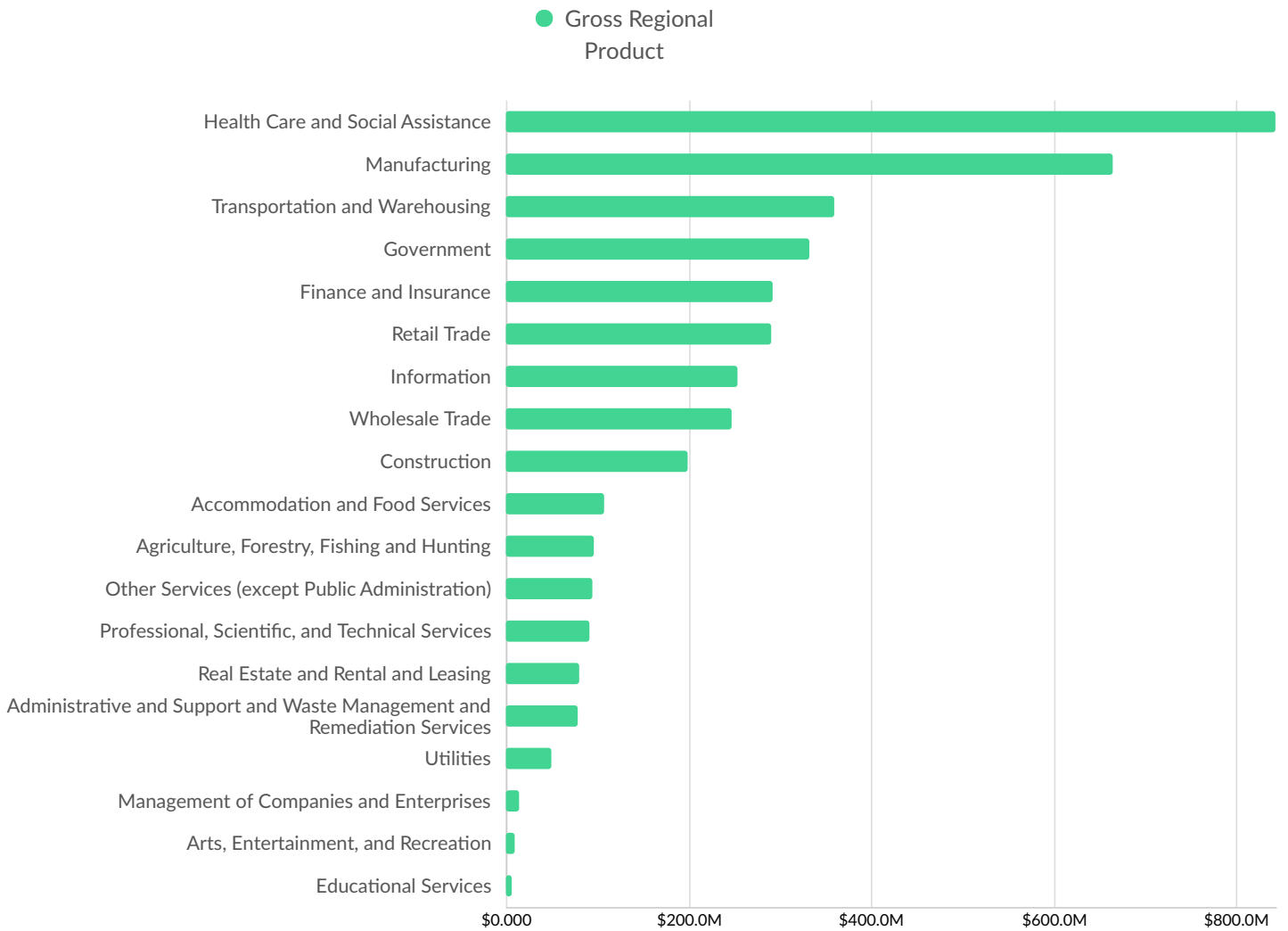
## Top Growing Industries



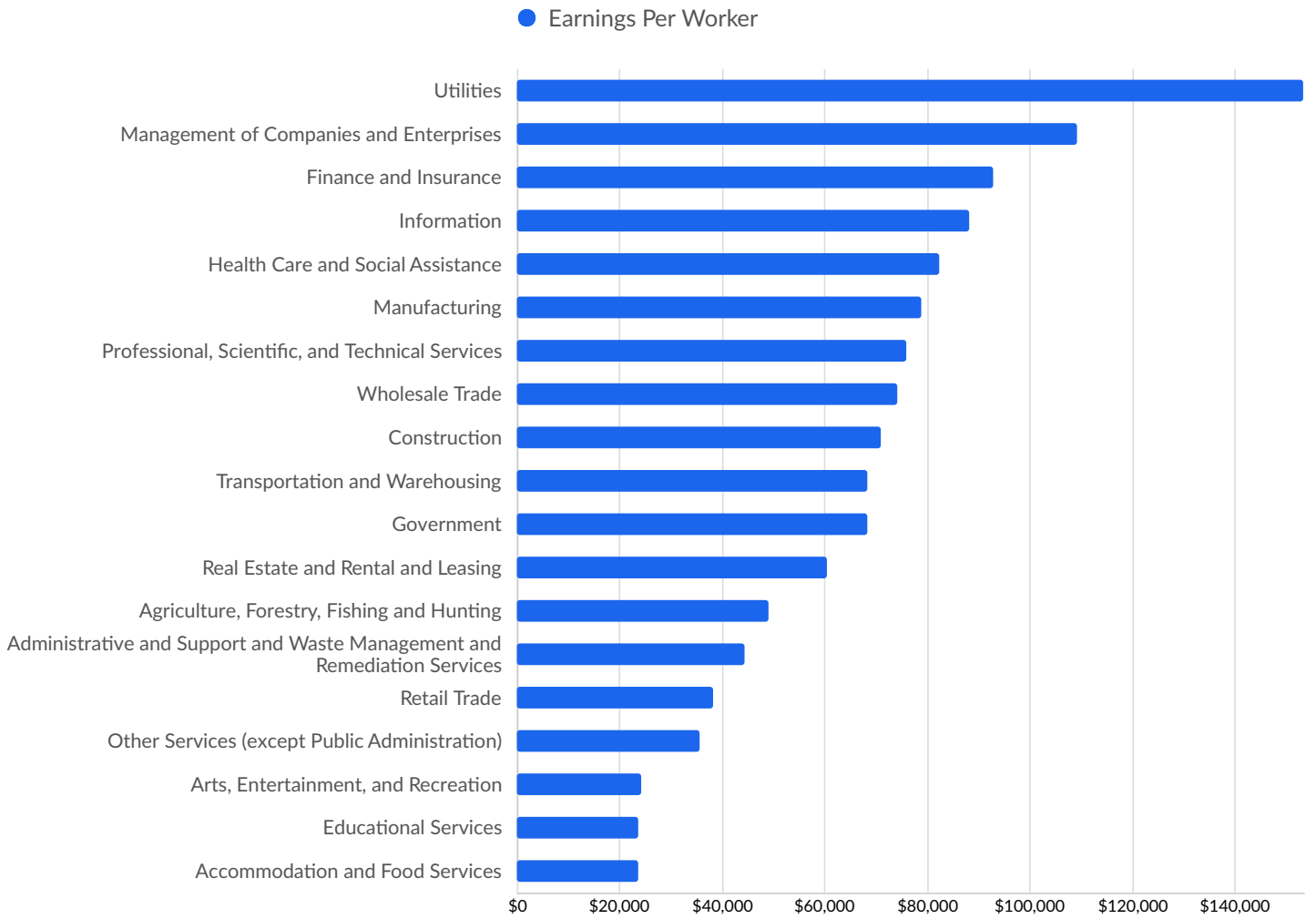
## Top Industry Employment Concentration

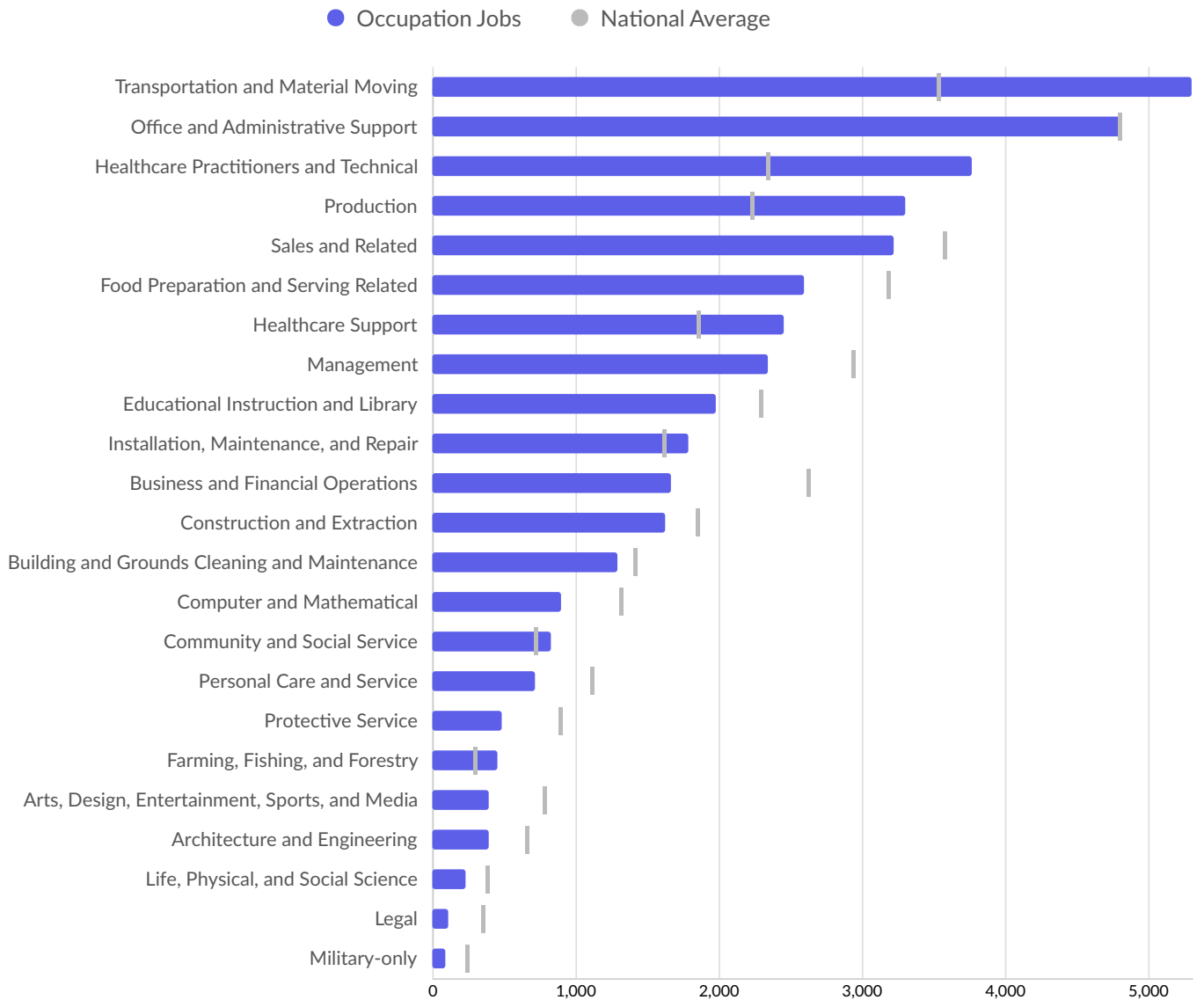

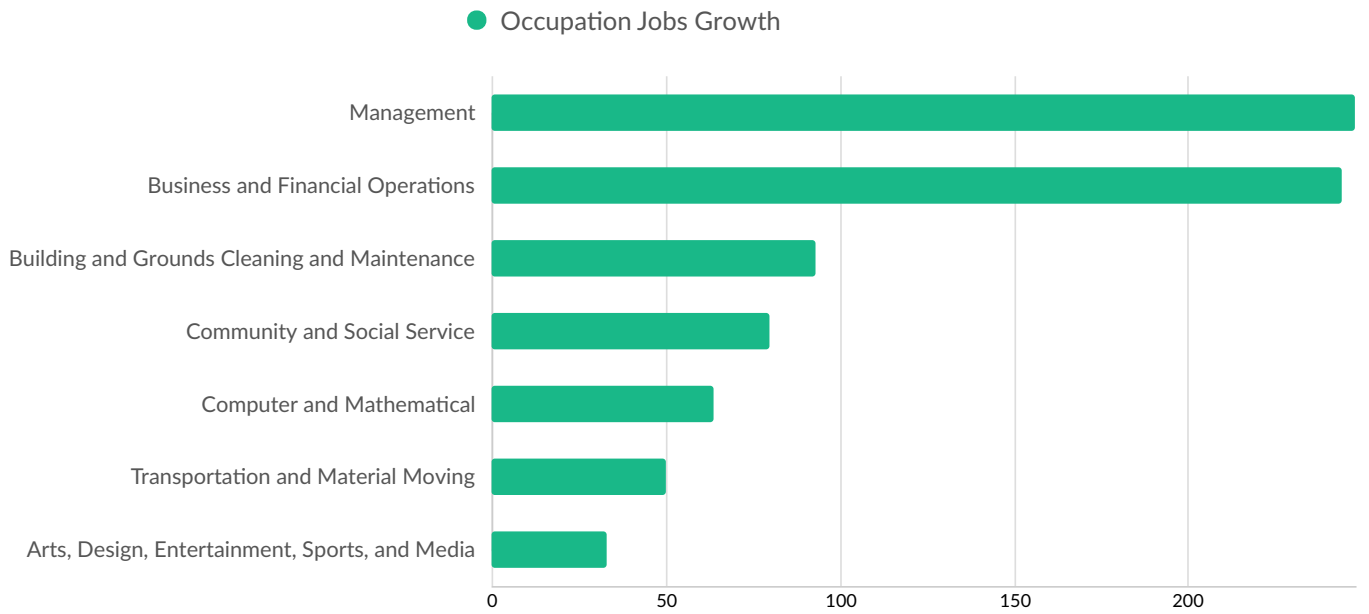

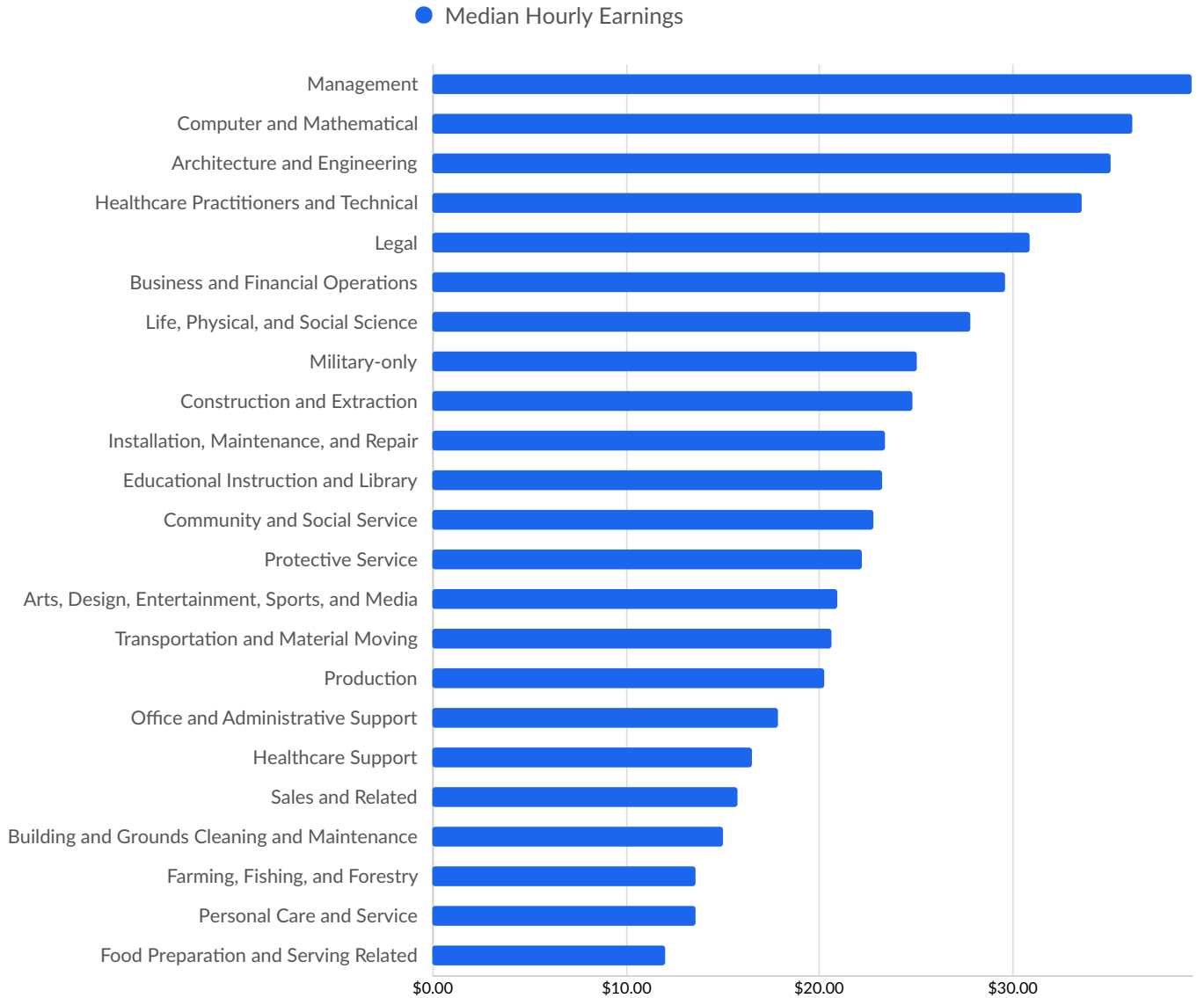


## Top Occupation Employment Concentration

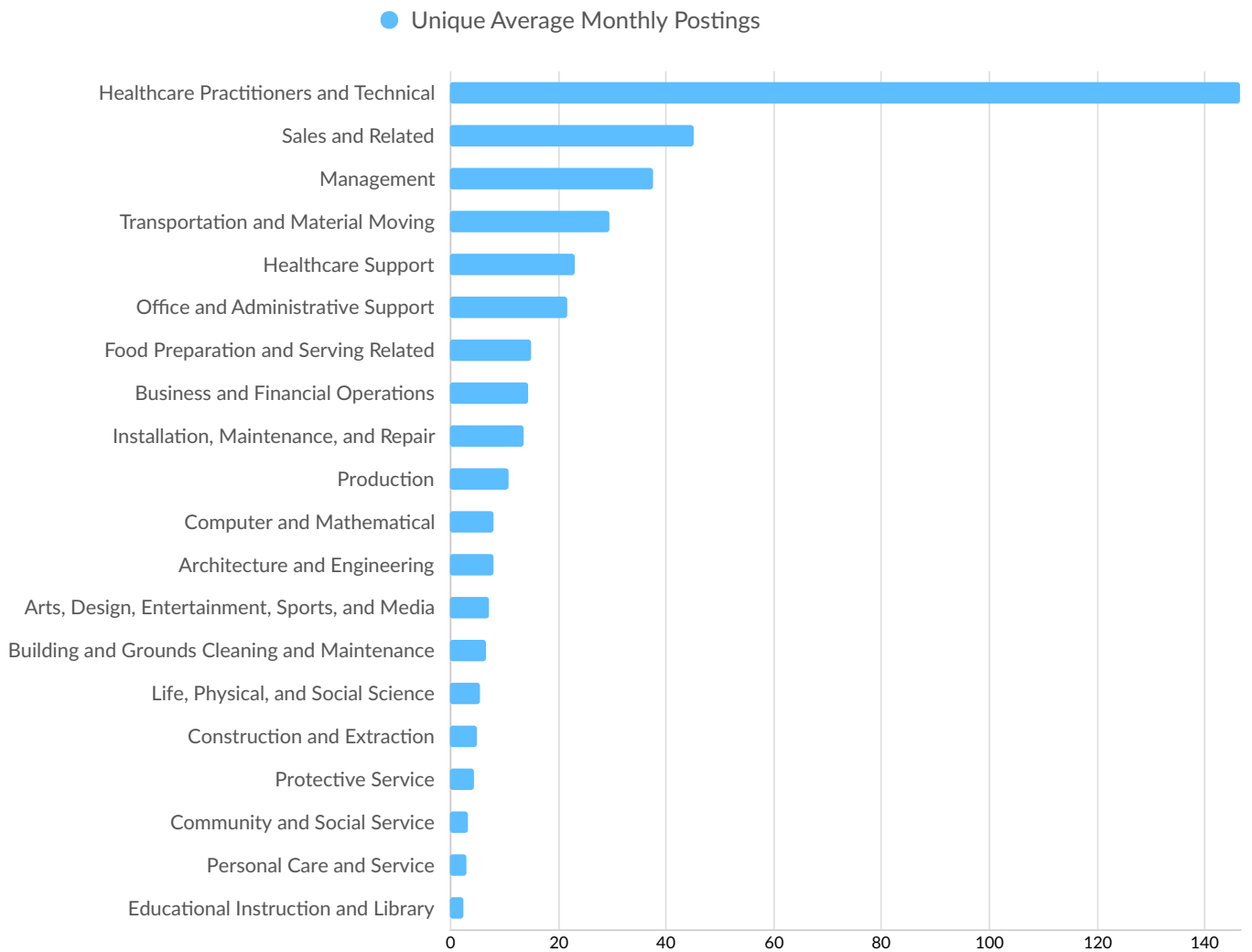

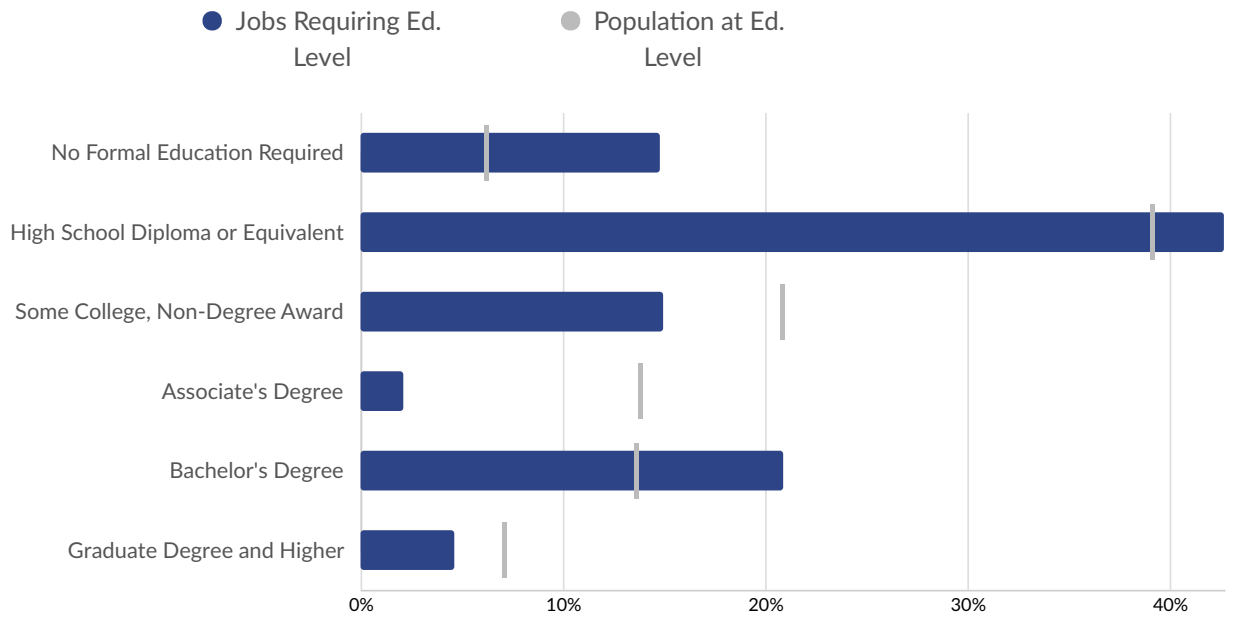

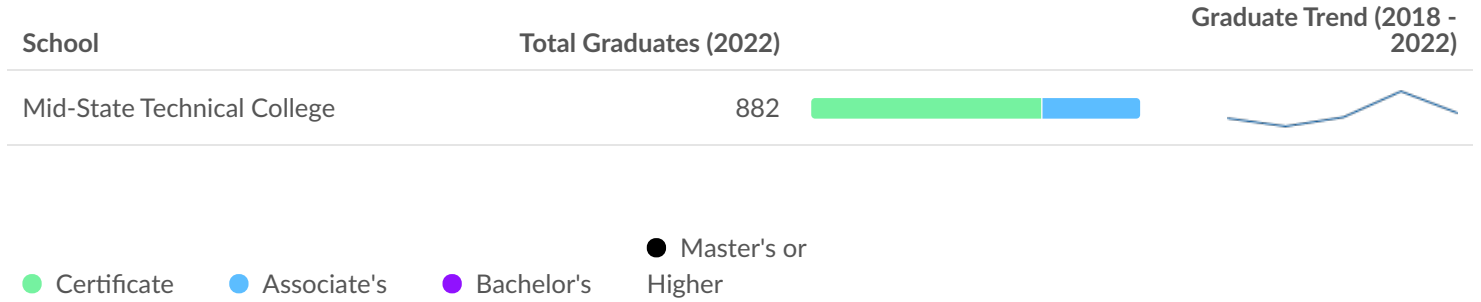

In 2022, there were 882 graduates in Wood County, WI. This pipeline has grown by 2% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide" (Certificate), "Registered Nursing/Registered Nurse" (Associate's), and "Emergency Medical Technology/Technician (EMT Paramedic)" (Certificate).
