

Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 1.3% since 2018, growing by 351. Population is expected to increase by 0.6% between 2023 and 2028, adding 152.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 0.9% in Juneau County, WI from 10,579 to 10,674. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 3.0%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 66.2% to 63.0% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.8% of Juneau County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.4% below the national average), and **12.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.




Feb 2024 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender




Unemployment by Race

Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Juneau County, WI had a February 2024 unemployment rate of 4.04%, increasing from 3.16% 5 years before.






Millennials


Juneau County, WI has 4,651 millennials (ages 25-39). The size is 5,463.






Veterans

Juneau County, WI has 2,062 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,405.




Retiring Soon

Juneau County, WI has 9.01 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 18.22 per 1,000 people.










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP











Top Occupation Employment Concentration




Top Occupation Earnings




