#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 2.6% since 2018, growing by 3,505. Population is expected to increase by 2.6% between 2023 and 2028, adding 3,560.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 1.0% in Marathon County, WI from 78,130 to 77,320. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 4.9%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 69.2% to 66.3% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **19.0% of Marathon County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.2% below the national average), and **13.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.1% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Dairy Product Manufacturing.

#### **Educational Attainment**













#### **Job Trends**






Marathon County, WI had a February 2024 unemployment rate of 3.02%, increasing from 2.75% 5 years before.








Marathon County, WI has 8,018 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 7,215.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 41,344 people 55 or older, while there are 46,157 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 56,734 racially diverse people, while there are 17,349 here.




#### **Property Crime**


















#### **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**





#### Unique Average Monthly Postings







### **Educational Pipeline**

In 2022, there were 2,284 graduates in Marathon County, WI. This pipeline has shrunk by 1% over the last 4 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide" (Certificate), "Welding Technology/Welder" (Certificate), and "Emergency Medical Technology/Technician (EMT Paramedic)" (Certificate).
