


#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 11.4% since 2018, growing by 2,502. Population is expected to increase by 11.9% between 2023 and 2028, adding 2,909.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 1.6% in Vilas County, WI from 9,497 to 9,647. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 2.3%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 52.4% to 48.6% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **19.2% of Vilas County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (1.9% below the national average), and **10.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).










# **Unemployment by Gender**









#### **Job Trends**






Vilas County, WI had a February 2024 unemployment rate of 5.01%, increasing from 4.05% 5 years before.




Vilas County, WI has 2,935 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,832.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Vilas County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 7,121 people 55 or older, while there are 12,317 here.




#### **Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is low in Vilas County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 9,772 racially diverse people, while there are 3,394 here.




#### **Veterans**










## **Top Industry Employment Concentration**








## **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**




