Median household income is \$19.6K below the national median household income of \$75.1K.


Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 6.5% since 2018, growing by 582. Population is expected to increase by 7.8% between 2023 and 2028, adding 751.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 1.6% in Forest County, WI from 3,568 to 3,626. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 2.7%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 53.7% to 50.4% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.1% of Forest County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.1% below the national average), and **10.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.








Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity





As of 2023 the region's population increased by 6.5% since 2018, growing by 582. Population is expected to increase by 7.8% between 2023 and 2028, adding 751.



Job Trends




Forest County, WI had a March 2024 unemployment rate of 5.22%, increasing from 4.98% 5 years before.




Millennials

millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 1,907.






Forest County, WI has 625 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 480.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Forest County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 2,811 people 55 or older, while there are 3,971 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Forest County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 3,858 racially diverse people, while there are 1,885 here.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP






Top Occupation Employment Concentration




