Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population **increased by 1.5%** since 2018, growing by 412. Population is expected to **increase by 1.2%** between 2023 and 2028, adding 316.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 1.5% in Juneau County, WI from 10,579 to 10,740. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 2.8%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 66.2% to 63.5% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.8% of Juneau County**, **WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.4% below the national average), and **12.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

Educational Attainment







Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity








Juneau County, WI had a March 2024 unemployment rate of 3.68%, increasing from 3.19% 5 years before.


Millennials

Juneau County, WI has 4,651 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,463.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Juneau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,051 people 55 or older, while there are 10,227 here.




Racial Diversity

Violent Crime


Juneau County, WI has 1.82 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.










Top Industry Employment Concentration




Occupation Jobs Growth

Top Occupation Employment Concentration






