Median household income is \$10.8K below the national median household income of \$75.1K.


Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 3.5% since 2018, growing by 976. Population is expected to increase by 3.3% between 2023 and 2028, adding 943.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 5.9% in Lincoln County, WI from 12,356 to 11,631. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 10.2%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 66.6% to 60.7% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.8% of Lincoln County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.3% below the national average), and **11.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Insurance Carriers, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.











Unemployment by Ethnicity





As of 2023 the region's population increased by 3.5% since 2018, growing by 976. Population is expected to increase by 3.3% between 2023 and 2028, adding 943.



Job Trends






Lincoln County, WI had a March 2024 unemployment rate of 4.11%, increasing from 3.56% 5 years before.



Millennials


Lincoln County, WI has 4,322 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,770.

Racial diversity is low in Lincoln County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 11,669 racially diverse people, while there are 1,608 here.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP




Top Growing Occupations





Top Occupation Employment Concentration




Top Occupation Earnings




