Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 2.5% since 2018, growing by 3,388. Population is expected to increase by 1.9% between 2023 and 2028, adding 2,601.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 1.2% in Marathon County, WI from 78,130 to 77,156. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 5.5%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 69.2% to 65.3% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **19.0% of Marathon County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.2% below the national average), and **13.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.1% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Dairy Product Manufacturing.




Mar 2024 Labor Force Breakdown









Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Marathon County, WI had a March 2024 unemployment rate of 3.17%, increasing from 2.77% 5 years before.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 41,344 people 55 or older, while there are 46,157 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 56,734 racially diverse people, while there are 17,349 here.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP





Top Occupation Employment Concentration












Educational Pipeline

In 2022, there were 2,284 graduates in Marathon County, WI. This pipeline has shrunk by 1% over the last 4 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide" (Certificate), "Welding Technology/Welder" (Certificate), and "Emergency Medical Technology/Technician (EMT Paramedic)" (Certificate).
