

Median household income is \$9.0K below the national median household income of \$75.1K.


#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 10.0% since 2018, growing by 3,533. Population is expected to increase by 7.5% between 2023 and 2028, adding 2,937.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 0.1% in Oneida County, WI from 18,554 to 18,581. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 4.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 59.7% to 54.4% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **16.8% of Oneida County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (4.4% below the national average), and **12.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, General Medical and Surgical Hospitals, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.








## **Unemployment by Gender**



## **Unemployment by Ethnicity**







#### **Job Trends**






Oneida County, WI had a March 2024 unemployment rate of 4.74%, increasing from 4.16% 5 years before.







#### **Millennials**

millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 7,770.






Oneida County, WI has 2,882 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,954.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Oneida County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 11,451 people 55 or older, while there are 17,979 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Oneida County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 15,714 racially diverse people, while there are 2,066 here.




#### **Property Crime**






#### **Top Growing Industries**






#### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**






#### **Top Industry GRP**





#### **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**



# **Educational Pipeline**

In 2022, there were 419 graduates in Oneida County, WI. This pipeline has shrunk by 19% over the last 4 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide" (Certificate), "Liberal Arts and Sciences/Liberal Studies" (Associate's), and "Licensed Practical/Vocational Nurse Training" (Certificate).
