

Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 5.2% since 2018, growing by 1,063. Population is expected to increase by 5.1% between 2023 and 2028, adding 1,104.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 4.3% in Adams County, WI from 5,840 to 5,589. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 8.8%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 47.8% to 43.2% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.9% of Adams County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.3% below the national average), and **8.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.2% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Crop Production, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Traveler Accommodation.




Sep 2024 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity









Labor Force Participation Rate Trends




Adams County, WI had a September 2024 unemployment rate of 3.33%, decreasing from 4.91% 5 years before.

Millennials


Adams County, WI has 3,052 millennials (ages 25-39). The size is 4,358.






Veterans

Adams County, WI has 1,766 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,087.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,475 people 55 or older, while there are 11,079 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,933 racially diverse people, while there are 2,293 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP








Top Occupation Employment Concentration




