Median household income is \$19.6K below the national median household income of \$75.1K.


Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 3.6% since 2018, growing by 324. Population is expected to increase by 5.0% between 2023 and 2028, adding 463.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 1.5% in Forest County, WI from 3,568 to 3,623. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 3.0%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 53.7% to 51.7% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.1% of Forest County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.0% below the national average), and **10.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.










Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity





As of 2023 the region's population increased by 3.6% since 2018, growing by 324. Population is expected to increase by 5.0% between 2023 and 2028, adding 463.




Job Trends

Labor Force Participation Rate Trends




Forest County, WI had a September 2024 unemployment rate of 3.04%, decreasing from 4.98% 5 years before.




Millennials

Retirement risk is high in Forest County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 2,815 people 55 or older, while there are 4,026 here.




Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Forest County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 3,884 racially diverse people, while there are 1,846 here.




Forest County, WI has 625 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 477.

Forest County, WI has 1.29 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP




Top Occupation Employment Concentration






