Regional average earnings per job are \$23.8K below the national average earnings of \$83.3K per job.


Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 5.0% since 2018, growing by 9,887. Population is expected to increase by 4.2% between 2023 and 2028, adding 8,553.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 1.1% in Grow North from 85,121 to 84,201. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 5.6%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 61.1% to 56.8% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.4% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.8% below the national average), and **12.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).















Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends





















Inbound and Outbound Migration








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP







Top Occupation Employment Concentration





Educational Pipeline

In 2023, there were 392 graduates in Grow North. This pipeline has shrunk by 24% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide" (Certificate), "Liberal Arts and Sciences/Liberal Studies" (Associate's), and "Licensed Practical/Vocational Nurse Training" (Certificate).
